

- Question #1: Regarding RFQ SWC19*2, MVTRUCK19, I would ask for clarification of the trailer brake requirement in Classes 17, 18A, 18B, 19A and 19B. A 7 Pin wiring harness provided the ability to connect the trailer brake controller as well as the lights to the trailer. The trailer brake controller itself is not "(included in wiring)" as indicated in the specification. Please clarify if your intent is for the vendor to provide both the 7-pin wiring and the trailer brake controller.
- Answer #1: The specifications for Class 17 will be changed to the following: "Tow Package Installed Receiver Hitch & 7-pin wiring, Trailer Tow Side Electric Mirrors, Factory Installed Electric Trailer Brake Controller".

The specifications for Classes 18A, 18B, 19A, and 19B will be changed to the following: "Tow Package – Towing Harness, Trailer Tow Side Electric Mirrors, Factory Installed Electric Trailer Brake Controller".

- Question #2: Also, for Classes 18A, 18B, 19A, and 19B, please note that while 7-pin wiring can be provided on these chassis cab trucks, the plug used to hook the truck to the trailer wiring will not be present. This is typically provided by the company who upfits the body and mounts the wiring plug in the proper location on the body. A power take-off provision would helpful or necessary for many upfit applications.
- Answer #2: Please see the response for Question #1 for the Tow Package revisions.
 - "Additional Requirements PTO take-off provision". (requirement has been added to these classifications).
- Questions #3: For these four classes, I would urge you to provide a space for the vendor to enter a bid for these trucks with a gasoline engine as well as the diesel engine which is already requested. This change would require you to alter the specifications listed for the engine on the pricing pages including reducing the engine size to 6.2L, the torque to 426 lb./ft. and expanding the axle ration range to 4.30.
- Answer #3: The State does not wish to include a gasoline engine option for Classes 18A, 18B, 19A, and 19B in this solicitation.
