- **4.1.9.5** Saw height will be recorded to the nearest half log and entered as follows: 15 for a 1.5 log tree.
- **4.1.9.6** All merchantable heights will be measured with a laser hypsometer;
- 4.1.9.7 Yellow-poplar & cucumber may have "Peeler" designations; these have to be at minimum of 8" DIB for top diameter & should be relatively straight & free of defect.

4.1.10 Pulp Height

4.1.10.1 Pulpwood is recorded to a minimum top diameter of 4" (DOB);

4.1.10.2 Pulpwood height will be recorded in 8' bolts;

4.1.10.3 Minimum pulp height is two 8' bolts;

4.1.10.4 Pulp maximum DBH is 22";

4.1.10.5 All pulp heights will be measured with a laser hypsometer
