REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.

**RELOCATION OF BOILER FROM BUILDING 3 TO BUILDING 4**

The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the agency, the West Virginia General Services Division, is soliciting quotations for the movement of a boiler located in the basement of Building 3 to the basement of Building 4. These facilities are located on the main Capitol campus in Charleston, WV 25305.

**GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS**

1. The successful contractor will be required to dismantle the existing 5000MBH boiler located in the basement of building 3, transport it to the basement of building 4, and re-erect the boiler for operation.
2. This installation will be temporary in nature; a new piped steam system will be installed to the facility sometime in the spring/summer of 2007; this installation is necessary to provide heating for the upcoming winter season.
3. This contract will include all necessary start-up and testing to ensure proper heating operation including any inspections and/or permits if required.
4. Boiler water treatment will be provided by General Services Division.
5. Due to the current short time-table, completion of this contract must be performed within 15 days of award (hopefully in mid-October 2006).
6. Bids shall be awarded to the lowest-cost qualified bidder who meets all specifications.
7. Work may be performed during the normal business hours of 8:00am to 5:00pm. Arrangements to perform work during non-business hours may be made, but at no additional expense.
8. No Bid Bond is required with the submission of the bid: however, the successful bidder shall furnish a performance bond and labor/material bond for one hundred (100%) of the amount of the contract prior to contract award. Bonds may be provided in the form of a certified check, irrevocable letter of credit, or bond furnished by a solvent surety company authorized to do business in the State of West Virginia. A letter of credit submitted in lieu of a performance and labor/material bond will only be allowed for projects under \$100,000.00. Personal or business checks are not acceptable in lieu of the performance bond or labor/material bond.
9. A mandatory pre-bid will be held on October 27, 2006 at 10:30 am at the chiller plant located at the corner of California Avenue and Piedmont Road in Charleston, West Virginia (The Capitol Complex).

**A F F I D A V I T**

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**West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states:**

No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

**DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions.

"Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:**

The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

**LICENSING:**

The vendor must be licensed in accordance with any and all state requirements to do business with the state of West Virginia.

**CONFIDENTIALITY:**

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
