The perimeter area may be enlarged depending upon the building configuration. The corner area is defined as the portion of the perimeter area beginning at the intersection of two roof edges and proceeding in both directions a distance equal to the width of the perimeter area. Corner areas on buildings with minimum 3 feet high continuous parapet walls and a maximum 2 inch in 12 inch roof slope can be treated as perimeter areas. 
1. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: West Virginia Code § 21-11-2 requires that all persons desiring to perform contracting work in this state be licensed. The West Virginia Contractors Licensing Board is empowered to issue the contractor's license. Applications for a contractor's license may be made by contacting the West Virginia Division of Labor. West Virginia Code § 21-11-11 requires any prospective Vendor to include the contractor's license number on its bid. Failure to include a contractor's license number on the bid shall result in Vendor's bid being disqualified. Vendors should include a contractor's license number in the space provided below.

### **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

**MANDATE:** Under W. Va.
