DIVISION OF PUBLIC TRANSIT RESPONSES TO SPECIFICATION QUESTIONS

CRFQ PTR 17*1 148" Passenger Type Dual Rear Wheel Tire Van

Request: Request a change to specification 3.21.1 Floor and Floor Covering, "one-piece

wall to wall transit grade floor covering".

Response: The Division will add to 3.21.1.5 "Floor covering shall be slip resistant vinyl

flooring, constructed with aluminum oxide, silicon carbide, quartz and optional PVC chip blended throughout a high quality vinyl wear surface (top coating is not acceptable). Backing to be polyester/cellulose material with fiberglass fiber reinforced center scrim for additional durability. Bacteriostats will be incorporated providing all exposed surface with excellent anti-bacterial properties. Minimum floor thickness of 2.2 millimeters (combination of flooring and backing not acceptable) or equal will be acceptable.

The whole floor will be a uniform thickness throughout the vehicle, eliminating the need for ribbed surfaces, while exceeding the ADA minimum slip resistance standard rating of .06 static coefficient of friction under dry or wet conditions. Covering material is to be installed to support floor when rolling floor covering up the sidewall of vehicle to the seat track.

Seams are to be heat welded to provide a permanent waterproof seal against water penetration leading to premature sub-floor failure or curling leading to possible tripping hazards.

The Division will delete subsections 3.21.1.8 and 3.21.1.10.

Request: Clarification if Section 11.6 Bus Testing FTA requirement applies to this vehicle

since it's a van not a bus?

Response: The Division will remove Section 11.6 FTA Bus Testing requirements.

Request: Clarification of Section 3.16.1.3 requests a double fold outward leaf style door,

but the Ford OEM door is a single sliding door? Which is preferred?

Response: A double fold outward, leaf style door.

Request: Section 3.19.1.3 requests a hooded step well light. Ford OEM does not provide

this light. If the Division is requesting for Ford OEM single sliding door would you

still request this light?

Response: The Division will not accept the sliding door. We are requesting the double fold

outward, leaf style door with a hooded step well light.

Request: Section 3.21.1.9 requests a yellow step edge for the entry steps.

Response: The Division will not accept the sliding door. We are requesting the double fold

outward, leaf style door with a hooded step well light and yellow step edge for

the entry steps.

Request: Section 3.27.1.2 is requesting a Fresnel lens to be mounted on the back window.

The van is to have a rear lift and the Fresnel lens would be hard to use with the

lift installed.

Response: The Division will remove Section 3.27.1.2

Request: Section 4.4 requests a Fixed Route Package and since these items are typical to a

Shuttle Bus is the Agency still asking for these items to be installed on the van?

Response: The Division is requesting a Fixed Route Package except deleting the request for

destination signs as part of the package.

Request: Section 3.28.1 refers to FMVSS 217 which requires a certain number of

emergency exits. Would it be allowed to only install Ford's OEM side emergency

exit as an approved equal instead of the escape/vent hatch in the roof?

Response: Denied, The Division requests the escape/vent hatch be installed.

Request: 3.12.2.1 Specs calls for an electrical distribution panel. The Ford Transit has an

OEM electrical distribution panel. A supplemental panel (like on buses) is not installed in this product. The wheelchair lift circuit breaker is underneath the driver seat where the OEM battery is located. All other circuits are tied in to OEM power and grounded. We request that this specification be removed.

Response: Section 3.12.2.1 can be removed. The OEM electrical distribution panel will be

fine.

incomplete chassis or modified OEM chassis. This bid is for unmodified OEM chassis. We request that this specification be removed or that it be done locally in Charleston, WV. This vehicle comes from Ford and only internal and side door modifications are complete, nothing is done on roof, windows, front or rear

doors.

Response: Section 3.13.1.4 can be removed.

Request: 3.16.1.3.6 Please accept double primed, painted, and clear coated door frame as

equal. At this time a stainless steel assembly is not available.

Response: The Division will accept aluminum, double primed, painted and clear coated door

frame as equal.

Request: 3.16.1.4.10 Pneumatic arm door holders will not function properly on a Ford

Transit. These are more commonly used on small buses. Please approve OEM

magnetic door holders as equal.

Response: The Division will accept magnetic door holders as equal.

Request: 3.16.1.4.12 Back up door locking mechanisms are not available on Ford OEM

doors. We request that this specification be removed.

Response: Section 3.16.1.4.12 can be removed.

Request: 3.20.1.1 OEM headlights are halogen. Please change L.E.D spec to halogen.

Response: The Division will accept halogen headlights.

3.20.1.4 OEM rear turn signal is red. Please change amber spec to red.

Response:

The Division will accept red turn signals on the rear of the vehicle.

Request:

3.21.1.8 & 3.21.1.10 These specifications are requesting modular flooring which will conflict with 3.21.1.5 that specs one piece flooring. We request that these specifications be removed.



We respectfully request a pre-bid conference for this solicitation due to the complexity of the specifications and the substantial amount of information provided by the State of West Virginia which conflicts with products currently available in our marketplace.

Response:

The Division is not requesting a pre-bid conference.

Request:

3.2.1.1: For the 2017 model year, the U4X chassis offers the 3.7L V6 engine as the standard offering. The 3.5L Eco Boost is an option on the van chassis. It is our recommendation to utilize the 3.7L V6 due to the significant upfront cost savings from Ford Motor Company. Would the 3.7L V6 be considered an "as equal" product?

Response:

The Division will allow the 3.7L V6 as an "or equal" product.

Request:

3.2.1.2: The high idle system is not offered by Ford Motor Company. We would utilize an aftermarket system designed by Intermotive. Would this be acceptable?

Response:

The Division will allow Intermotive high idle system.

Request:

3.12.1.11: The clearance and marker lights on the Ford Transit U4X are controlled by the Ford OEM light switch. Would this be acceptable?

Response:

The Ford OEM light switch is acceptable.

Request:

3.13.1.5: Unlike a bus conversion, Ford does not offer roof gutters as an option for the Ford Transit U4X. Would the state consider removing this requirement?

Response:

The Division will remove roof gutters from over passenger windows and drivers windshield. Roof gutters are to be installed on ambulatory door and wheelchair access door.

Request: 3.16.1.3.2: Our van up-fitter would be compliant on the 33" x 76" clear opening

for the transit door from the exterior of the van. Unfortunately with the design of the door header, the vertical clearance exiting the vehicle would only be 66".

back-up door locking mechanism in case the primary door handle fails while the

vehicle in motion. Would the state consider removing this requirement?

Response: The Division will remove Section 3.16.1.4.12.

Request: 3.20.1.1: LED headlamps are not offered by Ford Motor Company on the Ford

Transit U4X. The standard headlamps are halogen. Would this be acceptable to

the state?

Response: The Division will accept halogen headlights.

Request: 3.20.1.7: Could the state please clarify as to how the collision avoidance light is

to operate? We are unsure as to the functionality of the product, and do not

know which product to utilize for our response.

Response: The Division will remove Section 3.20.1.7

Request: 3.20.1.4: The directional signals in the rear of the Ford Transit U4X are

standard red from Ford and not amber in color. Would the state accept the Ford

offering?

Response: The Division will accept red turn signals on the rear of the vehicle.

Request: 3.20.1.5: Ford Motor Company does not offer their Ford Transit U4X with rear

LED stop lights and taillights. Would the state consider removing this

requirement?

Response: The Division will accept OEM stop lights and taillights.

Request: 3.21.1.8: Would the state consider accepting an Altro or Gerflor slip resistant

commercial floor covering? The rubber floor system has become obsolete in this

type of conversion.

Response: The Division will allow Altro or Gerflor slip resistant commercial floor covering.

Request: 3.21.1.10: Would the state consider accepting an Altro or Gerflor slip resistant

commercial floor covering? The rubber floor system has become obsolete in this

type of conversion and there are numerous styles and colors to select from

which can be beneficial to those with visual impairments.

Response: The Division will allow Altro or Gerflor slip resistant commercial floor covering.

Request: 3.24.1.8: All seat legs on the Ford Transit U4X van must be of the 2 leg variety.

Ford Motor Company does not offer the ability to add track seating to their van

front passenger seat to be OEM with arm rest, seat belt and air bags.

Clarification. Delete front passenger seat. Space can be used for farebox, safety

Request: 3.24.1.9: The minimum of 27" for hip to knee spacing will not be possible on the

Ford Transit U4X. The overall interior length will only support a 25" to 26" hip to knee measurement. Would this be acceptable? If not, would the state consider

Request: 3.24.1.9: The aisle width of 16" minimum could not be met with the Ford Transit

It would be impossible to fit four (4) Freedman Mid High Featherweight seats with a 17.5" width across the rear of the van.

Response:

The Division will allow for three (3) Freedman Mid High Featherweight seats with 17.5" width across the rear of the vehicle. See approved alternate floorplan for Class C.

Would the state consider the use of the Ford Transit 350HD cutaway as an option for this solicitation? The overall width of our product offering would be 84" in comparison to the 81" of the Ford Transit U4X van. But when comparing the interior width, the cutaway chassis with a bus body would provide an interior floor width of 80" in comparison to the maximum of 63" available on the Ford Transit U4X.

Response:

The Division has requested an open ended contract for Passenger Type Dual Rear Tire Van with non-raised roof. The Division is not looking for a cutaway vehicle for this particular style of vehicle.



Mr. Rymarz,

Does the new Ford Transit full sized vehicle fall under the below question? We are getting many bids that are FTA funded requesting documentation that the Transit van has been Altoona tested. I would like to be able to go back and let them know that it is not required just as the E-Series van was. We are making zero body modifications to the OEM chassis.

Q. I am trying to purchase two E-350 vans from Ford. The grant person who is my contact wants the Altoona testing certificate from the Ford dealer but the dealer cannot find this information. Does this testing requirement apply

to this type of vehicle?

A. The requirement for Altoona testing would depend on the extent (if any) to which the vans are modified from the stock configuration. If these are unmodified Ford E-350 vans, or they have had only limited modifications (e.g., adding a lift or raised roof) performed in strict compliance with Ford's Vehicle Modification Guidelines, then the Bus Testing Regulation (49 CFR Part 665) would consider them to be "unmodified mass-produced vans" and they would be exempt from Bus Testing ("Altoona testing") requirements if offered in the 4-year/100,000-mile service life category. It sounds as if you would buy the vehicles directly from Ford. If that's the case, these vehicles would likely qualify as unmodified mass-produced vans.

From the FTA Bus Testing page:

Unmodified mass-produced van means a van that is mass-produced, complete and fully assembled as provided by an OEM. This shall include vans with raised roofs, and/or wheelchair lifts, or ramps that are installed by the OEM, or by a



WHAT IS COVERED?

Your NEW VEHICLE LIMITED WARRANTY gives you specific legal rights. You may have other rights that vary from state to state. Under your New Vehicle Limited Warranty if:

- your Ford vehicle is properly operated and maintained, and

- was taken to a Ford dealership for a warranted repair during the warranty period,

then authorized Ford Motor Company dealers will, without charge, repair, replace, or adjust all parts on your vehicle that malfunction or fail during normal use during the applicable coverage period due to a manufacturing defect in factory-supplied materials or factory workmanship.

This warranty does not mean that each Ford vehicle is defect free. Defects may be unintentionally introduced into vehicles during the design and manufacturing processes and such defects could result in the need for repairs. Ford provides the New Vehicle Limited Warranty only to remedy manufacturing defects that result in vehicle part malfunction or failure during the warranty period.

The remedy under this written warranty, and any implied warranty, is limited to repair, replacement, or adjustment of defective parts. This exclusive remedy shall not be deemed to have failed its essential purpose so long as Ford, through its authorized dealers, is willing and able to repair, replace, or adjust defective parts in the prescribed manner. Ford's liability, if any, shall in no event exceed the cost of correcting manufacturing defects as herein provided and upon expiration of this warranty, any such liability shall terminate.

Conditions that are not covered by the New Vehicle Limited Warranty are described on pages 12-15. When making warranty repairs on your vehicle, the dealer will use Ford or Motorcraft parts or remanufactured or other parts that are authorized by Ford, at the discretion of Ford or the Ford dealership.

Nothing in this warranty should be construed as requiring defective parts to be replaced with parts of a different type or design than the original part, so long as the vehicle functions properly with the replacement part. Moreover, Ford and its authorized dealers are entitled to a reasonable time and a reasonable number of attempts within which to diagnose and repair any defect covered by this warranty.

In certain instances, Ford may authorize repairs at other than Ford dealer facilities.

Two separate warranties apply to tires on your new vehicle. The New Vehicle Limited Warranty covers tire defects in factory supplied material or workmanship for 100% of labor costs and on a pro rata adjustment basis for parts. (See the reimbursement schedule below).

For vehicles within the New Vehicle Limited Warranty time in service and mileage coverage period, defective tires will be replaced on a pro rata adjustment basis according to the following mileage-based Reimbursement Schedule:

1-12,000	100%
12,001-24,000	60%
24,001-36,000	30%

The tire manufacturer also provides you with a separate tire warranty that may extend beyond the New Vehicle Limited Warranty coverage. You will find the manufacturer's tire warranty with the owner literature supplied with your vehicle. You have the option of having a tire warranty repair performed by the tire manufacturer's authorized service center. If you go to a tire service center for a repair covered by the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, you may be charged a prorated amount for wear or other charges. If so, you should present your paid invoice detailing the nature of the charges to any Ford Motor Company dealership for refund consideration. When making warranty repairs on your vehicle, the dealer will use Ford or Motorcraft parts or remanufactured or other parts that are authorized by Ford. In certain instances, Ford may authorize repairs at other than Ford dealer facilities. Tire replacements under warranty will be made with the same brand and model as originally equipped with the vehicle unless the same brand and model is no longer available, in which case a tire of the same brand, size, load, speed and tread type will be used. In some circumstances, Ford may authorize another brand and/or model to substitute for the original brand and model, even if still available.

Normal tire wear or damage is not reimbursable. See page 15 for details of what is not covered.

Extended warranty coverage periods are available for certain vehicle parts and conditions. Specifically,

(1) Your vehicle's Powertrain components are covered for five years or 60,000 miles, whichever occurs first. The extended coverage applies to the **Engine**: all internal lubricated parts, cylinder block, cylinder heads, electrical fuel pump, powertrain control module, engine mounts, flywheel, injection pump, manifold (exhaust and intake), manifold bolts, oil pan, oil pump, seals and gaskets, engine thermostat, engine thermostat housing, timing chain cover, timing chain (gears or belt), turbocharger/supercharger unit, valve covers, water pump;

Transmission: all internal parts, clutch cover, seals and gaskets, torque converter, transfer case (including all internal parts), transmission case, transmission mounts; Front-Wheel Drive: axle shafts, front bearings, seals and gaskets, universal and constant velocity joints; Rear-Wheel Drive: axle shafts, rear bearings, center support bearing, drive axle housing (including all internal parts), drive shaft, retainers, supports, seals and gaskets, universal and constant velocity joints.

Four-Wheel/All-Wheel Drive: axle shafts, bearings (front and rear), center support bearing, drive shafts, final drive housing (including all internal parts), hubs-automatic front locking (four-wheel drive), locking rings (four-wheel drive), seals and gaskets, universal and constant velocity joints.

- (2) Your vehicle's safety belts and air bag Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) are covered for an extended Safety Restraint Coverage Period, which lasts for five years or 60,000 miles, whichever occurs first.
- (3) Your vehicle's body sheet metal panels are covered for an extended Corrosion Coverage Period, which lasts for five years, regardless of miles driven. The extended warranty coverage only applies if a body sheet metal panel becomes perforated due to corrosion during normal use due to a manufacturing defect in factory-supplied materials or factory workmanship. If aluminum body panels have corrosion or rust damage, and the damage is not the result of abnormal usage, vehicle accident, customer actions and/or extreme environmental conditions, the corrosion or rust damage repairs are covered for 5 years, unlimited miles. For damage caused by airborne material (environmental fallout) where there is no factory-related defect involved and therefore no warranty our policy is to provide free repair of paint damage due to the airborne material for 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever occurs first.
- (4) Your vehicle's direct injection diesel engine and certain engine components are covered during the PowerStroke Diesel Engine Coverage Period, which lasts for five years or 100,000 miles, whichever occurs first. The following parts are covered during this extended coverage period: the engine, cylinder block, heads and all internal parts, intake and exhaust manifolds, timing gear, harmonic balancer, valve covers, oil pan and pump, water pump, fuel system (excluding fuel lines, fuel tank and frame mounted fuel conditioning module sometimes referred to as the frame mounted pump/filter/water separator or frame mounted fuel filter/water separator), high pressure lines, gaskets and seals, glow plugs, turbocharger, two-stage turbocharger assembly, turbocharger actuator,

powertrain control module, high pressure fuel injection pump assembly, injectors, injection pressure sensor, fuel rail pressure sensor, exhaust back pressure regulator and sensor, exhaust pressure sensor, manifold pressure sensor, intake air temperature sensor, crankshaft position sensor, camshaft position sensor, accelerator switch.

NOTE: Some components may also be covered by the Emissions Warranties. For more information, see pages 17-31.

If you own or lease a 2017-model Next Generation Police Interceptor Vehicle (NGPI), refer to the Warranty Addendum Card that was given to you when you took delivery of your vehicle for further explanation of Amendments to the New Vehicle Limited Warranty. The Warranty Addendum applies only the NGPI vehicles delivered in the State of Florida and New York.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED UNDER THE NEW VEHICLE LIMITED WARRANTY?

Damage Caused By:

- accidents, collision or objects striking the vehicle (including driving through a car wash)
- theft, vandalism, or riot
- fire or explosion
- using contaminated or improper fuel/fluids
- · customer-applied chemicals or accidental spills
- driving through water deep enough to cause water to be ingested into the engine
- misuse of the vehicle, such a driving over curbs, overloading, racing or using the vehicle as a permanent stationary power source

Damage Caused by Alteration or Modification

The New Vehicle Limited Warranty does not cover any damage caused by:

- alterations or modifications of the vehicle, including the body, chassis, electronics or their components, after the vehicle leaves the control of Ford Motor Company
- tampering with the vehicle, tampering with the emissions systems or with the other parts that affect these systems (for example, but not limited to exhaust and intake systems)

- installation of unauthorized software, peripherals and attachments
- unauthorized, unapproved and/or incompatible repairs, upgrades and modification
- the defective function or obsolescence of your cellular phone or digital media device (for example, inadequate signal reception by the external antenna, viruses or other software problems)

Tire Wear or Damage

The New Vehicle Limited Warranty does not cover normal wear or worn out tires. Tires will not be replaced (unless required by a warranty repair) for wear or damage including:

- tire damage from road hazard such as cuts, snags, bruises, bulges, puncture, and impact breaks
- tire damage due to under or over inflation, tire chain use, racing, spinning (as when stuck in snow or mud), improper mounting or dismounting, or tire repair

Other Items or Conditions Not Covered

The New Vehicle Limited Warranty does not cover:

- vehicles that have had the odometer disconnected, altered, or inoperative for an extended period of time with the result that the actual mileage cannot be determined
- vehicles that have ever been labeled or branded as dismantled, fire, flood, junk, rebuilt, reconstructed, or salvaged; this will void the New Vehicle Limited Warranty
- vehicles that have been determined to be a total loss by an insurance company; this will void the New Vehicle Limited Warranty
- converted ambulances that are not equipped with the Ford Ambulance Prep Package, see important information about ambulance conversions (page 36)
- Aftermarket parts or components, sometimes installed by Ford Motor Company or an authorized Ford dealership, may not be covered by the New Vehicle Limited Warranty. Any damage caused to Ford components due to the failure of aftermarket parts (other than a certified emissions part) is not covered.



An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.


