Detailed Description of Project:

Project will generally consist of the following work on Hawks Nest State Park tramway. Rebuilding tower end plates at tower No. 2. Rebuild or replace each sheave wheel frame on tower No. 4. Review tower configuration at tower No. 2 and provide revised design to prevent axle rotation and implement said design. All work shall be in compliance with ANSI B77, 1999 and be certified as such by a registered professional engineer experienced in tramway design.

Proposed Sole Source Vendor: Doppelmayr CTEC, Inc.

Specified Eligibility Criteria:

Contractor must demonstrate 10 years or greater experience in tramway construction, maintenance and design. Contractor must have knowledge of manufacturers' specifications for original equipment. Contractor shall be familiar with ANSI B77, 1999 Federal Standards.

Specific Qualifications Criteria:

Contractor must be a licensed WV Contractor with Engineered Construction classification. Contractor must demonstrate compliance with specific eligibility criteria listed above. Contractor must be able to comply with certification required by scope of work.
