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The West Virginia State Rail Authority wishes to solicit bids for a contractor to install bridge ties and rail on a railroad bridge located in Elkins, WV and two additional tracks from the north end of the bridge to the front of the Elkins Depot.

#### SPECIFICATIONS:

Bridge track work will consist of all work from the top of the rail to the bottom of the ties including their securement as follows:

The contractor will be responsible for having a certified engineer survey the area and layout the placement of the tracks in front of the depot as well as the location of the two Number 10 131# turnouts. The design of the track layout must be approved by the State Rail Authority prior to the start of work.

131 # rail will be installed over the bridge and continuing on to the front of the depot. Rail laid will equal 698 If across the bridge, track one will be 1150 If and track two will be 1050 If. The length of the two tracks after the switches are installed will be a total of 2,898 If of rail installed.

100# jointed guard rail will also be installed on the bridge. (698 lf) The 100# rail and joint bars will be provided however, the contractor is responsible for removing it from side tracks located at Cheat Bridge and transporting the rail and joint bars to the Elkins work site.

The 131 # rail and joint bars will be provided however, the contractor is responsible for removing it from side tracks located at Cheat Bridge and transporting the rail and joint bars to the Elkins work site.

The vendor will install the ties on the bridge with tie spacing as shown on the attached tie layout drawing. The ties for the track from the end of the bridge to the depot will be placed on 21" centers.

#### CONDUCT OF WORK

Work will be subject to inspection by the SRA and WVCR.

The contractor will comply with all safety rules and regulations as required by the Federal Railroad Administration, WVCR and other parties as applicable.

Contractor will use Heavy and Highway Construction Rates as established for Randolph County. These rates are pursuant to WV code §21-5A, et. Seq and are available at <a href="https://www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates/heavyandhighway06.htm">www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates/heavyandhighway06.htm</a>. Contractor will be responsible for submitting certified payrolls to the SRA.

#### <u>MATERIALS</u>

Vendor is responsible for all materials as listed on the attached materials list except for the 131# jointed rail,131# joint bars, 100# guard rail, 100# joint bars, two number 10 131# switches and two complete sets of #10 switch ties. These items will be provided by the WVSRA. As stated previously, the 131 & 100 rail and joint bars are located at Cheat

Bridge, WV and it is the contractor's responsibility to remove the rail and joint bars and transport them to the Elkins project site. The turnouts and switch ties are located at the Elkins project site.

The sizes and quantities of the bridge ties are listed on the attached material list. Bridge ties will be new and will meet AREMA specifications. Bridge ties will oak and crossote pressure treated 10# retention or refusal. Ties will be dapped ½ inch to fit over bridge girders.

The ties for the track placement from the edge of the bridge to the front of the depot are to be 7" x 9" x 8'6" industrial grade ties. Specifications in AREMA Chapter 3 will govern. Ties will be mixed hardwoods and oak, 100% end plated and creosote pressure treated to 7# retention or refusal. Contractor will provide treated tie plugs and 6" track spikes per AREMA specifications.

The quantities of the steel tie spacers, tie anchors, nuts, bolts & washers is listed on the attached materials sheet. All materials must meet AREMA specifications.

#### COMPLETION DATE

All work must be completed by June 30, 2007. The cost to the SRA for the administration of the contract as well as delays in operating the excursion train that will be incurred by the WVCR after that date make it necessary for the agency to access liquidated damages against the contractor for each calendar day any work remains uncompleted after that date. The charge will be \$500 per day.

#### BID REQUIREMENTS

Contractor must have previous experience in railroad bridge work.

- THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THE TIMBER CRIB WALLS AT ABUTMENT NO. 1.
- EXCAVATION BEHIND ABUTMENT NO. 2 BACKWALL, REMOVAL OF STEEL BARRICADE AND METAL HAND RAIL ATTACHED TO ABUTMENT NO. 2.

THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING THE CURRENT CONDITION OF THE STRUCTURE AND SHALL USE APPROPRIATE METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR DISMANTLING THE STRUCTURE IN A SAFE AND EFFICIENT MANNER.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE PORTIONS OF THE EXISTING CONCRETE PIER CAPS, ABUTMENT BACKWALL, AND ABUTMENT BEARING SEATS TO THE LIMITS SHOWN ON THE PLANS IN SUCH A MANNER THAT NO DAMAGE RESULTS IN THE ABUTTING SECTIONS WHICH ARE TO REMAIN IN PLACE. IF ANY DAMAGE OCCURS IN THE REMAINING SECTIONS, IT SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. 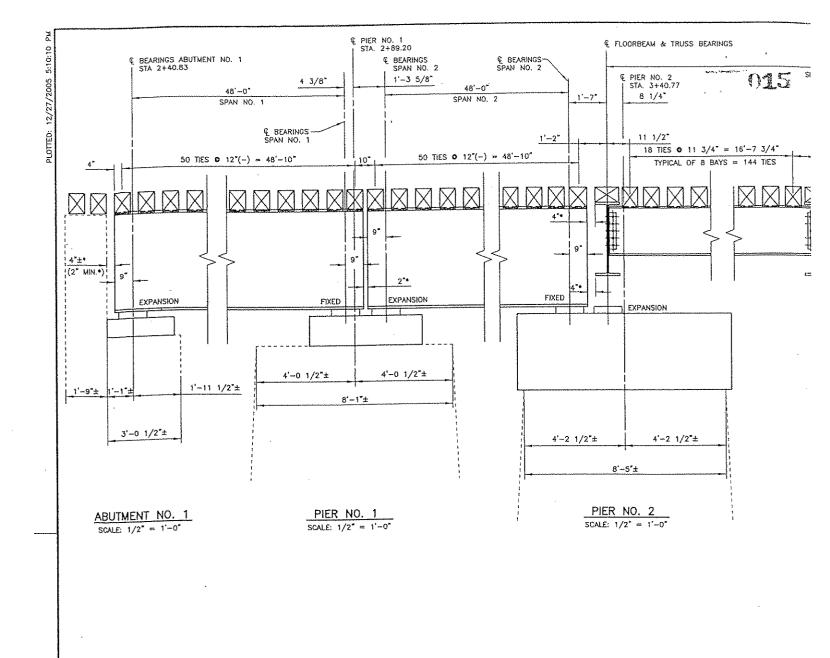

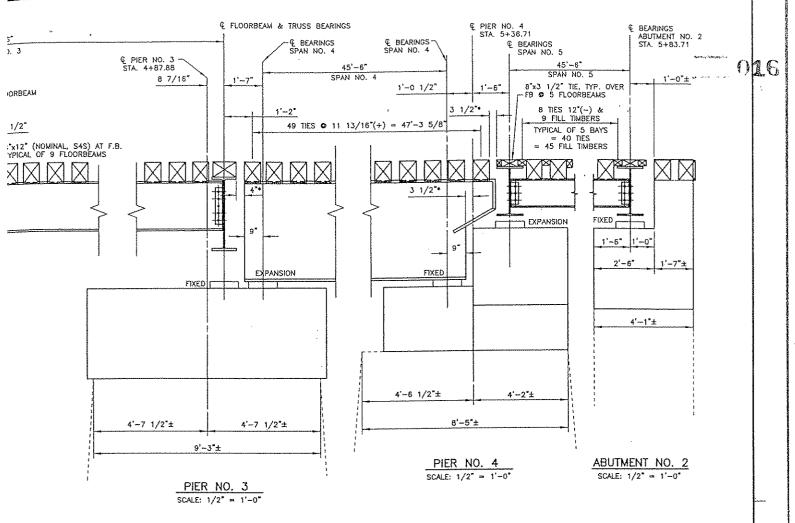
