# PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

**CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

**ALL CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

**"Employer default"** means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

**"Related party"** means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

**AFFIRMATION:** By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. **ADDENDUM\_1****Steel Semi Elliptical Dump Body with Hydraulics**

The original language in contract will be listed first with question and answer to follow below.

**1. 3.1.1.3 Dump body inside minimum length – 14 Foot.**

**Question:** The C/A measurement of the chassis (104") and requested 14' body create an overhang of 19-11/16" (see attached layout) The most common overhang in the industry is 12" ... this allows for ideal weight distribution and center of gravity. Would the WVDOH consider shorting the bed to 13'6" to optimize weight distribution?

**Answer:** Yes we will change to read **3.1.1.3: Dump Body inside minimum length – 13'6"**.

**2. 3.1.2.1 Dump Body Long members shall be formed 8-inch (minimum) x 3/8<sup>th</sup> (.375) inch thick.**

**Question # 1:** There are manufacturability issues related to using 3/8" thick material for forming longsills. We recommend 8" x 1/4". Is that acceptable?

**Question # 2:** Would the WVDOH accept 1/4" thick long members with 3/16" Domex internal reinforcements?

**Answer for both questions:** Will change to read: **3.1.2.1 Dump body long members shall be formed 8-inch x 1/4 inch thick with 3/16<sup>th</sup> inch internal reinforcements.**

**3. 3.1.3.1 Dump Body Side Fenders shall be full length bolt on 3/16" (minimum stainless steel or aluminum).**

**Question # 1:** Would the state approve weld on fenders ilo of bolt on? Note: we can bolt on but prefer weld on.

**Question # 2:** Would the WVDOH accept welded on stainless steel fenders?

**Answer:** Yes, we will accept.

**4. 3.1.4.1 Dump Body top rails shall be structural 4 inch x 4 inch x ¼ (.250) inch square tubing (minimum) 12.21 pounds per foot (minimum)**

**Question:** Would the WVDOH accept a 4'x3"x1/4" tube?

**Answer:** Yes, we will accept.

**5. 3.1.5.1 Dump body shall have a minimum of (1) one horizontal side brace.**

**Question:** In our opinion the side brace on this style of elliptical body is not required for the additional strength normally provided by a side brace on a square body. This adds unnecessary weight and cost. Would the state consider deleting this specification?

**Note:** we can add the side brace if WVDOH wants to keep in the spec.

**Answer:** Leave as written

**6. 3.1.12.1 Dump body rear bolster shall be minimum ¼ (.250) AR450 steel full depth and width.**

**Question # 1:** It is our experience AR450 cannot be formed with 90 degree bends as it will crack. We recommend either ¼" GR50 or ¼" 409SS. Would the state consider modifying this specification?

**Question # 2:** The rear bolster is integral to the rear stability of any dump body design and must be made of softer more flexible steel than AR450. AR450 is too brittle and too stiff therefore it won't flex with the body when loaded and traveling down the road. Ultimately, the rear assembly will eventually give-way prematurely. Would the WVDOH accept ¼" 44 W material in the rear bolster.

**Answer:** We will change this to read: 3.1.12.1 Dump body rear bolster shall be minimum (.250) ¼ inch GR50 steel or (.250) ¼ inch 409SS full depth and width or equal.

**7. 3.1.16.1 Hydraulic Hoist shall be a Mailhot CS130-6.5-4 or equal trunnion mounted not to extend in bed over 10 inches maximum. Shall be double acting power up/power down fully operable with truck hydraulics.**

**Question:** Would the WVDOH accept a trunnion mounted cylinder that extends into the bed 12 inches?

**Answer:** Yes, we will accept.

**8. 3.1.22.1 Hoses with SS quick disconnects shall be run to left front side of truck to operate plow Left/Right, Up and Down.**

**Question:** What type of disconnect does the WVDOH use?

**Answer:** NPT Stainless Steel Quick Couplers or equal.

**9. 3.1.22.2 Hoses and SS tubing shall be run to rear of chassis to run the spreader conveyor and spinner with SS quick disconnects.**

**Question:** What type of disconnect does the WVDOH use?

**Answer:** NPT Stainless Steel Quick Couplers or equal.

**10. 6.1 Delivery Time: Vendor shall deliver standard orders within 60 working days after order are received. A completed pilot model for inspection must be provided within 60 working days after receipt of the purchase agreement.**

**Question:** Is it assumed that all chassis are available at the installation site at time the purchase agreement is received? Would the state consider 90 days ARO for pilot model inspection? The bid is started at 20 units; therefore, asking consideration of remaining units be delivered with-in 90-120 days after pilot approval.

**Answer:** Standard orders 60 days, Pilot 90 days.
