Specific Eligibility Criteria: Product must be approved by Gypsy Moth Cooperative Suppression Program

Specific Qualification Criteria: Product must be an insecticide that has been approved for use in the Gypsy Moth Cooperative Supression Program. Dimilin is a manufactured insect growth regulator. Dimilin is to be used when dealing with high population counts but can not be sprayed over flowing streams or open water. Federal dollars are used for this program and the guidelines set forth in the Environmental Impact Statement filed by the USDA Forest Service with the EPA.
