

The original language in contract will be listed first with question and answer to follow below.

1. 3.1.1.4 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.

Question #1: Request date of Manufacture for tractor changed to a 2019 or 2020 machine.

Question #2: What if tractor is produced before Jan 1, 2020?

Answer: Question #1. Will accept.

Question #2. Will accept

2. 3.1.1.2 Wheelbase shall be 90 inches minimum.

Question: Will you accept Wheelbase of 88.6 inches?

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

3. 3.1.6.3 Shall have minimum 1200 cold cranking amp (CCA)

Question #1: Is a battery with 140 Ah fine? Standard battery is only 800 CCA

Question #2: This RFQ specifies that the state wants a four (4) Wheel Drive Tractor John Deere 5100M or Equal. We are requesting that the listed specification 3.1.6.3 be corrected to have a minimum 925 CCA battery, which more accurately describes the current model year 2020 production of the John Deere 5100M Tractor.

Answer: Question #1 No. Will change 3.1.6.3 to read shall have a minimum 900 Cold cranking amps (CCA) with matching Ah rating for battery size

Question #2 Will change 3.1.6.3 to read shall have a minimum 900 Cold cranking amps (CCA) with matching Ah rating for battery size.

4. 3.1.9.1 Unit shall have Whelen IX4AC liberty II LED amber and white lightbar or equal, mounted on the top rear center of cab protection.

Answer: The Equipment Division will be removing section 3.1.9.1, we will be installing our own light bar.

5. 3.1.11.2 Shall be equipped with a de-clutch button on gear shift lever, requiring no foot clutch usage while shifting range gears.

Question: Is a de-clutch button required?

Answer: Yes. Leave as written.

6. 3.1.12.1 Shall have power shift design, power shuttle provides powershifting through the gears of each range and must have a transmission that can be shifted on the go within the speed gears.

Question: Transmission - The RFQ specifies that the state wants a Four (4) Wheel Drive Utility Tractor John Deere 5100M or Equal. We are requesting that the listed specification 3.1.12.1 be corrected to include a John Deere PowrReverser Transmission, which more accurately describes the current model year 2020 production of the John Deere 5100M Tractor. The PowerReverser transmission has 4 ranges with partial synchronization between ranges and allows the speed gears to be shifted on the go within each range. See below for more details.

Answer: Will accept John deere PowerReverser transmission.

- 7. 3.1.19.1 Front tire shall be minimum 340/85R24 R1W radial or equal.
- 3.1.19.2 Rear tires shall be minimum 18.4R30 R1W radial or equal.

Question #1: Are 13.6R28 front tires fine?

Question #2: Are 18.4R34 rear tires fine?

Question #3: This front tire is larger than Tiger recommends and may cause a clearance issue. Will the state change the specification to allow 11.2x24 radial front tires to insure compatibility?

Question # 4: This rear tire is larger than Tiger recommends. Will the state change the specification to allow 16.9x30 radial rear tires to insure compatibility?

Question # 5: To ensure mower compatibility we are respectfully asking that the specification be changed to allow for 280/85R24 (11.2 x 24) R1W Radial front tires or a 320/85R24 (12.4R24) R1W front tire, whichever one is compatible with the boom mower.

Question # 6: To ensure mower compatibility we are respectfully asking that the specification be changed to allow for 420/85R30 (16.9 x 30) R1W Radial rear tires 460/85R30 (18.4 x 30) R1W radial rear tire, whichever one is compatible with the boom mower.

Question: 7:We are requesting that you change the minimum front tire code to 320/85R24 (12.4R24) so that the ratio matches the minimum 18.4R30 rear tire code in the next section (3.1.19.2)

Question #8: 3.1.19.1 – In a boom mowing application, slight variations in front tire diameter can drastically affect the turning radius of the boom mowing package. Can 320/85R24 tires be supplied on the front tires to optimize turning radius, tread wear, and stability.

Answer: Will change 3.1.19.1 to read front tires shall be minimum 280/85R24 (11.2x24)R1W radial or equal.

Will change 3.1.19.2 to read tires shall be minimum 420/85R30 (16.9x30)

8. 3.1.20.9 Lift arm cylinders shall be mounted externally and be a min 68 millimeters diameter

Question: - Lift arm cylinders - The RFQ specifies that the state wants a Four (4) Wheel Drive Utility Tractor John Deere 51000M or Equal. We are requesting that the listed specification 3.1.20.9 be changed to EITHER (#1) Lift arm cylinders shall be mounted externally and be a min of 65mm or (#2) Lift Arm cylinders shall be mounted externally and shall have an AVERAGE minimum diameter of 68mm." This will more accurately describe the current model year 2020 production of the John Deere 5100M Tractor where one cylinder is 65mm and the other cylinder is 75mm, averaging 70mm.

Answer: Answer: Will revise 3.1.20.9 to read Lift arm cylinders shall be mounted externally.

9. 3.1.21.3 Cab shall have Poly-shield or equal on right side 1/2 inch thick minimum with anti-scratch coating on both sides, installed into the original cab manufactured door and side window. Windows shall be tinted at all locations.

Question: A. Industry standard for right hand polycarbonate windows on boom mowing tractors is 3/8-inch thick. Will 3/8-inch thickness be acceptable?

Answer: No. Leave as written.

10. 3.1.21.4 Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, air conditioning and standard AM/FM radio with Bluetooth and shall be installed by the manufacturer.

Question: We politely ask that you change the language to: Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, and air conditioning and shall be installed by the manufacturer. An AM/FM radio with Bluetooth shall be installed.

Answer: Yes. Will revise to read: Cab unit shall be equipped with heater, defroster, air conditioning installed by manufacturer. A Jensen SWJHD1635BT or equal AM/FM radio with Bluetooth shall also be installed.

11. 3.1.21.8 Seat shall have a height and swivel adjustment and be heated.

Question: Is seat swivel required?

Answer: Yes. Leave as written.

12. 3.2.2.1 Frame shall be mid-mounted to underside of tractor utilizing a center weldment adequately bolted to the tractor and 3 ½-inch x 3 ½- inch x 1/8 inch-minimum dual rear axle braces for maximum stability and weight transfer.

Question: The dual axle braces for the Bengal 18' boom mower mounted on the John Deere 5100M are 3" x 3" x $\frac{1}{4}$ ". By using $\frac{1}{2}$ " smaller tubular steel and increasing the wall thickness from 1/8" to $\frac{1}{4}$ " we obtain the required strength to support the main frame and the boom rest properly. A 3" x 3" x $\frac{1}{4}$ " tube has a section modulus of 2.107 in³, which is greater than the section modulus of a 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" x 1/8" tube at 1.766 in³. Will the state change the specification to allow 3" x 3" x $\frac{1}{4}$ " dual rear axle braces?

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

13. 3.2.2.2 Unit shall be counterweighted to maintain the most possible ground pressure of tires on opposite side of mower during all reach out, up, and down operations of boom with specified head. Rear tire that holds counterweight shall be filled with beet juice, water or calcium filled will not be accepted.

Question: Will you accept windshield washer fluid to replace beet juice?

Answer: No. Leave as written.

14. 3.2.4.2 An axle boom stow system constructed of minimum ¼-inch x 4-inch x 4-inch square tubing minimum with water drain holes and shall be mounted to the mower frame with frame member extending to the axle mounts. 3-point hitch system shall function normally.

Question: Due to the fact that the 5100M is a smaller framed tractor and the 18 ft. boom does not require a 4" x 4" x 1/4" square tubing to adequately support the boom when in the stow position, Tiger uses a 3" x 3" x 1/4" tubing, which will have sufficient support and structure for this shorter boom mower. Will the state change the specification to allow a 3" x 3" x 1/4" 3OS design boom stow system?

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

15. 3.2.5.1 Boom shall be minimum two (2) piece design, with all hinge points of the arm and mast shall have minimum 2-inch diameter steel pins with greaseable, replaceable steel bushings. Kingpost or Turret style mounting is acceptable.

Question #1: The Bengal 18' boom mower Tiger offers a 2 ½" Vertical pin for the boom swivel bracket and has 1 ½" pins for the boom pivot points. Will the state change the specification to allow for 2 ½" vertical swivel bracket pin and 1 ½" steel boom pivot pin?

Question #2: Please change the pin diameter to minimum 1 1/2 inch as we build our pins out of AISI 1045 steel with a Brinell Hardness ranging between 170 and 210 which is higher than conventional ASTM A36 carbon steel.

Answer: Question #1. Will accept.
Question #2. Will accept.

16. 3.2.5.4 Dipper boom shall be made of 6-inch x 4-inch x 1/4-inch steel tubing minimum, with a 50,000 lb. per square inch minimum yield strength.

Question: Please include 5-inch x 5-inch x 1/4-inch steel tubing as an alternate material. We construct our dipper booms out of ASTM A500 GR.50 structural tubing that meets the 50,000 psi minimum yield strength requirement and features a minimum tensile strength of 62,000 psi. Furthermore, the equilateral shape provides greater strength in the vertical plane than a 6" x 4" tube.

Answer: Will accept.

17. 3.2.5.5 All hinge points shall be T-1 steel reinforcement.

Question: Since T-1 is a trade name, could you consider rewriting the specification to read, All hinge points shall include High Strength Low Alloy (HSLA) steel reinforcement.

Answer: Yes. Will change to read: All hinge points shall be high strength low alloy steel reinforced.

18. 3.2.6.2 Top deck shall be A606 alloy steel 10 gauges or equal.

Question: Will the state change the specification as follows to allow for this rotary deck?

Note: This is the same verbiage used in CRQF 20*53, 3.2.6.2

Top deck shall be 110,000 PSI yield Domex® or equal 1/8-inch thick minimum, continuously welded for strength.

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

19. 3.2.6.3 Side skirts shall be a minimum of 3/8-inch steel.

Question: Will the state change the specification as follows to allow for ¼" side skirt? Note: This is the same verbiage used in CRQF 20*53, 3.2.6.3

Side Skirts shall be a minimum of 1/4 inch steel.

Bengal boom mower side skirts are constructed of 110,000 PSI yield Domex® steel ¼" thick side skirts.

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

20. 3.2.6.6 Spindle bearings shall be tapered roller type in a sealed housing, to support 4 ½-inch minimum diameter spindle drive shaft.

Question: Will the state change the specification as follows to allow this spindle? Note: This is the same verbiage used in CRQF 20*53, 3.2.6.6

The 60" rotary mower deck has a one piece forged and heat-treated spindle. It has an integral 7 1/4" O.D. drive hub.

Answer: Yes. Will accept.

21. 6.1 Delivery Time: Delivery Time: A completed pilot model for inspection must be provided within 120 working day(s) after receipt of the pilot model order, by the successful vendor. Vendor shall deliver standard orders within 180 working days after orders are received Working day is defined as any week day, Monday thru Friday, excluding Federal and State Holidays. Vendor shall ship all orders until a minimum delivery quantity is met.

Question # 1: Is this 180 working days after the Pilot is accepted?

Question #2: We would ask that the delivery be extended by 30 working days, so 150 working days for the pilot model and 210 working days for the balance.

Answer: Question #1. After the pilot is accepted you have 180 days to fill orders placed.

Question #2. Yes. Will accept

- 3.2.3.10 Mower cutter shall have an 8 second maximum emergency shutdown.
- 3.2.3.11 Mower head motor shall take 6 seconds minimum to wind up to full RPM for a "no-shock-load startup".
- 3.2.3.12 Mower shall have an electric solenoid operated hydraulic lock valve incorporated in the head tilt function to prevent cylinder leak down during storage or transportation
- 3.2.3.13 Hydraulic system shall be equipped with oil-to-air cooler with integrated electric fan
- 3.2.3.14 The model bid will have been in the manufacturers model line for a minimum of one (1) year(s) of production time prior to bid.
- **3.2.4 Boom Rest** The following are mandatory items related to the boom rest.

- 3.2.4.1 When in stow, tractor and mower shall be maximum 133-inches width, with 60-inch rotary mower, and 12-foot-high maximum.
- 3.2.4.2 An axle boom stow system constructed of minimum ¼-inch x 4-inch x 4-inch square tubing minimum with water drain holes and shall be mounted to the mower frame with frame member extending to the axle mounts. 3-point hitch system shall function normally.

- 3.2.6.10 Hydraulic Motor shall be cast steel and shall be sized to match the hydraulic pump proposed by the mower manufacturer.
- 3.2.6.11 Brush head shall be required to have a front safety shield, hydraulic actuated, center feed metal door operational from joystick control or on main control panel.
- 3.2.6.12 Cutter deck tilt rotation shall be 160 degrees minimum.
- 3.2.6.13 Rear shield shall be full width rubber/fabric material.
- 3.2.7 Paint The following are mandatory items related to the color.
 - 3.2.7.1 Mower shall be manufacturer's standard color.
- **3.2.8 Miscellaneous** The following mandatory items are related to the mower.
 - 3.2.8.1 Complete unit shall be delivered with all manufacturers' safety features intact.

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- 3.2.8.2 The unit specified herein and offered shall be manufactured on or after January 1, 2020 and will be clearly identified and marked with date of manufacture.
- 3.2.8.3 Unspecified Accessories & Features: All parts, equipment, accessories, material, design and performance characteristics not specified herein, but which are necessary to provide a complete unit, must be furnished with each unit and required to conform to strength, quality of material, and quality of workmanship to those which are advertised and provided to the market in general by the unit industry. All parts and accessories advertised and regularly supplied as standard shall be included, except those which would represent duplication of these specified and except those which, by specification, are not to be furnished. All standard safety features, required by Federal and State Law, shall be included.

3.3 Vendor

3.3.1 Vendor Responsibility:

- 3.3.1.1 The vendor is responsible to furnish a 4-wheel drive tractor with a mid-mounted 18-FT articulated boom mower with 60" rotary cutting head that is properly engineered and that confirms to all and any laws governing such equipment.
- 3.3.1.2 Inspection: WVDOH requires unit shall have a West Virginia State inspection sticker upon delivery, if applicable.

3.3.2 Representative Unit for Test:

3.3.2.1 The successful vendor must (if specified) provide the DOH one (1) completed represented unit to be observed and evaluated on each order to ensure compliance with specification. If requested, the time period for testing and evaluation shall be seven (7) working days following receipt of the unit. DOH will incur no obligation for deterioration of surfaces, finishes, seals, and mechanical or electrical parts on the unit resulting from operation and testing within the limits of these specifications; nor will DOH incur obligation for damage to the unit resulting from failure to

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meet specifications when due care and attention is given by DOH and testing is done within the limits of these specifications. Failure of the pilot unit to satisfactorily meet specifications as bid may be cause for cancellation of the purchase order and return of the delivered unit along with all associated equipment to the vendor at the vendor's expense.

3.3.3 Operating and Service Manuals and Parts Lists:

3.3.3.1 An operator's manual must be included with each unit upon delivery. A "line sheet" (if applicable) and the "Equipment Preventative Maintenance Questionnaire", (Exhibit "B") must be with pilot unit upon delivery, Attn: Todd Campbell. There must be 12 service/shop/maintenance manuals and 14 parts manuals; USB storage drive is preferred in lieu of parts manuals. Manuals and USB storage drive shall be delivered upon completion of delivery of total units. Failure to do so will delay payment.

3.3.4 Training:

3.3.4.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to stage a thorough seminar on the subjects of Preventative Maintenance, Operator, and Mechanic Training. In order to keep operators and mechanics updated, the successful vendor shall conduct training sessions covering the operation, maintenance, trouble-shooting with each purchase order against this open-end contract.

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3.3.5 Preventative Maintenance & Operator Procedures:

3.3.5.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to submit to the Equipment Division, in addition to the operating and service manuals, booklets and pamphlets explaining the Preventative Maintenance and Operator Procedures to be used by the operators of this equipment, and must include such things as daily prestart inspection procedure, service schedule, and routine maintenance required, safety precautions, etc. The successful vendor shall furnish all training aids; i.e. videos, projectors as required in conducting the training.

3.3.6 Warranty and Service Policy:

3.3.6.1 The bid shall include a breakdown of the complete manufacturer's warranty per section. The unit must be accompanied upon delivery by the unit's manufacturers executed warranty and service policy.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- 4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.

Vendor shall include the cost of standard order delivery charges in its bid pricing/discount and is not permitted to charge the Agency separately for such delivery. The Agency will pay delivery charges on all emergency orders provided that Vendor invoices those delivery costs as a separate charge with the original freight bill attached to the invoice.
- 6.4 Condition of Unit(s) Upon Delivery: All units must arrive at the prescribed delivery point having been completely pre-serviced with oil, lubricants, and coolant. All prescribed precautions pertaining to first operations and breaking of the unit are to be posted conspicuously on the unit for ready observance by the operator.
- 6.5 Delivery Point: Delivery point of the completed representative unit will be the WVDOH, Equipment Division, Rt. 33 and Brushy Fork Road, Buckhannon, WV 26201.

7. VENDOR DEFAULT:

- 7.1 The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.
 - 7.1.1 Failure to provide Contract Items in accordance with the requirements contained herein.
 - 7.1.2 Failure to comply with other specifications and requirements contained herein.
 - 7.1.3 Failure to comply with any laws, rules, and ordinances applicable to the Contract Services provided under this Contract.
 - 7.1.4 Failure to remedy deficient performance upon request.
- 7.2 The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
 - 7.2.1 Immediate cancellation of the Contract.
 - 7.2.2 Immediate cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.

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7.2.3 Any other remedies available in law or equity.

8. MISCELLANEOUS:

- 8.1 No Substitutions: Vendor shall supply only Contract Items submitted in response to the Solicitation unless a contract modification is approved in accordance with the provisions contained in this Contract.
- 8.2 Reports: Vendor shall provide quarterly reports and annual summaries to the Agency showing the Agency's items purchased, quantities of items purchased, and total dollar value of the items purchased. Vendor shall also provide reports, upon request, showing the items purchased during the term of this Contract, the quantity purchased for each of those items, and the total value of purchases for each of those items. Failure to supply such reports may be grounds for cancellation of this Contract.
- 8.3 Contract Manager: During its performance of this Contract, Vendor must designate and maintain a primary contract manager responsible for overseeing Vendor's responsibilities under this Contract. The Contract manager must be available during normal business hours to address any customer service or other issues related to this Contract. Vendor should list its Contract manager and his or her contact information below.
