- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.

General Overview

Purpose: The acquisition of, set up, installation and configuration of a video surveillance and card access security system for the West Virginia Department of Agriculture consisting of interconnected, centrally controlled, systems for the following department locations:

- Inwood Farmers' Market and Office Complex
- Moorefield Laboratory Facility
- Gus R. Douglass Agriculture Center at Guthrie

Requirements for All Locations

Video Surveillance Requirements

- The Video Surveillance System must provide video surveillance of specified exterior and interior zones.
- All video must be remotely viewable from Guthrie Executive Office location via a web browser interface on a real-time basis, but must also be able to maintain video surveillance capabilities locally in the event of a network outage.
- Exterior cameras must be weather and fog resistant. Exterior cameras need to be night vision capable with IR lights.
- The West Virginia Department of Agriculture has and will maintain Wide Area Network connectivity for the three locations specified in this document. Wide Area Network interconnectivity is facilitated by Verizon's Frame Relay network utilizing T1's with CIR (Certified Information Rate) bandwidth of 768K with the ability to burst to 1.544MB. The network is an IP (Internet Protocol) network. Video streaming over the network must be able to operate within this specification.
- Video storage servers must be at each department location (ie.. Guthrie, Moorefield, Inwood).
- The Video Surveillance system for each location must provide 30 days of video retention locally.
- The Video Surveillance system must allow for permanent archival of selected video to DVD.
- The Video Surveillance system must be of quality that is admissible in a court of law for purposes of criminal prosecution. The video resolution must be no less than 704 x 480 (NTSC), 704 x 576 (PAL). All video surveillance must be time stamped in real-time and the time stamp cannot be able to be altered.

• Ethernet (100MB) connectivity between buildings on each campus presently exists and may be utilized for communications by the winning bidder. The only exceptions are the Building and Grounds Remote Storage Facility at Guthrie (Building 20) and the Sewage treatment plant, which have no network connectivity. All exterior wiring must be out door and UV rated.

Card Access System Requirements and Specifications

• Current System Compatibility: All Card Access Readers installed in all locations must work with and be controlled by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture's current Keyscan System V Access Control Operating Software, Keyscan System VPH Photo Badging Software, and be compatible with Smart Cards already purchased by the department. The door readers will have to be compatible with RFID proximity cards.

Card Access Database Specifications

- The central card access database is currently, and will remain, located at the Gus R. Douglass Agriculture Center at Guthrie. All remote locations have IP (Internet Protocol) network connectivity to the Guthrie Center location.
- All locations must have the ability to retain the card access database and security permissions for that location in order to operate doors in the event of a network outage, realizing that no updates can be made until connectivity is resumed.

Door Reader and Opener Considerations

- All doors and entry gates specified to utilize locking mechanisms must work with and be controlled by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture's current Keyscan System V Access Control Operating Software, Keyscan System VPH Photo Badging Software, and be compatible with Smart Cards already purchased by the department.
- The gate systems, for both Moorefield and Guthrie, must be motorized.
- Gates must automatically open when emergency vehicles approach.
- Card access doors need to have after hour (forced entry) monitoring alarm system.
- All card access doors must adhere to fire code.

- Door reader and locking mechanisms must be able to operate independently in the event of a Wide Area Network outage. Independent operation must include, but not be limited to having the ability for current cardholders to operate configured doors without having to communicate back to Guthrie location. Ability to update remote card reader systems during a network outage is not required.
- All readers and locking mechanisms must have a battery backup to enable use during intermittent commercial power loss of up to a minimum of 4 hours.
- All doors must include emergency release (unlock) capabilities in the event of battery power loss or network outage.
- Doors and gates specified may require installation of wiring and/or conduit to support card readers, locking, and opening/closing mechanisms.
 Quotes must include installation of wiring and conduit in each campus environment if required.
- Ethernet (100MB) connectivity between buildings on each campus presently exists and may be utilized for communications by the winning bidder. The only exceptions are the Building and Grounds Remote Storage Facility at Guthrie, and the Sewage Treatment Plant which have no network connectivity




Exhibit I-4 Inwood Farmer's Market





Exhibit M-1


