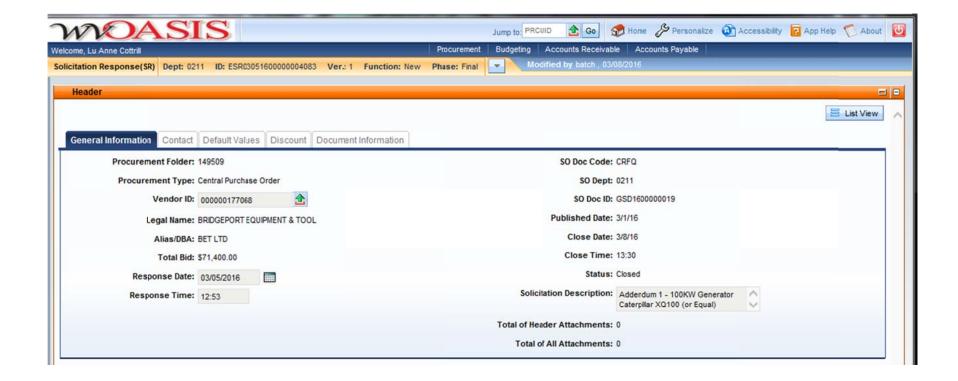

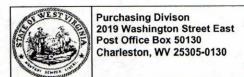

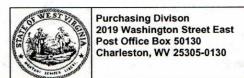

SPECIFICATIONS

- PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the Department of Administration, General Services Division, to establish a contract for the one time purchase of 100KW New Portable Generator with Trailer, to be delivered and installed at BEP Building 4, 112 California Ave, Charleston WV 25305.
- DEFINITIONS: The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - **2.1 "Contract Item"** means 100KW New Portable Generator Caterpillar XQ100 (or equal) as more fully described by these specifications.
 - **2.2 "Pricing Page"** means the pages, contained in wvOASIS or attached as Exhibit A, upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Items.
 - **2.3 "Solicitation"** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.1 Mandatory Contract Item Requirements: Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.
 - 3.1.1 New 100KW Portable Generator Caterpillar XQ100 (or Equal) with trailer.
 - 3.1.1.1 Must be a 100KW generator
 - **3.1.1.2** Must include all cable sets, including control cables and grounding stake with cable and will consist of 1-100ft and 2-50ft sets complete with tail cables and include 2 spares of each cable.
 - **3.1.1.3** Must have Portable distribution panel for standalone operations
 - 3.1.1.4 Must include auto switch panel

- 3.1.1.5 Must include complete trailer set up including dual axle trailer, generator mounted to unit, fender with fender steps on front/rear of fenders, 25/8" hitch ball, and electric brakes
- **3.1.1.6** Must include Operators Training and 1 year of technical support on operations either by phone or on site.
- 3.1.1.7 Must have a manufacturer's warranty
- 3.1.1.8 Item must include a Manufacturer's warranty of sixty (60) months or 2500 hours whichever occurs first. Warranty becomes effective date of purchase with a Zero (-0-) deductible on parts and labor. Warranty not to cover consumables such as oil, fluids or filters.
- 3.1.1.9 Must be delivered and initial setup as part of Operators Training.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- **4.1 Contract Award:** The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price for the Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by completely filling out the pricing on the commodity line in wvOASIS or by completely filling out the Exhibit "A "Pricing Page Attachment. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.

Vendor's who wish to respond to a Centralized Request for Quotation (CRFQ) online may submit information through the State's wvOasis Vendor Self Service (VSS). Vendors should download the Exhibit "A" Pricing Page attached separately to the CRFQ and published to the VSS. Vendors should complete this form with their pricing information and include it as an attachment to their online response. If bidding an "or equal" product, Vendors should include the manufacturer make and model number they are bidding, this information must be provided before award.

5. PAYMENT:

5.1 Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

- 6.1 Shipment and Delivery: Vendor shall ship the Contract Items immediately after being awarded this Contract and receiving a purchase order. Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items within 30 (thirty) calendar days after receiving a purchase order. Contract Items must be delivered to Agency at BEP Building 4, 112 California Ave, Charleston WV 25305.
- 6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if the shipment of the Contract Items will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the Contract, and/or obtaining the Contract Items from a third party.

Any Agency seeking to obtain the Contract Items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.

- **6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss:** Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location.
- 6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items: If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive a full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the Agency's discretion.
- 6.5 Return Due to Agency Error: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.

7 VENDOR DEFAULT:

- 7.1 The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.
 - **7.1.1** Failure to provide Contract Items in accordance with the requirements contained herein.
 - **7.1.2** Failure to comply with other specifications and requirements contained herein.
 - **7.1.3** Failure to comply with any laws, rules, and ordinances applicable to the Contract Services provided under this Contract.
 - **7.1.4** Failure to remedy deficient performance upon request.
- 7.2 The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
 - **7.2.1** Immediate cancellation of the Contract.
 - **7.2.2** Immediate cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.
 - **7.2.3** Any other remedies available in law or equity.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va.
