A.6 Upon completion of all fabrication operations in the shop, and before shipment to the project site, all weathering steel bridge components shall be blast cleaned to a near white surface condition according to SSPC-SP 10. Prior to the start of any blast cleaning, all oil, grease, cutting fluids, or other foreign matter shall be removed from the surfaces of the steel by solvent cleaning according to SSPC-SP 1. Paint the ends of the girders and all other structural components for a distance of 4 feet from the ends of the girders. The color shall be 20062 in accordance with Federal Standard 595.
