# General Requirements Response

3. Quality Drug will provide WVDOT with the items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract items will meet or exceed the mandatory requirements set forth in CRFQ.

# 3.1.1 Drug and Alcohol Testing Services

3.1.1.1 Quality Drug will produce random selections for the WVDOT employees whose job duties place them into the WVDOT programs. These employees will be divided into four testing pools and the WVDOT will provide, via email at the start of each quarter, a list of the employee within each pool.

3.1.1.1.1 Quality Drug will maintain the testing pool of not more than 3000 employees in compliance with Title 49 CFR Parts 40 and 382. Accordingly, random screes selections will be accomplished with the same regulations.

3.1.1.1.2 Quality Drug will split sample collections, a certified laboratory, and MRO oversight generally mirroring a DOT collection, storage and mailing process for the second testing pool of not more than 400, which contains employees whose tests are defined commonly as non-DOT tests.

3.1.1.1.3 Quality Drug will maintain all testing and quarterly random selections of the Parkways Authority testing pool of not more than 100, which are maintained in compliance with Title 49 CFG Parts 40 and 382. Quality Drug will supply all quarterly and annual reports as required.

3.1.1.3.4 Tests will follow USDOT collection protocols found in Title 49 CFR Part 40.

3.1.1.3.5 Quality Drug will provide for a confirmatory breath alcohol test on all breath concentrations measuring at 0.02 percent blood-alcohol content or above.

3.1.1.4 The on-site testing locations, dates, and arrival times will be identified and confirmed through the WVDOT's Drug and Alcohol Testing Coordinator each quarter.

3.1.1.5 Upon arrival at an agency location, Quality Drug will not begin random testing without the presence of the Agency's site supervisor.

All data placed on or utilized within such portal shall be WVDOT's property and shall not be utilized by or accessed by Quality Drug without written prior consent of WVDOT. In no circumstance shall Quality Drug allow any unauthorized access to WVDOT data within the portal.

3.1.1.8.9 Quality Drug will use the portal daily and will prove reliable in its availability, functionality and execution. Qualities and functions of the portal are subject to WVDOT review.

3.1.1.8.10 Development and design of the portal will ensure privacy and strong security controls by using authentication/passwords, preauthorizing all users, and confidential handling of data.
