

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS (No AIA Documents)

1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of West Virginia Department of Agriculture to establish a contract for the following:

WVDA FDP needs to repair and replace the current parking lot and loading zones at the Food Distribution Warehouse located in Ripley, WV.

The Vendor shall furnish all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to complete all Construction Services. The Vendor shall furnish any incidental work, materials, labor, and equipment that are necessary to complete the Construction Services, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the Project Plans.

- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions and in the Project Plans as defined below.
 - **2.1** "Construction Services" means removal and repair of pavement and concrete as more fully described in the Project Plans.
 - **2.2** "Pricing Page" means the pages contained in wvOASIS, attached hereto as Exhibit A, or included in the Project Plans upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Construction Services.
 - **2.3 "Solicitation"** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with Construction Services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
 - 2.4 "Project Plans" means documents developed by an architect, an engineer, the Agency, or another design professional, which are attached hereto as Exhibit B, that provide detailed instructions on how the Construction Services are to be performed. In the event that Project Plans contain drawings or other documents too large to attach in Exhibit B, Vendors can obtain copies in accordance with Section 9 of these Specifications.
- 3. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE: This General Construction Specifications document will have priority over, and supersede, anything contained in the Project Plans.
- **4. QUALIFICATIONS:** Vendor, or Vendor's staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:

- 4.1. Experience: Vendor, or Vendor's supervisory staff assigned to this project, must have successfully completed at least (5) projects that involved work similar to that described in these specifications or the Project Plans. Compliance with this experience requirement will be determined prior to contract award by the State through references provided by the Vendor upon request, through knowledge or documentation of the Vendor's past projects, through confirmation of experience requirements from the architect assisting the State in this project, or some other method that the State determines to be acceptable. Vendor must provide any documentation requested by the State to assist in confirmation of compliance with this provision. References, documentation, or other information to confirm compliance with this experience requirement may be requested after bid opening and prior to contract award.
- 4.2. State of West Virginia Contractors license
- 4.3. Must have a minimum of 10 years' experience in paving and concrete work.
- 5. CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Construction Services. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest qualified responsible bidder meeting the required specifications. If the Pricing Pages contain alternates/add-ons, the Contract will be awarded based on the grand total of the base bid and any alternates/add-ons selected.
- 6. SELECTION OF ALTERNATES: Pursuant to W. Va. Code§ 5-22-l(f), any solicitation of bids shall include no more than five alternates. Alternates, if accepted, shall be accepted in the order in which they are listed on the bid form. Any unaccepted alternate contained within a bid shall expire 90 days after the date of the opening of bids for review. Determination of the lowest qualified responsible bidder shall be based on the sum of the base bid and any alternates accepted.
- 7. **PERFORMANCE:** Vendor shall perform the Construction Services in accordance with this document and the Project Plans.
- 8. SUBSTITUTIONS: Any substitution requests must be submitted in accordance with the official question and answer period described in the INSTRUCTIONS TO VENDORS SUBMITTING BIDS, Paragraph 4. Vendor Question Deadline. Vendors submitting substitution requests should submit product brochures and product specifications during the official question and answer period.
- 9. PROJECT PLANS: The checked box will apply to Project Plans for this solicitation.
 - X No Additional Project Plan Documents: There are no additional Project Plans other than those attached hereto as Exhibit B or any subsequent addenda modifying Exhibit B.

10. CONDITIONS OF THE WORK

- 10.1. Permits: The Vendor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable Federal, State, or Local laws, regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 10.2. Existing Conditions: If discrepancies are discovered between the existing conditions and those noted in the specifications, Vendor must immediately notify the Agency's representative. Vendor must also immediately notify the Agency if suspected hazardous materials are encountered.
- 10.3. Standard Work Hours: The standard hours of work for this Contract will be 5:30am 4:00pm excluding holidays recognized by the State of West Virginia. Any work outside of the standard hours of work must be approved in advance at the Agency's sole discretion. Authorization of work outside of the standard hours of work will not entitle Vendor to additional compensation.
- 10.4. Project Closeout: Project Closeout shall include the following:
 - **10.4.1. Final Cleanup:** Vendor shall perform the final cleanup activities listed below, along with any other final cleanup activities normally associated with the work performed under this Contract, prior to final inspection:
 - 10.4.1.1. All trash shall be removed prior to final project inspection.
 - 10.4.2. Final Inspection: Vendor shall participate in a final inspection with the Agency's project manager. The purpose of the final inspection will be to identify deficiencies that need to be remedied prior to Agency's final acceptance of the work. Vendor shall at all times be obligated to perform in accordance with the Contract and must take all actions necessary to ensure that work complies with requirements of Contract prior to final acceptance. Final acceptance does not waive or release Vendor from its obligation to ensure that work complies with the Contract requirements. Vendor shall submit any warranty documents to the Agency project manager at final inspection.

- 11. FACILITIES ACCESS: Performance of Contract Services may require access cards and/or keys to gain entrance to Agency's facilities. In the event that access cards and/or keys are required:
 - 11.1. Vendor must identify principal service personnel which will be issued access cards and/or keys to perform service.
 - 11.2. Vendor will be responsible for controlling cards and keys and will pay replacement fees if the cards or keys become lost or stolen.
 - 11.3. Vendor shall notify Agency immediately of any lost, stolen, or missing card or key.
 - **11.4.** Anyone performing under this Contract will be subject to Agency's security protocol and procedures.
 - 11.5. Vendor shall inform all staff of Agency's security protocol and procedures.

13. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:


- **13.1 Mandatory Contract Item Requirements:** Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.
 - 13.1.2 Vendor must use hot-mix pavement rated for a minimum 80,000lb vehicles.
 - 13.1.3 Area of Hot-mix paving will be minimum of 11,180 square yards. It is the vendors responsibility to measure areas for correctness and exact measurements.
 - 13.1.4 Vendor shall complete all work in a neat and workmanlike manner. All work shall be done using new materials in a manner that meets commercial quality standards. Work shall be neat, true, plumb, and square, as applicable. Vendor shall verify all dimensions.
 - 13.1.5 Agency will provide a designated location inside the gate at the warehouse for equipment and materials.
 - 13.1.6 Vendor must mill area around building and concrete pads to obtain smooth transition.
 - 13.1.7 Vendor must mill smooth any high spots before paving.
 - 13.1.8 Vendor must sweep, clean, and apply tack to areas before paving.
 - 13.1.9 Vendor must repair the four (4) existing areas that exhibit damage, see Exhibit C Drawings.
 - 13.1.9.1 Area #1 12ft X 40ft minimum,
 - **13.1.9.2** Area #2 is 12ft X 30ft minimum,
 - 13.1.9.3 Area #3 is 10ft X 10ft minimum and
 - **13.1.9.4** Area#4 12ft X 20ft minimum.

This will be a minimum of 104 square yards. It is vendors responsibility to measure areas for correctness and exact measurements.

- **13.1.10** Vendor must install a minimum of 3-inch compacted thickness of Hot-mix Base-2 Asphalt to four (4) damaged areas, prior to installing top layer.
- **13.1.11** Vendor must install a top layer of Hot-mix W ct-1 Asphalt, at a minimum of 2-inch average compacted thickness.
- 13.1.12 Vendor must install (2) 6ft X 50ft minimum Concrete pads must be 12 inches thick for trailer stands. The pad on the front parking lot will be 30ft off the east end of the parking lot and 39ft from the south end of the parking lot. The pad on the back parking lot will be 42ft off the east end of the parking lot and 39ft off the back of the building.
- 13.1.13 Vendor must provide a (1) year warranty for all materials and work done.

Failure to read the Bid Documents in their entirety and comply with the stated requirements contained therein may result in bid disqualification.

Errors That Shall Be Reason for Immediate Bid Disqualification

- 1. Failure to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting
- 2. Failure to sign the bid
- 3. Failure to supply a valid bid bond or other surety approved by the state of West Virginia
- 4. Failure to meet any mandatory requirement of the solicitation
- 5. Failure to submit bid prior to the bid opening date and time
- 6. Federal debarment
- 7. State of West Virginia debarment or suspension

Errors that May Be Reason for Bid Disqualification Before Contract Award

- 1. Failure to acknowledge receipt of Addenda (only if stipulated as mandatory)
- 2. Debt to the state or political subdivision (must be cured prior to award)
- 3. Workers' Compensation or Unemployment Compensation delinquency (must be cured prior to award)
- 4. Not registered as a vendor with the state of West Virginia (must be cured prior to award)
- 5. Failure to obtain required bonds and/or insurance
- 6. Failure to provide the sub-contractor listing within one business day of bid opening or one business day of the request to do so by the Purchasing Division
- 7. Failure to supply West Virginia contractor's license number with bid or within one day of Purchasing Division request to do so
- 8. Failure to supply a signed drug-free workplace affidavit with bid or within one day of Purchasing Division request to do so
- 9. Failure to use the provided solicitation form (only if stipulated as mandatory)
