**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS  
REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this contract is automatically null and void, and is terminated without further order.

**Question #1:** The mobile radio model number specified is AAM25SKD9PW100. The prefix AAM25SKD9PW is the model number for a Motorola CDM1250 mobile radio, which is a 40 watt dash mounted mobile unit. The 100 suffix looks to be one that was added by another vendor to specify providing a 100 watt external power amplifier, but was not specified as to the manufacturers model. If that is the intent, could you please specify a "similar" model so it may be quoted. Motorola does make a 100 watt mobile, which is model number AAM79QTD9PW5. It is the Motorola PM1500. This prevents having to use an external power amplifier.

**Answer:**

- 1. The correct mobile radio model number is Motorola CDM1250, "or equal".**
- 2. Vendor must supply a 100 watt external power amp with each unit.**

**Question #2:** The base station Model number again specifies the prefix CDM1250 with a -100 (possibly indicating 100 watts) and -BA (possibly indicating an AC power supply). As in the mobile specifications, it appears to infer an external power amplifier and power supply (specifications needed but are unknown) be used. The desktop alpha display remotes that are specified generally will change channels on the base station. Can we please have a better description of the interface (standard tone remote or proprietary multiple frequency), and the number of frequencies that will be utilized by the base station. For the base antenna, a "dipole style" is stated, but the number of dipoles on the antenna is not. Can we please get a "similar" description? The type and length of transmission line is also not stated, nor is any lightning or AC power protection.

**Answer:**

- 1. The correct base radio model number is Motorola CDM1550, "or equal".**
- 2. Vendor must supply a 100 watt external power amp and adequate power supply to run both radio and amplifier.**
- 2. Agency will use up to 30 remote frequencies.**
- 3. 150 feet of transmission line is estimated to be used. ½ Helix type cable to be used. Lighting and A/C power protection is required.**
- 4. A four (4) bay DIA-Pole UHF Antenna Model #65143 "or approved equal" to be used.**

**Question #3:** Finally, there is no mention of installation for this system in regard to mobile, base, antenna, or remotes. Please indicate whether system will need installation services, or will be installed by end user.
