

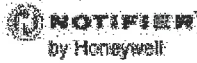

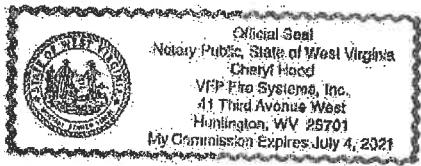

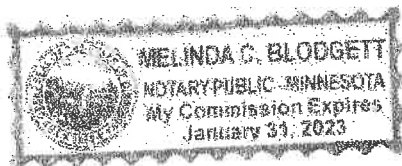

Addendum 1 Solicitation: DOT2100000039 Fire Suppression System

1. Question: Can you provide a complete set of the original sprinkler system shop drawings? (Sheet 2 of 2 was provided during site visit)?

Answer: Unable to locate page 1.

2. Question: Scope of work on RFQ states "Remove and install new fire suppression system and 2 dry valves". At the site visit during discussion it was stated that the dry valves & mains were to be replaced, but the branch lines were NOT to be replaced. Can you clarify which is the actual scope of work?

Answer: Main lines replaced, but small pipes to sprinkler heads not.

3. Question: Because you are asking to replace the existing schedule 10 pipe with schedule 40 pipe, this could create an issue with the hydraulic calculations of the system which is designed using black schedule 10 pipe. Should we provide price with schedule 40 black pipe as requested (which may or may not meet the required hydraulic demand), an alternate price for schedule 10 galvanized pipe and then an alternate price to replace with schedule 10 black pipe that would match the existing pipe?

Answer: No, state will not meet, and specifications will need changed.

4. Question: If the schedule 40 black or schedule 10 galvanized pipe is chosen, I would expect that new hydraulic calculations would be required and submitted to WV State Fire Marshal. Can you verify this is the case?

Answer: Specifications, vendor will work with the WV State Fire Marshal.

5. Question: Will contractor be responsible for removing the pipe from property, or will you provide a dumpster for the purpose of removing the demoed pipe?

Answer: Vendor will remove and supply.


