Ownership

StaffLink has over thirty-nine (39) years of experience in recruiting nursing and healthcare personnel to public, government and private entities. We were legally incorporated in March 1987 in Missouri.

Most of the administrative staff have worked with StaffLink for 30-40 years. Our recruiters and schedulers have worked as clinicians prior to becoming recruiters and schedulers.

Pre-Recruitment

It is our practice to pre-recruit before we bid. We pre-recruited for this Request for Quote (RFQ). Over a three (3) day period, we made contact with 13 HSWs, 3, LPNs and 1 RN. We are confident that with a longer recruitment timeline, we will be able to secure even more candidates.

For recruitment purposes, we are confident we can cover the following hours:

HSWs – 20,000 hours

LPNs – 6,000 hours

RNs – 2,000 hours

Recruitment Plan

StaffLink will recruit qualified nursing staff in West Virginia through a combination of our existing healthcare staffing network, targeted online recruiting, local outreach, employee referrals, and partnerships with nursing schools and professional organizations. We will actively recruit RNs, LPNs, and CNAs based on the facility's specific staffing needs and credentialing requirements.

Our recruitment team can begin sourcing candidates immediately upon award of the contract. Depending on the number and type of positions required, we anticipate presenting qualified candidates within **3–7 days**, with onboarding and credential verification proceeding concurrently. Our goal is to provide reliable staffing as quickly as possible while ensuring all

personnel meet West Virginia licensing, certification, background-check, and facility requirements.

Coverage

StaffLink will maintain a dedicated, pre-qualified staffing pool and a 24/7 on-call coverage system to support the facility's staffing needs, including weekends, holidays, employee call-offs, and scheduled vacations. StaffLink will use primary, first-call backup, and secondary backup personnel to promptly replace unavailable employees. Upcoming schedules will be proactively monitored, and StaffLink will verify coverage before each shift. Any call-off will immediately trigger the replacement process, with escalation to management when necessary. StaffLink will monitor and report fill rates, call-offs, response times, and unfilled shifts to ensure accountability and continuous improvement.

Rapid Deployment Timeline

StaffLink will begin recruitment **immediately upon contract award and receipt of the facility's staffing requirements.**

- **Days 5–7:** Complete remaining credentialing, onboarding, and scheduling for candidates who are approved.
- **Ongoing:** Maintain a continuous candidate pipeline and recruit replacement/backup personnel to minimize staffing interruptions.

Our objective is to have **qualified candidates available for consideration within 3–5 days**, with deployment as soon as facility approval, credentialing, and required onboarding are completed. Larger staffing requests or specialized positions may require additional time, but StaffLink will use an expanded regional recruitment strategy when necessary.

StaffLink's commitment is to provide the facility with a reliable, repeatable recruitment pipeline—not simply fill the initial vacancies. We will continuously recruit, maintain a pool of qualified backup candidates, and monitor staffing needs so that vacancies can be addressed quickly as they occur.

Onboarding Support

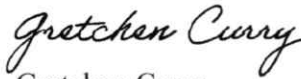

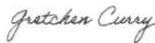
