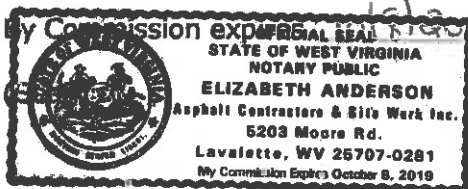

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

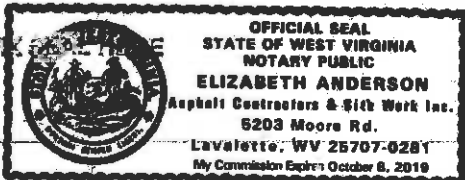

Q.1. We were at the pre-bid yesterday and it was discussed to profile mill all the entrances to the garages and around the drains. We would not mill the entire lot down 2 inches and replace with an 1 ½" of blacktop. This would most likely take away the stability of the lot. We would suggest and I believe the other contractors would agree to profile mill and add the additional 1 ½" to the top of the rest of the parking lot. There were a few areas that needed milled and patching done but not nearly the whole parking lot. We would like to submit for these changes to be made in the Request for Quotation. I did not see where I could send this request in by way of the CRFQ, if there is let me know and I will resubmit this paragraph for all the contractors' comments.

A. After consultation with prospective vendors, it has been determined that the bid specification shall be modified as follows:

The Proposal shall include two (2) inch profile milling of pavement at all edges of the parking lot, at the entrances to the garage facility and around all drains.
