Specific Eligibility/Qualification Criteria:

In order for the radios to be compatible with the other mobile radios in the Wildlife Resources Section, they will need to be digital radio systems with full 9600 baud features including VHF/R1 band, multiple modes of operation in a single radio (ASTRO digital clear and encrypted, and analog), project 25 capable on trunking systems, project 25 compliant interoperable voice signaling features, FLASHport capable. The units will also need to be XTL 5000 VHF Mobile 25-110 Watt 136-174 MHZ with ASTRO digital Cai Operation Software, ¼ wave broadband antenna and W7 control head. The DNR's current radios are programmed to communicate with systems operated by the WV State Police, County Sheriff Departments, City Police Departments, County Fire Departments, County and State Emergency Services, WV Department of Forestry, US Forest Service, US Army Corp of

Engineer facilities, National Park Service and the State of Ohio on VHF 136-174 MHz band. It is essential that all Sections within the DNR have mobile units compatible with the existing system for both personnel safety and local, state or national emergencies. Two (2) year express factory depot service with standard mobile installation required.
