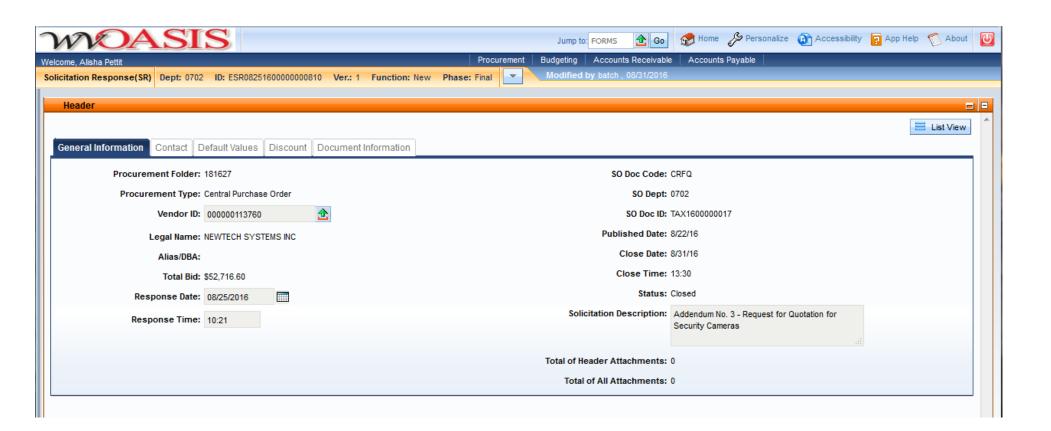

Installed system must have night vision, must have clarity at three hundred (300) feet in total darkness, and must provide three hundred sixty (360) degree coverage of the building exterior, including the parking lots to the side and rear of the building, sidewalks in front of, beside, and behind the building. Existing interior cameras will be replaced and additional interior cameras added. The cameras which are replaced will be sent to Surplus Property for disposition. In addition, the installed system must be capable of being remotely monitored from an off-site location, via a secure IP address.
