

"State Contract Project" means any erection or construction of, or any addition to, alteration of or other improvement to any building or structure, including, but not limited to, roads or highways, or the installation of any heating or cooling or ventilating plants or other equipment, or the supply of and materials for such projects, pursuant to a contract with the State of West Virginia for which bids were solicited on or after June 6, 2001.
- b. "Steel Products" means products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forged, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed, or processed by a combination of two or more or such operations, from steel made by the open heath, basic oxygen, electric furnace, Bessemer or other steel making process. The Purchasing Division Director may, in writing, authorize the use of foreign steel products if:
- c. The cost for each contract item used does not exceed one tenth of one percent (.1%) of the total contract cost or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), whichever is greater. For the purposes of this section, the cost is the value of the steel product as delivered to the project; or d. The Director of the Purchasing Division determines that specified steel materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient quantity or otherwise are not reasonably available to meet contract requirements.

44. PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC ALUMINUM, GLASS, AND STEEL: In Accordance with W. Va. Code § 5-19-1 et seq., and W. Va. 1) Vendor Question/Inquiry:

"I did see the spreadsheet, but as I dug deeper into the spreadsheet, I noticed that it shows the unit of measurement incorrectly. For example: Line 32, description says "1,000 feet per easy pull box", the unit of measure says "EA", and the quantity says "5,000." Based off of that, the estimated quantity is 5,000 boxes of cable, that are 1,000 foot each. I don't believe that was the intention."

WVOT Response 1:

Please see the RFQ section 3.1.1. It states that the UOM is each and pricing is to be per foot. Please enter price in a "per foot" value: example -\$1.00 per foot X 5000 = \$5,000.00.

2) Vendor Question/Inquiry:
