 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.

MOBILE RADIO SPECIFICATIONS FOR MA/COM RADIOS AND RELATED COMPONENTS

The Public Service Commission is seeking to purchase 30 to 35 mobile police/emergency radio equipment and related accessories (if budget allows we will purchase 35). It is important that the equipment meet all specifications and be compatible with existing equipment. Vendors submitting "or equal" bids should include with their bids detailed documentation and literature to show that the "or equal" product meets the specifications contained in this RFQ. The agency reserves the right to reject any vendor's bid proposal that does not meet the specifications contained in this RFQ or who fails to provide supplemental literature for evaluation.

Equipment Specifications

Low Band Mobile Radio - Macom Orion (or Equal) with option cable D22BIN, Key Cap kit DRMK2F, 19C307172P2 Swivel Base, spring and associated whip rod, and 19C851530P3 39-47Mhz antenna matching unit (110 watts).

Radio must be capable of operating in a band of 37-50 MHZ with no degradation of rated specification. Radio must have at least 192 channel capacity, with 2 channel priority scan capability (Priority scan is defined as a scan that continues to periodically check the priority channels for activity if not already locked on one of those channels and change to the active priority channel when activity is detected). If 64 channels may not be scanned contiguously, then the radio must be capable of storing a minimum of 256 channels with channels scanable in banks of 32 channels minimum. The scan list must be capable of holding 32 channels. Alpha-numeric display of at least 8 characters shall be provided on the control head. Control head unit shall have the ability to act as a light and siren control. This control shall access four auxiliary SPST switches capable of at least 20 Amps at 12 Volts DC. There shall be at least four additional switches capable of handling 10 amps at 12 volts. One further switch shall be an additional 10 amp switch, or a class C relay connection (one position NO or NC). All switching should be accomplished by remotely located relays located in the siren module. Labeling on the control head buttons should include, but not be limited to, Wail, Yelp, Hi/LO, Scan, RST, SL1, SL2, SL3, SL4, SL5, SL6, SPK, PA, Aux 1, Aux 2. Control unit shall be capable of directly interfacing with a remote siren unit and control this siren utilizing a data cable to enable and disable all siren/light functions. External speaker and standard microphone shall be provided.

A broadband mobile whip antenna with a swivel mount, chrome ball, heavy duty spring, and stainless steel whip shall be provided. Antenna will be pretuned to operate in a frequency range of 37-49 MHZ. It shall be capable of operating with 150 watts of transmitter power and provide unity gain. A minimum of 15 feet of RG-58 cable shall be provided with appropriate connector to mate with mobile low band radio. VSWR over the bandwidth of the antenna shall be less than 2.0:1.

All radio and control head programming must be able to be performed with a personal computer utilizing Windows 98, Windows 200, or Windows XP. The vendor shall provide programming

software and any hardware and cabling necessary for interfacing with the personal computer. Proprietary programmers are not acceptable.

Both transmitter and receiver must comply with all FCC requirements.

Unit shall have a programmable carrier controlled timer.

A key lock shall be provided.

Radio T/R unit shall be able to be mounted remotely from the control head of the unit. Power and control cabling shall be at least 18 feet in length.

Radio shall have programmable encode and decode capability for both CTCSS tones and digital coded squelch, with a minimum of one pair of tones, not necessarily the same, for each programmed channel. Control heads shall have the ability to provide for activation of a vehicular repeater. Control head shall provide for audible notification when the vehicular repeater is activated. Receiver audio stage shall be capable of a minimum of 10 watts of audio. The speaker shall be driven by this audio amplifier and must be capable of dissipating the entire audio capability. An internal speaker driven by a restricted audio source is not acceptable. CTCSS decoder must be capable of decoding CTCSS tones of 350 Hz modulation level or less.

Scanning shall include talk back scan. Talk back scan is defined as scanning that allows the operator to talk back to a calling station that is received for a predetermined number of seconds. The transmit channel shall be the same channel as was received prior to the expiration of the talk back scan timer. This time period shall be from .1 to 5 seconds. At the expiration of this time, the receiver shall return to normal scanning. The selected transmitter channel shall then be the channel selected at the time scanning began. This is not to be misconstrued as manually programming a priority channel from the front panel. The transmit channel shall be the channel that is displayed on the LCD display at the time the scan button is depressed to initiate scanning.

A F F I D A V I T**West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states:**

No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions.

"Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION:

The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING:

The vendor must be licensed in accordance with any and all state requirements to do business with the state of West Virginia.
