3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.

This RFQ also includes removal of existing unit, piping, flu attachments and controls and reinstallation of a new unit to include all controls, piping, and flu vent to an operational condition.

TRIAD BOILER SYSTEMS, INC.
Specification for Series 1600 SH Steam, steel, fire tube boiler..

GENERAL PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

1. Furnish and install a modular steel boiler with a total rated input of 1,300 MBH. Each boiler shall have a rated output of 1,079 MBH when fired with natural gas.
2. Acceptable boiler design will be TRIAD Series 1600 designed for steam heating applications.
3. Boilers shall be in accordance with Section IV of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and must be tested, stamped, and approved for 15 psi operating pressure and bear the ASME symbol. Each boiler shall be registered with the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors.

BOILER DESIGN:

1. Boilers shall be of a water-backed fire tube design and fired with AGA or UL listed burners. Vessel walls shall be 1/4" thick boilerplate. Top and bottom tube sheets shall be 3/8" thick boilerplate. Fire tubes shall be of 12 gauge steel, no fewer than 70 vertical tubes, and no less than 2" dia. Firetubes shall be expanded/rolled into the top and bottom tube sheets; welding of tubes to tube sheet will not be permitted. Top and bottom tube sheets and tubes shall be accessible for easy inspection and cleaning. Boilers shall include a drain and have bolt-style leveling legs or rails. Each boiler shall be encased in a painted metal jacket with 1" high performance insulation.
2. All valving, fixed orifices, and associated piping shall be as recommended by the manufacturer so return water from the main enters the lower front of each boiler and supply exits the top rear of each boiler.
3. Provide a condensate feed system consisting of a tank and pump properly sized in accordance with the factory recommendations for this application.
4. The maximum rated temperature shall be 250°F with nominal upper limits set at 220°F and operated at 218°F. The units shall operate on 120 volt, single phase, 60 Hz power.
5. Boiler equipment, associated manifolding, and control panel shall be manufactured by TRIAD Boiler Systems. All boiler controls shall be UL Listed or Recognized.

BOILER TRIM:

The following trim items shall be integral to the boiler and factory installed and wired:

1. Low Water Cut-Off with Manual Reset, Test Light, & Test Button internal to the boiler (probe type) that prevents operations if the boiler water level falls below a nominal operating level.
2. Operating High Pressure Limit control.
3. Safety High Pressure Limit Control that is a second high-limit with manual reset that prevents burner operation above nominal operating conditions.
4. Pressure/ temperature gauge of suitable range for monitoring operations.
5. High Visibility "Call for Heat" Light to indicate when the boiler circuitry has been activated.
6. Disconnect switch.
7. ASME relief valve with a setting of 15psi.
8. Observation port for flame inspection.

BURNERS:

The horizontally mounted burner shall be a PowerFlame atmospheric burner and fire natural gas. The burner and gas train shall be of a design that produces flame retention with rapid mixing of the fuel and combustion air.

The entire fuel burner system and its installation shall conform with applicable codes. The burner shall contain manufacturer's pre-wired controls. The burner shall normally operate without objectionable noise, vibration, or pulsation with not more than 20 percent excess air and with no CO in the products of combustion. The burner to boiler interface shall allow for ready installation and removal for inspection and cleaning.

The following trim and controls shall be supplied for the burner:

- A. Air inlet shutter.
- B. Combustion safety control with integral pilot ignition.
- C. Internal gas pilot with combustion ignition electrode and sensor.
- D. Pilot solenoid valve.
- E. Pilot gas pressure regulator.
- F. Diaphragm air flow switch.
- G. Combination gas valve & regulator.
- H. Manual leak test valve.
- I. Second safety shutoff gas valve.

The Burner Control Panel shall include the following:

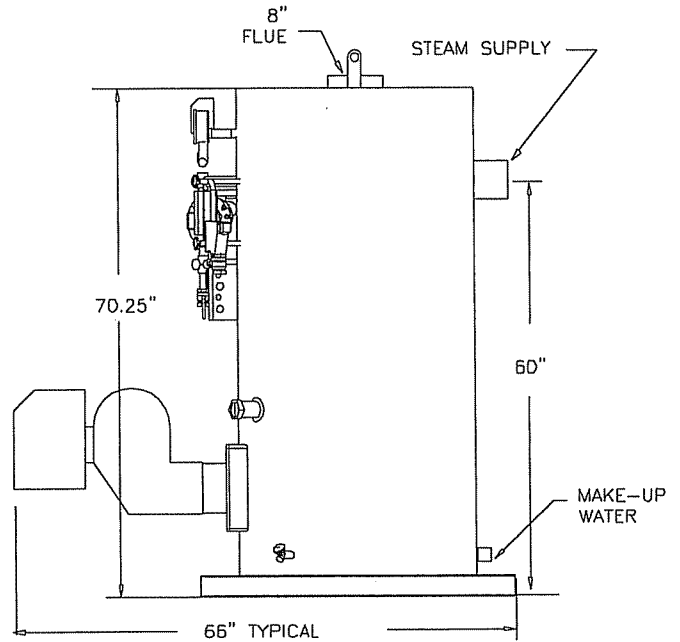
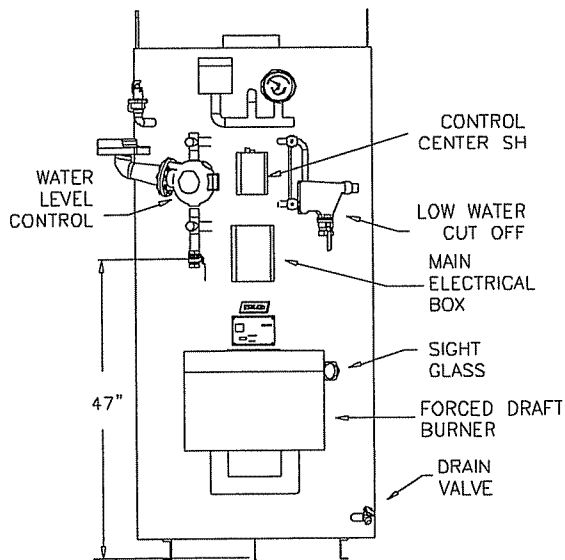
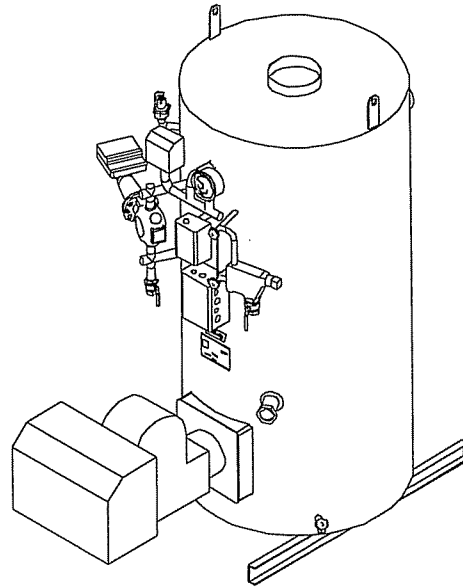
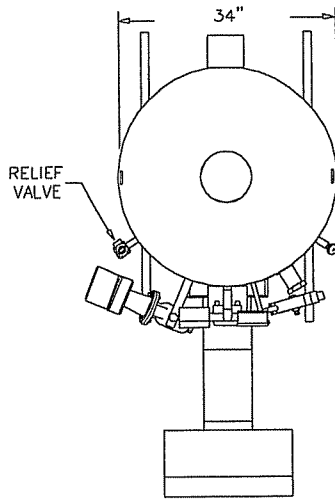

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT
