1. What Mile Posts can we clear up our equipment that can hold a tie gang and what Mile Posts can handle just the surfacing crew (smaller siding)?
Grace Cabin MP 8.7 – 420 feet capacity
Vanderlip MP 16.9 – 420 feet capacity

We do not know what each contractor may use so we gave the track capacity in feet.

2. Who will dump the ballast? Will the ballast be dumped before or after the track surfacing?

SBVR will dump the ballast. The plan is to dump the ballast after the tie installation and before The surfacing.

3. Is it anticipated that the track surfacing can be done in one Pass? YES

4. Page 27 shows that Davis Bacon wage rates (Prevailing Wage) are not required to be paid on this project. Is this correct? YES

1. Are we to assume ties to be changed will be on the average of 600/mile? **No**
2. Will replacement be 1 out of every 5 or will some be in groups requiring multiple passes?
99% will be no more than 2 consecutive ties changed
3. Will the Railroad assist for any hand raising if required on Turnouts? Or should we figure our own labor for that task? **No – The Contractor is responsible**
4. What is percentage of ties that will be replaced in cut areas where a “whole” tie cannot be removed?
**Total distance of cut areas about 1.5 miles.
Each cut section is about 1/10 mile.**

MP 11.5 – MP 11.6 is the tightest area. Cut on east side, west side is a retaining wall. 16” from end of ties and 6” to 12” above top of ties

Took measurements at the northwest spot in each section with the tightest being, from field side of East Rail to bank 4’ and West rail 5’. 4 feet above rail East rail to bank 5’ and West Rail 7.5’.

The average measurement of all the tightest location in each section is:

**East side 5.5’ rail to bank
East side 8’ – 4 feet above rail to bank
West side 5.5’ rail to bank
West side 7.5’ – 4 feet above rail to bank**
