- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the **West Virginia Code**.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

#### **ADDENDUM #1**

PURCHASING DIVISION STATE OF WV

- 1) The attached Section 13 Bridge/Walkway and Section 14 Revegetation are included as part of the Technical Specifications for this project.
- 2) The pump shown in the pipe suspended under the bridge in the Bridge Detail on Sheet 2 is not part of this contract. It shall be bid under another contract.
- 3) The relocation of electricity item shall involve the extension of electrical service from the end of service located east of the project site, which is actually farther east than the end of service that is indicated on the plan drawings, to the doser pad. The contractor may contact:

Zack Bittner Allegheny Power (301) 533-3390

for more information. The contractor shall contact the Kingwood, WV office of Allegheny Power at (800) 255-3443 to acquire a work order for the extension of service to the project site.

The contractor shall provide all customer required facilities in accordance with the attached Figure 7 and as per <u>Customer Requirements for Electric Service</u>, effective April 1, 2005. The contractor shall provide the required service entrance facilities (service pole and appurtenances) with disconnect or breaker panel board for single phase 200 AMP service for connection to the service drop from Allegheny Power. The electrical connection will be completed in the next contract for the doser and building.

4) The project shall be bid in accordance with the attached revised bid schedule dated 04/06/07.

#### SECTION 13 BRIDGE/WALKWAY

#### **13.1** Scope

The Contractor shall furnish all materials and labor to construct a bridge/walkway over the borehole. The work shall include excavation of eight, 4-foot deep holes to install support posts, installation of all joists, cross-members and decking as per the contract drawings. The bridge/walkway will include an access door to the borehole and the submerged pump (pump supplied under separate contract). No consideration will be given to the nature of materials encountered in excavating the holes. Therefore, as unclassified excavation, no additional payment will be made for difficulties occurring in excavating and handling of materials. All excavation shall be conducted from dry land, no equipment shall be allowed to work from in the pond.

#### 13.2 Job Conditions

- A. Soil and Weather Conditions Do not perform grading when soil or weather conditions are unsuitable. Unsuitable conditions include moisture saturated soil, frozen in place soil and significant precipitation of any kind present on the soil or occurring during the work.
- B. Storm Protection Plan work so as to provide adequate protection during storms with provisions available at all times for preventing flood damage.
- <u>C. Toxic Material</u> Material uncovered during site grading that is considered toxic and may require special disposal requirements, as delineated by the WV DEP, shall be transported and disposed of at a WV DEP approved disposal site at WV DEP expense.
- <u>D. Protection</u> Assume all risks attending to the presence or proximity of overhead or underground public utility and private lines, pipes, conduits and support work for same, also existing structures and property of whatever nature, in or over excavations or adjacent to such excavations. Complete responsibility for replacement and restitution work of whatever nature to the above, as damaged or destroyed by work of this Contract, rests solely with the Contractor and at no expense to the WV DEP.
- <u>E. Limit of Grading and Revegetation</u> Take necessary precautions to protect structures, trees, shrubs, wetlands and other landscaping outside of the work limits.
- <u>F. Classification of Excavated Materials</u> No consideration will be given to the nature of materials encountered in site grading operations. Therefore, as unclassified excavation, no additional payment will be made for difficulties occurring in excavating and handling of materials.

- <u>G. Work Limits</u> The area that is off-limits to grading shall be discussed at the Pre-Bid Meeting.
- <u>H. Estimated Quantities</u> The amount of earthwork listed is an estimate of total cubic yardage to be moved. This figure should be used for estimating purposes only and it remains the Contractors responsibility to determine the exact quantity to be moved in order to achieve the required grade and lines indicated in the contract drawings. The Contractor should make a determination to confirm these estimates. Final payment will be based upon the lump sum bid amount and no adjustments will be made, regardless of the actual quantities handled. The Contractor's bid price shall reflect all necessary costs required to excavate, haul, and grade the material required to meet the grades and lines indicated on the project plans.

#### 13.3 Materials

- <u>A.</u> "<u>Lumber</u>" All lumber shall be Select Lumber <sup>TM</sup> or Fiberforce®, "plastic" materials manufactured and distributed by Bedford Technology, LLC, 2424 Armour Road, PO Box 609, Worthington, MN 56187, phone 800.721.9037, or an approved equivalent. Lumber dimensions and quantities can be determined from the contract drawings. Lumber must be fastened as per manufacturers recommendations.
- <u>B. Hardware</u> All fasteners and hinges are to rust proof, and conform to the "plastic" lumber manufacturer's recommendation.
- C. Concrete Concrete shall be 4,000 psi.
- D. Re-bar The Concrete shall be reinforced with no. 6 re-bar, 6" (six inches) on center.

#### 13.4 Performance

- A. Site Grading Perform grading over the site within the Work Limit and Revegetation as indicated on the project plans.
- B. <u>Bridge/Walkway</u> Construct bridge/walkway in the location shown on the site plans. Attach all materials as per manufacturers recommendation. Any materials damaged during shipment, storage, placement, backfilling or any other means shall be immediately replaced at no additional expense to the WV DEP.
- <u>C. Finished Elevations and Lines</u> Grade the area within the Work Limit and Revegetate to the elevations and lines indicated on the drawings. Leave finished grade surfaces free of objectionable material larger than six (6") inches in greatest dimension. Dispose of such objectionable material by burying on-site or at an acceptable off-site location.

#### 13.5 Items of Work and Construction Details

Items of work to be performed in conformance with this specification and the construction details therefore are:

- A. Bid Item 10 Bridge/Walkway
  - 1. This item includes all earthwork and final grading necessary to construct a Bridge/walkway over the bore hole. This work will include all materials necessary to construct the bridge/walkway as per construction drawings.
  - 2. Payment for this item shall be Lump Sum.

## SECTION 14 REVEGETATION

#### **14.1** Scope

This work will consist of preparing, furnishing, and applying all materials for the permanent vegetation of approximately 1 acre in accordance with these Specifications and Plans.

#### 14.2 Materials

A. Certified Seed - All seed shall be from the latest crop available. The Contractor shall provide the MMP/BOM with a seed certification from the supplier. The seeding mixture to be used is as follows:

Roughstalk Bluegrass (Poa trivialis)	8 lbs/ac
Red Top (Agrostis alba)	8 lbs/ac
Wild Millet (Echinochloa crusgali)	8 lbs/ac
Switchgrass (Panicum virgatum)	8 lbs/ac

B. Lime - A minimum of 4 tons/acre of agriculture grade ground limestone is required.

<u>C. Fertilizer</u> – A minimum of 500 pounds/acre of 20-20-20 fertilizer, or the equivalent, is required.

<u>D. Mulch</u> - Hay, straw or an approved alternative mulch is required. A minimum of 4 Tons/acre of mulch is required.

#### 14.3 Construction Performance

- A. Seedbed Preparation and Treatment Upon completion of construction, topsoil distribution, and final grading of all disturbed areas, the Contractor will utilize the following lime and fertilizer rates. A minimum of 500 lbs. per acre of fertilizer, and a minimum of four (4) tons per acre of ground limestone shall be applied. On areas where equipment cannot operate, the seedbed shall be prepared by hand scarifying to provide a roughened surface so that broadcast seed will stay in place. All disturbed areas shall be limed, fertilized, seeded and mulched within seven (7) days after final grading of topsoil. Rocks larger than six (6) inches in diameter, trash, weeds and other debris that will interfere with seeding or maintenance shall be removed and disposed of as directed by the MMP/BOM.
- B. <u>Seed Application</u> Once the seedbed is prepared, the Contractor shall apply the specified seed mixtures evenly over the entire disturbed areas. Seeding shall be done at such times of the year when soil conditions are suitable for tillage and when

moisture and temperatures are suitable for plant growth. No permanent seeding will be made between September 15 and March 15, unless otherwise directed by the WV DEP.

C. <u>Mulch Application</u> - Immediately upon completing seed application, the Contractor shall apply four (4) tons of mulch per acre over all seeded areas. The mulch shall be spread evenly with no bare or excessively thick areas of application. Mulch lost due to wind or runoff shall be immediately replaced at no additional cost to the WV DEP.

#### 14.4 Temporary Seeding and Mulching

All areas, which have been backfilled and will remain inactive for at least seven (7) days will be temporarily seeded and mulched. All seed shall be from the latest crop available. The Contractor shall provide the WV DEP with a seed certification from the supplier. The temporary seeding and mulching mixture to be used is as follows:

Winter Wheat or Rye

2 1/2 bushel/acre

Mulch - Hay or Straw

2 tons/acre

#### 14.5 Items of Work and Construction Details

Items of work to be performed in conformance with this specification and the construction details therefore are:


A. Bid Item 11 - Revegetation

This item includes seed, seed bed preparation, providing and applying all necessary soil amendments and materials, including lime, fertilizer, seed and mulch, and performing all other work required to revegetate approximately one (1) acre in accordance with these specifications.

B. Payment of this item shall be per acre.

- 4. ANTENNAS OR AERIALS SHALL NOT BE ATTACHED TO ANY POLE USED FOR SUPPLYING ELECTRIC SERVICE TO CUSTOMER.
- 5. INHIBITOR COMPOUND SHALL BE USED ON ALL ALUMINUM WIRE TERMINATIONS.
- 6. ALL **CUSTOMER** WORK SHALL BE COMPLETED AND INSPECTIONS (SEE SECTION 4.06) OBTAINED BEFORE COMPANY WILL PROVIDE SERVICE.
- 7. WHEN LOAD EXCEEDS 320 AMPS, SEE FIGURE 11.
