The purpose of this addendum is to modify the solicitation identified as CRFQ RMA1800000007 to reflect the change(s) identified and described below.

Description of Modification to Solicitation:

1. To publish Vendor questions and Agency responses.
2. The bid opening has moved from 06/05/2018 to 06/13/2018. The bid opening time remains at 1:30 pm.

Additional Documentation: Documentation related to this Addendum (if any) has been included herewith as Attachment A and is specifically incorporated herein by reference.

Terms and Conditions:

1. All provisions of the Solicitation and other addenda not modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.
2. Vendor should acknowledge receipt of all addenda issued for this Solicitation by completing an Addendum Acknowledgment, a copy of which is included herewith. Failure to acknowledge addenda may result in bid disqualification. The addendum acknowledgement should be submitted with the bid to expedite document processing.

Questions and Answers**

Q1. Are there any requirements for prevailing wages at the State, County or local levels?

A1. NO

Q2. Will there be any cost for railroad provided flagging, on track protection or authority?

A2. NO

Q3. Is the award of the work all or none?

A3. Yes – This will be awarded as one project.

Q4. Are materials tax exempt?

A4. No tax is added to the bottom line of the contract because SRA/SBVR is a tax exempt government agency. However, the tax exemption does not go to the contractor, so any materials purchased by the contractor are NOT tax exempt.

Q5. In the RFQ document/form the quantities are listed as 0 Ea.?

A5. The quantity is 1(one) for each line with each line equating to all work per bridge as detailed in Exhibit B

Q6. Exhibit B lists replace pile 4 bent 2, 2 braces at span 1 and shims at bents 11 & 14, the RFQ document/form says replace bent?

A6. Exhibit B is the detail for all work, the RFQ document is simply a brief description.

Q7. Can a copy of the track chart/profile extending 1 mile beyond each end of the milepost project limits be provided?

A7. Yes - Attached

Q8. Can you please confirm the Agency name and the REQ.P.O# for the bond?

A8. The Agency name for bid submission is the Department of Administration, Purchasing Division. The number is CRFQ 0804 RMA18*7.

Questions and Answers

Q9. What is the anticipated start and completion date?

A9. There is no way to anticipate the start date due to unknown circumstances. But the vendor will have 365 days from “Notice to Proceed” to complete the project.

Q10. Is railroad protective liability insurance required?

A10. No – All required insurance is outlined in the Terms & Conditions document

Q11. Is there a material specification available for the wood products and fasteners to be used?

A11. All materials must meet AREMA specifications.

Q12. Bridge 8.5, “Replace Post 1 at Bent 4” Is it post 1 on Bent 4A or 4B or both?

A12. Both

Q13. RFQ document/form line 2, BR 9.7 add helper stringers, what is the proposed method for blocking to match the elevation of the existing shared corbel blocks?

A13. The same size corbel blocks as existing. If there are any discrepancies, shims will be used to establish proper elevation, if needed.

Q14. Bridge 9.7, Add a stringer to go from 3 ply to 4 ply: Do we need to install additional corbels under the stringers?

A14. Yes

Q15. Bridge 9.7, Add a stringer to go from 3 ply to 4 ply: Do we add the stringer to the outside of the existing stringers?

A15. Yes

Q16. Bridge 9.7, Add a stringer to go from 3 ply to 4 ply: Is there a hardware detail? Do we need to remove the existing hardware joining the existing 3 plys together?

A16. Yes – the existing hardware will have to be removed. New hardware will be put in the same holes if possible. There is no hardware detail. Hardware should meet AREMA standards.

Questions and Answers

Q17. Bridge 9.7, Add a stringer to go from 3 ply to 4 ply: The notes say to estimate 40 - 8" x 16" x 24' stringers, most of the spans are 12' 10", this will not allow for 24' materials to splice over bearing, please advise.

A17. To clarify, all spans are 12' or less with the exception of the first span on the south end which will require a 14' stringer. The statement in this question about most are 12' 10" is incorrect, we remeasured for accuracy.

Q18. On BR 9.7, will the stringer chords need to be centered under the rail after the 4th stringer is added?

A18. Two of the three existing will be moved because the spacers between the stringers will be removed, but the center one does not have to be moved.

Q19. On BR 9.7, will the contractor need to add longer chord bolts and repack the chords after the 4th stringer is added or will the 4th stringer just be added and pinned on the outside?

A19. Add the longer chord bolts and repack the chords after the 4th stringer is added.

Q20. On BR 9.7, will extra corbel blocks be required when adding the 4th stringer to maintain proper bearing?

A20. Yes

Q21. In 13.1.5.2 BR 23.2, the requirement of the 2 new end piers, are these to be constructed using Timber or Concrete?

A21. Timber in kind will be used. Refer to the drawing in Attachment A. Since only two piers will be remaining, contractor will add X bracing, pier to pair.

Q22. Do you have any plans, specs or drawings for what you are wanting for end piers on BR 23.2?

A22. Refer to answer 21

Q23. In reference to the installation of the Gabion Baskets for BR 23.2, are there any spec's pertaining to elevation for the bottom row, how many baskets per row and how many rows?

A23. The bottom row will start 9' 6" below the bottom of the ties.

Q24. Are there any specs for the fill, size and quantity of the fill stone, for the baskets for BR 23.2?

A24. Gabion basket fill is _____. Shot rock and crusher run can be used for fill.

Q25. Do you have estimated quantities for the river rock to be placed along the face of the baskets on BR 23.2?

A25. There is nothing to be placed on face (outside) of baskets.

Q26. Are there any compaction specs for track beds on BR 23.2?

A26. Nominal compaction – No target amount

Q27. During the pre-bid we noticed a black cable running under and along the bottom of BR 23.2, is the origin known and will it need to be relocated?

A27. It's a simple water line and it does not have to be relocated.

Q28. Will there be a track outage for this conversion for BR 23.2? IF so, how long? If not, what will the work windows be?

A28. Work for BR 23.2 cannot be planned in October because excursion trains run daily. Any other month, we should be able to accommodate a three day window, but the three days will be dependent on train schedule.

Q29. Who will be performing the track work for BR 23.2?

A29. Contractor

Q30. Will the contractor reuse the existing rail & tie plates to build the track where the bridge is going to be filled in on BR 23.2?

A30. Yes

Q31. Should the contractor plan using new 8' 6" standard hardwood crossties with end plates where BR 23.2 will be removed in place of the bridge ties?

A31. Yes

Q32. BR 23.2 – Has any design work been completed for the concrete pier extensions? How will the new concrete attach to the existing? Rebar, details etc

A32. Refer to answer 21 – Concrete will not be used

Q33. RFQ document/form line 7, BR 23.2, the plans show details for the gabion baskets, what are the details for the new end piers? Also, the work scope in Exhibit B differs from the RFQ document/form?

A33. For piers refer to answer 21 –
Exhibit B is the detail of scope, RFQ line item is a brief description

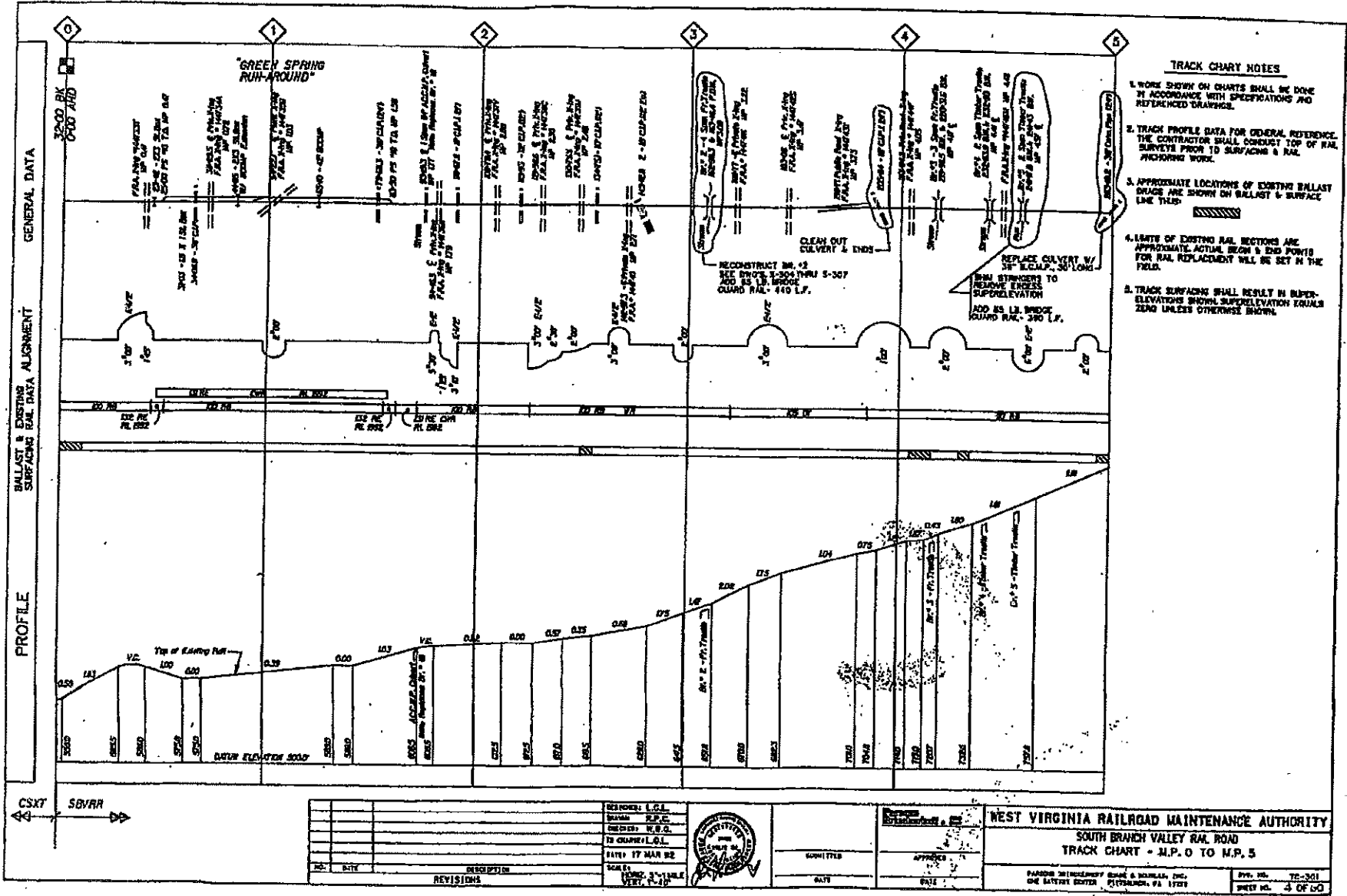

TRACK CHART - M.P. 0 TO M.P. 5

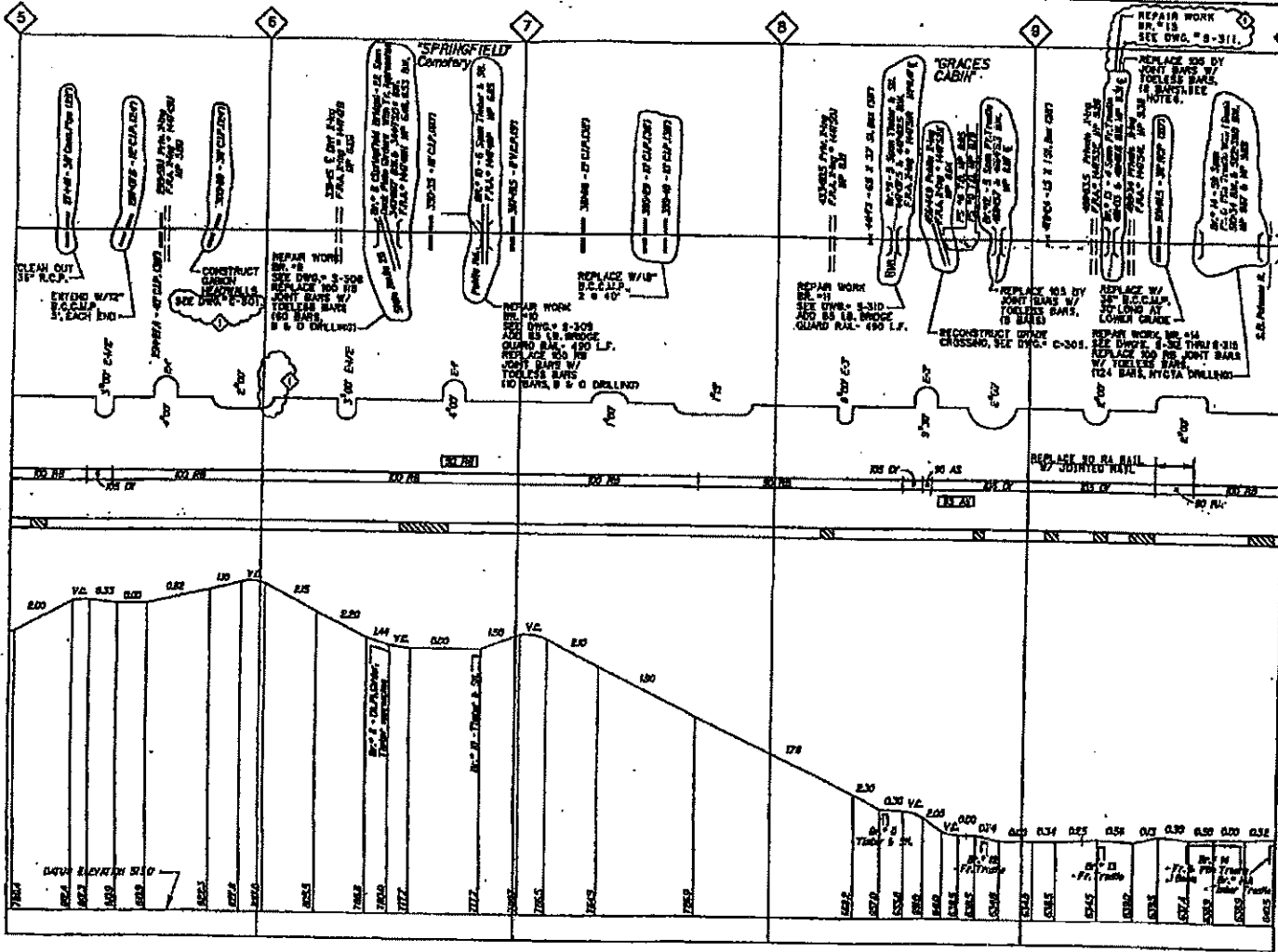

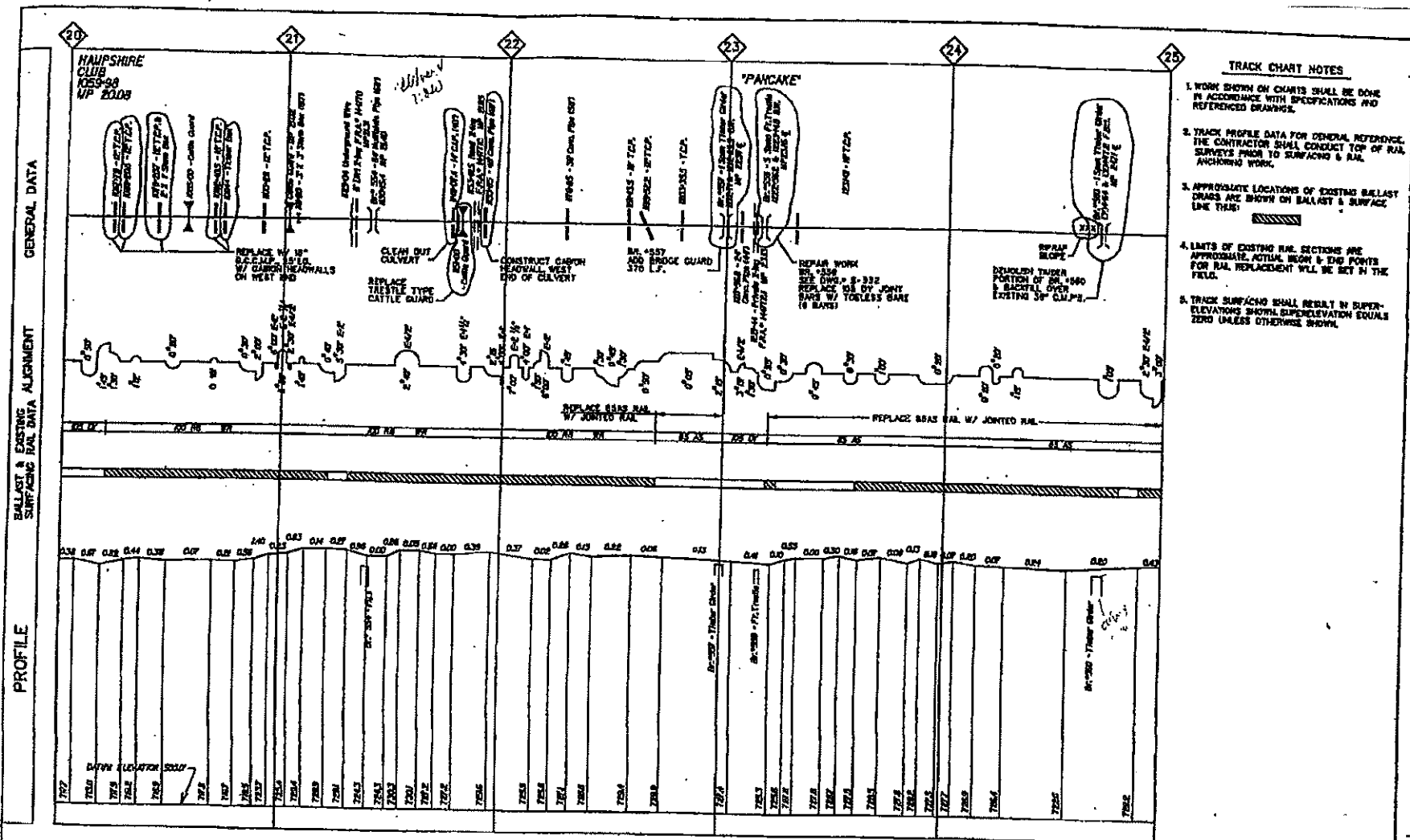

This list has been provided for informational purposes only and is not to be construed as a complete list of request for quotation or bidding requirements for any individual construction project. This list does not and cannot include every item, mistake or oversight that could cause a contractor's bid to be disqualified. Rather, this list is intended to draw attention to some of the most common problems that the Purchasing Division encounters in the bidding process for construction projects. All potential bidders must read the request for quotation, all additional documents, and all instructions relating thereto ("Bid Documents") in their entirety to identify the actual request for quotation and bidding requirements. Failure to read the Bid Documents in their entirety and comply with the stated requirements contained therein may result in bid disqualification.

Errors That Shall Be Reason for Immediate Bid Disqualification

1. Failure to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting
2. Failure to sign the bid
3. Failure to supply a valid bid bond or other surety approved by the State of West Virginia
4. Failure to meet any mandatory requirement of the RFQ
5. Failure to acknowledge receipt of Addenda (only if stipulated as mandatory)
6. Failure to submit bid prior to the bid opening date and time
7. Federal debarment
8. State of West Virginia debarment or suspension

Errors that May Be Reason for Bid Disqualification Before Contract Award

1. Debt to the State or Political Subdivision (must be cured prior to award)
2. Workers' Compensation or Unemployment Compensation delinquency (must be cured prior to award)
3. Not registered as a vendor with the State (must be cured prior to award)
4. Failure to obtain required bonds and/or insurance
5. Failure to provide the sub-contractor listing within one business day of bid opening or one business day of the request to do so by the Purchasing Division.
6. Failure to supply West Virginia contractor's license number with bid or within one day of Purchasing Division request to do so.
7. Failure to supply a signed drug free workplace affidavit with bid or within one day of Purchasing Division request to do so.
8. Failure to use the provided RFQ form (only if stipulated as mandatory).
