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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- **12.** Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this contract is automatically null and void, and is terminated without further order.
- 14. - 5. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- **6. BID SUBMISSION:** All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. Failure of the bidder to deliver the quotations on time will result in bid disqualifications.

SUMMARY OF WORK

PART 1 – GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. General. Drawings and general provisions of Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and other Division 1 specification sections, apply to this section.

1.2 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

- A. **General.** The Contractor shall provide the labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to construct the project in accordance with the plans and as specified herein.
- B. The project consists of complete removal of 16,500 SF of existing rubber roof system down to existing roof metal sheeting, spot repair metal as needed, install new rubber roof system including insulation equal to or greater than existing, closing up one 4 ft. roof penetration and the repair of the metal deck on adjacent new roof area.
- C. The metal deck repair under the existing rubber roof system will be performed on a per square foot basis and a price per square foot for completely installed metal deck shall be provided with the bids. The replacement areas shall be agreed upon jointly by the contractor and the engineer prior to any work being performed. This does not include the metal deck replacement for the above noted 4 foot roof penetration.
- D. The price for the repair of the metal deck on the adjacent new built up roof with be provided as an Alternate No. 1 to the base bid price. The work shall be performed by a contractor or a sub-contractor authorized to work on roof with the existing warranty.

The work will be performed for the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Public Transit.

1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Codes and Standards. Perform all work in compliance with applicable requirements of governing agencies having jurisdiction and in accordance with the plans and as specified herein.

1.4 SUBMITTALS

- A. **Submittal Requirements.** Submittals will be required for all roofing materials, insulation and metal sheeting and trim.
- B. **Transmittals.** Furnish technical submittals including shop drawings, product and material samples, manufacturer's product data, test reports, and material certifications as required.

1.5 **JOB CONDITIONS**

1.6 **DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING**

1.7 SPECIAL WARRANTY

1.8 CONTRACTOR USE OF PREMISES

- A. General. During the construction period the Contractor shall have limited use of the premises for construction operations, including use of the site. The Contractor's use of the premises is limited only by the Owner's right to perform construction operations with its own forces or to employ separate contractors on portions of the project.
- B. General. Limit use of the premises to construction activities. Confine operations to areas within Contract limits which are within the property lines and adjacent right-of-way where work is shown. Portions of the site beyond areas in which construction operations are indicated are not to be disturbed.
