REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.

Add to Specification 15.5 – Erosion and Sediment Control – Second paragraph – “This plan shall include a copy of the reclamation plan for each site showing the location of the contractors proposed sediment control measures”.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTIONS ASKED AT SITE 17

Q: Can we use silt fence for temporary sediment control?

A: Yes.

Q: Are you paying for temporary sediment control under the sediment control plan?

A: No.

Q: Where is the soil borrow area?

A: Soil borrow areas are shown on the plan views drawings.

Q: Is there any work on the other side of the creek at this site?

A: No. The work is to be performed within the construction limits as shown on the drawings.

Q: Can we use reddog as soil cover?

A: No, As outlined in Specification 20.3.1 reddog may not be used.

Q: Is there anything happening to the stream bank at this site?

A: No.

Q: Is there any regrading across the road?

A: No, the regrading is to be done within the construction limits as shown on the drawings.

Q: How come we are not taking care of the erosion on the opposite side of the stream bank?

A: The erosion occurred after the project was designed.

Q: Have you done any borings on the borrow area?

A: The soil borrow areas were hand augered. The depths of augering have been listed on the plan view drawings.

Q: Is this the location of the culvert road crossing?

A: The culvert road crossings locations are shown on the plan view drawings.

Q: What does the outlet end of the culvert get?

A: According to the drawings, there is not any outlet protection required.

Q: Do the culverts require headwalls?

A: According to the drawings, there are no headwalls required.

Q: Do you speculate there is enough soil in the borrow areas to cover the site?

A: Yes, but if there is insufficient material, the Contractor must follow guidelines outlined in Specification 19.9.

QUESTIONS ASKED AT SITE 16

Q: What is the reason you can not tear down structures only at certain times?

A: The only limitations on structure demolition are structures that are associated with bat gates as outlined in Specification 17.1.

Q: Does the tank at this site get removed?

A: Yes

Q: Does the tank have anything in it?

A: The tank did not previously contain anything, however, if it is discovered that the tank contains materials, the Contractor shall follow guidelines within the construction specifications.

Q: Has there been any asbestos testing on the buildings?

A: No, due to safety concerns, materials were not collected for testing. However it will be the Contractors responsibility of disposing of any materials according to the construction specifications in a legal manner.

Q: Can we bury the building demolition material on site?

A: The Contractor must dispose of materials according to the construction specifications in a legal manner.

Q: What about removal of all the stuff in the creek?

A: Materials in the creek change with each rain storm. The only material the Contractor must remove from the creek is any that may fall into the creek during demolition activities.

Q: Do we have all the SHIPO information in order?

A: Yes, within the construction limits as shown on the plan views.

Q: Does the retaining wall get removed along the road we walked along?

A: The structures and walls to be removed are clearly marked on the plan view drawings. The structures and walls not labeled are not to be removed.

Q: What about this foundation under the building across the creek?

A: According to Specification 18.2 the foundation is to be removed.

Q: Will the Contractor be required to test for asbestos?

A: The Contractor will be responsible for whatever it takes to remove and dispose of any materials in a legal manner.

Q: Do the bat gates go in entries at Mine Seal E and F where they are now?

A: Yes, according to plan view drawings and details. The entry's will just need cleaned out enough to do the work.

Q: Do we take out any of the structures seen above this area?

A: Yes, structures to be removed are clearly labeled on the drawings.

QUESTIONS ASKED AT SITE 15

Q: Can we close this road while we are working?

A: Yes, the road can be closed on a temporary as needed basis.

Q: Do we need railroad insurance?

A: No.

QUESTION ASKED AT SITE 14

Q: Can we borrow from one site to another?

A: Yes since we have only one landowner.
