


SPECIFICATIONS

1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources' (WVDNR) Wildlife Resources Section to establish an open-end contract for the application of pre-timber harvest herbicide treatment. Services will be performed on Wildlife Management Areas throughout West Virginia; a map for location details is included as Exhibit B.

Dyes, surfactants, carriers, and herbicides will be provided by the West Virginia Division of Natural resources and are not the responsibility of the vendor.

- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in Section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 "Contract Item" or "Contract Items" means the list of items identified in Section 3.1 below and on the Pricing Pages.
 - 2.2 "Pricing Pages" means the schedule of prices, estimated order quantity, and totals contained in WV OASIS or attached hereto as Exhibit A, and used to evaluate the Solicitation responses.
 - **2.3 "Solicitation"** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
 - 2.4 "NNIS" means Non-native Invasive Species.
 - **2.5 "Basil Spray"** means the application of herbicide by spraying it completely around stems 12-15 inches above ground line to point of runoff.
 - 2.6 "Hack and Squirt" means the use of an applicator to inject a cull tree using a hatchet with a ground-down bid and a spray bottle of herbicide
 - 2.7 "Foliar Spray" means application of herbicides to completely wet foliage.
 - 2.8 "Wildlife Management Areas" means: Burnsville Lake WMA(Braxton), Chief Cornstalk WMA(Mason), Elk River WMA(Braxton), Frozen Camp WMA(Jackson), Handley WMA(Pocahontas), Hillcrest WMA(Hancock), Lewis Wetzel WMA(Wetzel), Pleasant Creek WMA(Barbour), R. D. Bailey Lake WMA (Logan, Mingo, and Wyoming), Sleepy Creek WMA (Berkeley and Morgan), Stonewall Jackson Lake WMA (Lewis and Upshur), and Wallback WMA. (Clay, Kanawha, and Roane)

- 3. QUALIFICATIONS: Vendor, or Vendor's staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:
 - 3.1 Must be a certified commercial pesticide applicator in one (1) of the following categories:
 - 3.1.1 13c (hardwood tree release); or
 - 3.1.2 Category 7 (right-of-way/ industrial weed).

Vendor should provide a copy of certification with Vendor's submitted bid response. Certification will be required prior to bid award Vendor must provide any documentation requested by the State to assist in confirmation of compliance with this provision. References, documentation, or other information to confirm compliance with this experience requirement may be requested after bid opening and prior to contract award.

4. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

- **4.1 Mandatory Contract Services Requirements and Deliverables:** Contract Services must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.:
 - **4.1.1** <u>Basal spray</u> application to NNIS vines and shrubs and undesirable native woody trees and shrubs on West Virginia Division of Natural Resources managed property.
 - 4.1.2 <u>Hack and squirt and stump painting</u> application to NNIS and undesirable woody vegetation on West Virginia Division of Natural Resources managed property.
 - **4.1.3** Foliar spray application to NNIS and undesirable woody vegetation to West Virginia Division of Natural Resources managed property.
 - **4.1.4** Must provide all labor and equipment for any or all the three application types outlined in 4.1.1, 4.1.2 and 4.1.3 used in combination per acre on West Virginia Division of Natural Resources managed property.

5. CONTRACT AWARD:

- 5.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Contract Services. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Services meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- **5.2 Pricing Page:** Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by specifying a fee per acre for each WMA. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.



"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.
