





2. In the proposal the seep collector has a dimension of 2'X2' and in the plans it has a dimension of 3'X3'. Could I please get clarification on which size it is?

Answer: *The 2 x 2 ft. dimension described in Section 2.12.1 of the specifications is incorrect. The seep collectors are 3 x 3 ft. as shown on the plans.*

3. Will this be a lump sum bid and paid on percentage complete as there is not line items in the Final CRFQ?

Answer: *The pricing pages are presented as Exhibit A in the "Solicitation Documents" found on the OASIS Site just below the Final CRFQ. Copy attached. The project is bid as a unit price contract. 




