- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- **12.** Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- **13. BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
- 14. 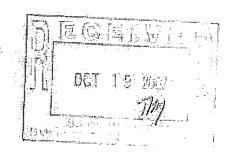

Questions and Answers

- Q1. What about the timbers?
- A1. No, everything, the timbers are to be disposed of. And along with all the other odds and ends and metal debris.
- Q2. As far as the stake out stuff in (RFQ) there. What is there to stake out?
- A2. Virtually nothing. It's a standard bid item we put in there. Maybe you want to check to make sure that your area sheet flows.
- Q3. I didn't eateh what you said about the concrete. All the concrete can be buried onsite as long as the steel is removed thish?
- A3. Yes. All the concrete can be buried on-site once it is broken up in pieces no larger than four foot in any direction and the steel removed flush with the concrete. If it's (Steel) encapsulated in concrete you can bury it on-site. And the steel and/or rebar has to be disposed of off-site. And that is in item seven in the scope of work.
- Q4. Dave, this bundle (Railroad Ties) here stays and this pile goes. Is that right?
- A4. Yes this pile goes and the one that is bundled up and stacked stays, ok, on this side. The ones over here on this side go. Those over there he set off the limits of the work area.
- Q5. Where's your topsoil at Dave? For your borrow sites.
- A5. Topsoil is wherever you can find it, ok, within the bounds of the permitted area. Any place within that that you can get brown-type soil to cover with.
- Q6. This railroad grade, are you going to cover (Topsoil) this whole railroad grade?
- A6. No, miless you tear it up.
- Q7. Dave, the large hopper (Bin) there, is the association hooked on it?
- A7. No, I don not think so. I think they want that little one that's attached to the building.

- Q8. Do you have to remove all this stuff (Brush) that has been grubbed?
- A8. No, the landowner did that.

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- Q9. We don't have to cover this over with grass or anything?
- A9. Well, whenever you go out of here you need to just top dress it and seed.
- Q10. Are the blocks (Old Cinder Block Building) attached to the base?
- A10. Thave no idea how they are attached or whether they are setting on top of there. If they are attached to the concrete, which I doubt that, but if they are then we'll just clean the blocks out as close as we can get to the concrete.
- Q11. That stack of lumber back there that's to be removed as well, over by the cinder-block building, I didn't get a chance to ask you?
- A11. No, that stack of lumber that's covered up with the till and weights on top of it, it stays, ok.
