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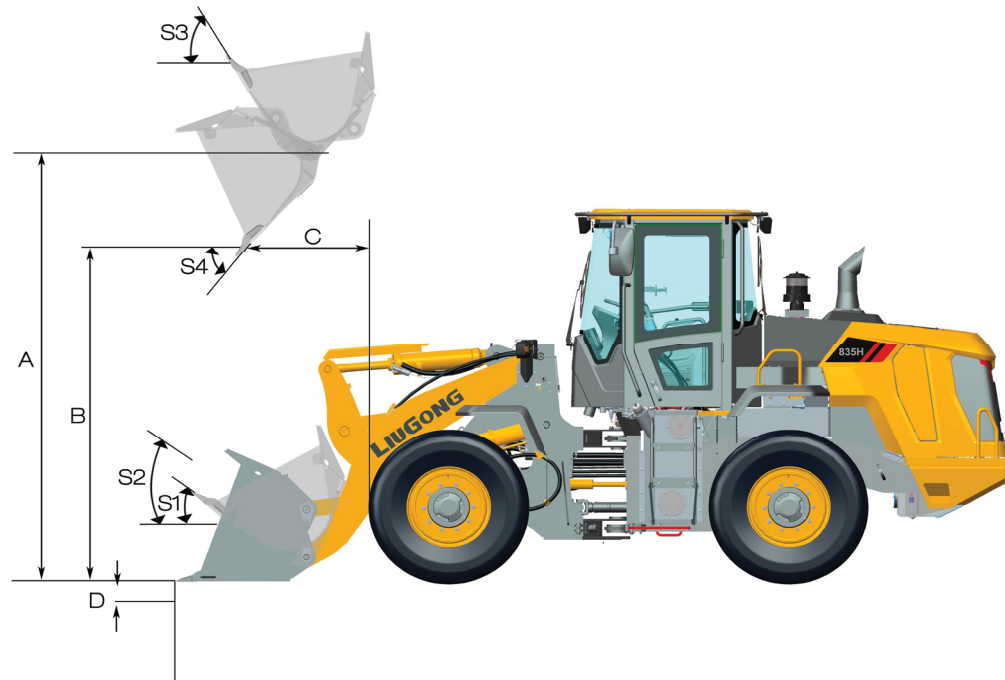

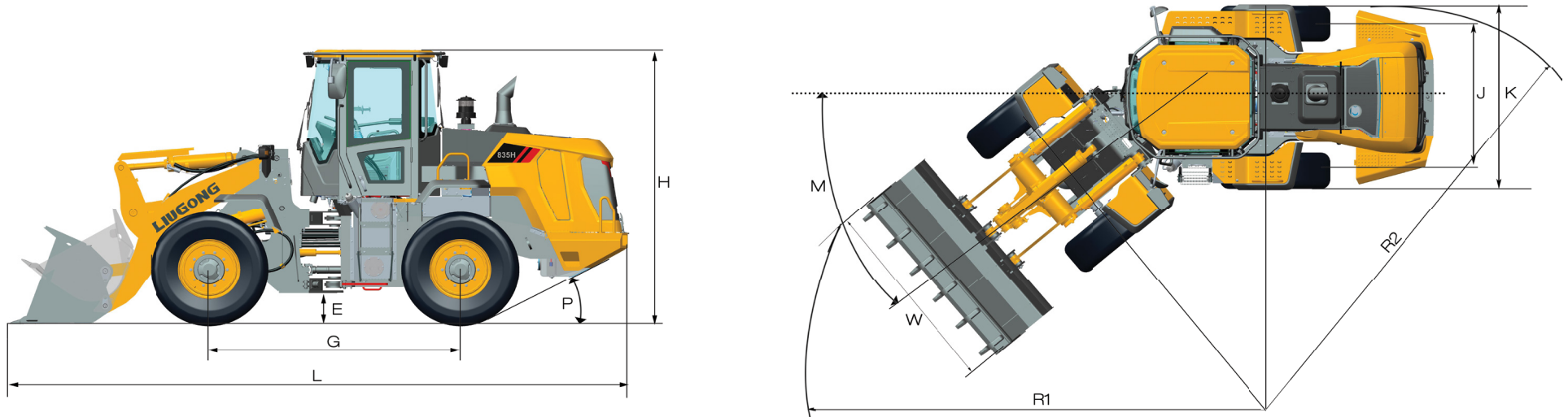

3.1.8.1 - Unit shall have 120-amp alternator minimum with internal regulator.

Would the State accept a 90-amp alternator? This is the OEM standard and is capable of running all machine electronics and any add-ons the State would happen to add.

Answer: Will accept 90-amp alternator

3.2.6.1 - The bid shall include a breakdown of the complete manufacturer's warranty per section.

We ask that the State set a benchmark for warranty. Our standard manufacturer's warranty is 3-yr/4,000-hr standard & 5-yr/7,000-hr powertrain & hydraulics. This warranty is built into the retail price of the unit and is one of the most comprehensive in the industry. We feel as though we will be penalized monetarily for offering a better product, standard.

Answer: The purpose and scope section of the spec calls out a specific model and brand that will be used as a comparison for an or equal. The or equal covers all aspects of what shall be met at a minimum, including warranty coverage unless an exemption is given by the WVDOH.

3.1.1.5 Is a 24'5" maximum overall length acceptable.

Answer: Will accept up to 24' 8" overall length with bucket on the ground.

3.1.2.1 Is an EPA Final Tier 4 engine acceptable.

Answer: Will accept final tier 4.

3.1.7.3 Are (2) 700 CCA batteries acceptable.

Answer: Will accept two 700CCA batteries.

3.1.14.7 What does "Unit shall be electric over hydraulic control referring to".

Answer: Referring to the use of electrical solenoids on the hydraulic valve to control the hydraulic spools to change direction of liquid flow in the hydraulic valve for bucket operation.

3.1.15.2 Are 20.5/R25 tires acceptable.

Answer: Will accept either 17.5/R25 or 20.5/R25

3.1.1.4 Unit shall have a breakout force of 20,000 pounds minimum. - Would you allow a breakout force of 16,000 pounds?

Answer: No leave as written.

3.1.2.2 Engine shall be a minimum net power rating would 142 hp. - Would you allow minimum hp requirement of engine to be 120 hp?

Answer: No leave as written.

3.1.14.4 Hydraulic system relief pressure shall be 3755 PSI minimum. - Would you allow hydraulic system relief shall be 3600 PSI minimum?

Answer: Will accept 3600PSI.

3.1.1.8 Would you allow a 98" dumping clearance at maximum height and 45- degree dump angle?

Answer: Will accept.

Question 1 – 3.1.1.5 Overall length (bucket on ground) shall be 24-foot-2-inch maximum.

Our machine is 24' 5" with coupler and bucket. Will you accept?

Answer 1 – Will accept a maximum 24' 8" overall length with bucket down.

Can you please clarify this? Will CAT's standard exhaust system suffice?

Question 3 – 3.1.8.1 Unit shall have 120-amp alternator minimum with internal regulator.

Our machine comes standard with a 115-amp alternator. Will you accept?

Answer 3 – Will accept 90 amps and above alternator output.

Question 4 – 3.1.12.1 Axles should be ZF.

ZF is an aftermarket brand axle. Will you accept a CAT branded axle?

Answer 4 – Will accept manufacturer branded axles if the warranty coverage is an or equal to the base warranty for the model covered in the purpose and scope section.

Question 5 – 3.1.15.2 Tires shall be correct ply and rating grader/loader type front and rear tubeless radials 17.5/R25 size 1-star L-3

The standard size for our loader is 20.5/R25. Will you accept?

Answer 5 – Will accept 17.5/R25 or 20.5/R25.

Question 6 – 3.1.19.7 Bucket shall have lifting eyes on left and right side and center of bucket.

It is not common industry practice to have lift eyes on a wheel loader bucket. It would require welding on lift eyes, which then creates other complications, such as safety certifying the lift eyes. This is nearly impossible without knowing the specific applications that these would be used for. Will you consider removing this spec?


