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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. WEST VIRGINIA ALCOHOL & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT: If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

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### 1. SPECIFICATIONS

The following sections of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways' Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2000 and the current Supplemental Specifications shall apply to the administration of this Contract: Sections 101, 102.4, 105.1, 105.3, 105.4, 105.10, 105.11, 105.12, 106.3, 106.4, 106.5, 106.6, 106.7, 106.9, 107.1, 107.2, 107.3, 107.14, 107.19, 107.20, 108.8, 108.9, 109.1, 109.2, 109.9 and 109.20.

The terms "Contractor" and "Vendor" used in the above specifications of this Contract are interchangeable. Contractor shall mean Vendor and Vendor shall mean Contractor.

All Pre-cast Concrete Box Sections with a span or rise of 12 feet or less furnished under this contract shall be manufactured in accordance with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials' Standard Specifications, AASHTO Designation M273-00 (revised 2004), meeting the design requirements of Table 2, except that all welded wire reinforcement and reinforcing steel bars where allowed shall be coated in accordance with AASHTO M284M-95 (Epoxy Coating). The manufactured length of individual box sections may be from four (4) to eight (8) feet in increments of one (1) foot. The maximum section length for delivery to a specific site shall be specified in the State Contract Order (SCO).

The Vendor shall furnish joint sealant material conforming to the requirements of AASHTO Destination M198-94, Type B for each box section delivered.

#### 2. BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of this contract is to establish unit prices for purchase and delivery of Pre-cast Concrete Box Sections throughout all ten districts.

Vendors shall bid on all box sections they propose to furnish.

It is intended that the box beam sections may be the final roadway wearing surface for the structure.

Any qualification of bids or modification of the specifications, design or conditions governing the bids may be cause to reject bids.

### 3. DETERMINATION OF LOW BID

State Contract Orders (SCO's) will be issued for delivery of required box sections to a specified delivery site.

### 4. CONTRACT AWARD

The qualified vendor who submits the valid low bid "F.O.B. Division of Highways' Delivery Site" for the specified box dimensions will be awarded the contract.

In the event a Vendor fails to conform to the requirements set out in this contract document, the State Contract Order or the governing specifications, the Contract may be cancelled and awarded to the next lowest bidder.

#### 5. ACCEPTANCE

Cracks developing in a box may be cause for rejection of the box. Cracks that are not detrimental to the structural integrity of the box section, as determined by the Division of Highways, may be accepted under the following conditions:

1) Cracks of 0.004 inch or less shall be treated with a second coat of a Division of Highways approved concrete sealer.

2) Cracks of greater than 0.004 inch shall be treated by a Division of Highways approved epoxy injection method.

All concrete sealer and epoxy injection required for acceptance shall be performed at no additional cost to the Division of Highways.

### 6. DELIVERY

Upon receipt of a State Contract Order (SCO), the Vendor shall submit shop drawings on Concrete Box Sections with a span or rise of 12 feet or less to the District Engineer/Manager issuing the SCO within twenty (20) calendar days. Shop drawings must be approved by the Division of Highways prior to the manufacture of any box sections.

All box sections shall be delivered to the specified delivery site within ninety (90) calendar days after Vendor's receipt of approved shop drawings.

The Division of Highways may require that a minimum of forty-eight lineal feet of box sections be delivered to a designated job site in a single calendar day. Upon receipt of a State Contract Order (SCO) specifying a minimum daily delivery requirement, the Vendor must notify the District Engineer/Manager within ten (10) calendar days if the required delivery can not be accomplished. To meet minimum delivery requirements the SCO may be cancelled and the box section obtained by alternate means.

Should the Vendor fail to meet the above delivery schedule, liquidated damages will be assessed in accordance with Section 108.7 of the current Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges.

Sites for delivery of box sections under this contract shall be accessible to equipment that is normally and customarily used for transportation of box sections. Upon receipt of an approved State Contract Order (SCO), the Vendor must notify the District Engineer/Manager within ten (10) calendar days if delivery under the terms of this contract cannot be performed due to weight restriction or roadway geometric.

Prior to delivery, all Box Sections shall be tested and accepted in accordance with the requirement of AASHTO Designation M273-94 with a span or rise 12 feet or less.

### 7. VENDOR'S INVOICE

Vendor's invoices must be submitted in original and one (1) copy and contain the following:

- a. Division of Highways' State Contract Order (SCO) number, and this contract number.
- b. Total quantity and unit price with the total cost of box sections furnished.

NOTE: Under no circumstance will the West Virginia Division of Highways accept, or pay for, quantities of material in excess of the quantity stated on the State Contract Order.

### 8. PARTIAL PAYMENT OF APPROVED BOXES

Upon completion of manufacture and approval by the Division of Highways of all Box Sections specified on an individual State Contract Order (SCO, the vendor may invoice and the Division will pay for the cost of manufacturing the Box Sections, not to exceed 65% of the total cost of the delivered Box Sections. Partial payment for Box Sections shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The vendor must request partial payment and furnish an official invoice for the manufactured and approved Box Sections.
- b. The partial payment invoice shall be accompanied by a surety bond equal to the invoiced amount guaranteeing delivery of all items specified on the State Contract Order (SCO).
- c. The vendor shall furnish a statement of approved Box Sections condition and exact storage location.
- d. The vendor shall furnish a legal right-of-entry onto the storage site to Division of Highways' employees and/or agents for the purpose of inspecting, sampling, testing and removing any or all Box Sections.

e. The vendor shall certify that the stored Box Sections are suitably marked and identified as property of the Division of Highways and will not be used for any purpose not designated by the Division.

### 9. PURCHASING CARD ACCEPTANCE

The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA Purchasing Card Program which is issued through a bank. The successful vendors must accept the State of West Virginia VISA Purchasing Card for payment of all orders placed by State DOT agency for orders as a condition of award.

### 10. BID SCHEDULE



Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
