"Following is my question/suggestion for the DOT specifications for a liquid asphalt storage tank DOT22\*153.

3.1.1.4 We would like to change this section to the following:

The tank shall be electronically heated and contain a minimum of five (5) internal heat tubes at the bottom of the tank (15 kw total) with thermostat control and designed to run off 240 volts."

### **RESPONSE #1**

Section 3.1.1.4 of the specification is being updated to reflect this new heating standard.

This Addendum is to change section 3.1.1.4. of the specifications.

### 3.1.1.4. used to read;

The tank shall be electronically heated and contain a minimum of nine (9) 800 watt electric heat strips (7,200 watt total) attached to the outside bottom of the tank and designed to run off of 220 volts.

### 3.1.1.4. now reads;

The tank shall be electronically heated and contain a minimum of five (5) internal heat tubes at the bottom of the tank (15 kw total) with thermostat control and designed to run off of 240 volts.

An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.







### **SPECIFICATIONS**

7000 Gallon Tanks (gravity flow)

### STANDARD EQUIPMENT

- 1. 7000 gallon tank 8'-0" diameter by approximately 19' high.
- 2. Made from 1/4" carbon steel.
- 3. Tank insulated with 3" fiberglass and covered with aluminum jacketing for all weather protection, including bottom and top.
- 4. Tank erected on and attached to steel stand to place bottom of tank 7'-0" above ground, 3'-0" above ground with option "A" (pump).
- 5. Equipped with ladder and safety rail to provide access to door on top of tank. Ladder is enclosed to meet OSHA specifications as shown on plans.

- 8. Loading hose 3" diameter and 12' long flexible steel with quick coupler at tank end.
- 9. Built-in float gauge for measuring liquid, reading both English and Metric.
- 10. Equipped with electric driven motor 1 HP single or 3 phase 220 volt, two (2) bladed agitator, RPM designed for agitation emulsions, with automatic timer capable of agitating from 5 to 30 minutes, in one minute increments, at set times on any given day of the week.
- 11. One (1) temperature gauge, 4" dial type 50° F. to 200° minimum.
- 12. Concrete pad and steel support plates to be constructed by customer as per attached plans. Customer will be responsible for required welding to foundation pads.

- 16. Vendor will construct sufficient hooks on the tank for unloading and lifting onto pad. Cranes for doing this will be provided by customer. Vendor must notify customer 48 hours prior to delivery.
- 17. Customer will provide welder to weld legs to lag plates on pads as directed by contractor.
- 18. Tanks and structures must meet all applicable Federal And State codes including electrical components and wind velocity requirements. Successful bidder shall certify that tanks and structures meet such laws & codes.
- 19. Tank and all attachments to have a one (1) year warranty from date of operation.
