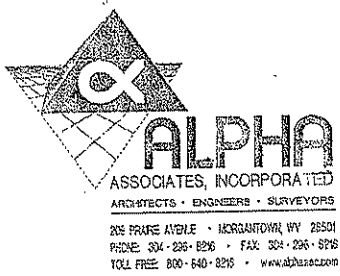
**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS  
REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.

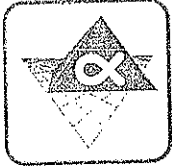

#### 4.0 MEETING MINUTES FROM MANDATORY PRE-BID ON APRIL 23, 2009:

**Location:** The Edgar Simms Armory, 1500 Blizzard Drive, Parkersburg, West Virginia

- .01 **SIGN-IN SHEET:** Beckner asked all present parties to sign a sign-in sheet, attached.
- .02 **INTRODUCTION OF PARTIES:** Major Michael Beckner opened the meeting by introducing himself as the state's project manager. Beckner introduced the following individuals: Rick Colebank (Alpha Associates), Tom Pritts (Alpha Associates), and Brandon Merriman (Miller Engineering). He noted that John Abbott was the state's purchasing agent for this project. All Contractors submitting a bid are required to procure a bid packet from the State of West Virginia - Purchasing Division that contains specific instructions for submitting a bid. Contact Mr. John Abbott at State Purchasing for more information.
- .03 **BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW:** Beckner gave an overview of the contract requirements as specified in the Project Manual. Completed form of proposal, bid bond, drug-free workplace affidavit, and purchasing affidavit are to be attached to the completed Request For Quotation. Contractor License number is to be included on the form of proposal. Prevailing building and construction wage rates apply to this project.
- .04 **BID DUE DATE:** Beckner stated that bids are due at 1:30 p.m. on May 19th, 2009. They may be faxed, mailed, hand delivered or delivered by express courier. The bids are to be delivered to location or fax number listed in the Request For Quotation. The bids will be opened and read aloud publicly at approximately 1:45 p.m.
- .05 **COMMENCEMENT OF WORK/COMPLETION OF WORK:** The project consists of a single phase of work. The work is to be substantially complete 180 days from the notice to proceed. Liquidated damages are \$500/ day beyond Substantial.
- .06 **SUMMARY OF PROJECT:** Pritts gave a brief overview of the project. The project includes the interior fit-out of a previous rifle range as well as a new addition with stair to main building. Also as part of the work, a new fire alarm system is to be installed. The three alternates have been removed from the project via addendum. A unit price is to be provided on the bid form for all costs associated with the fire alarm upgrade. This unit cost is to be included in the base bid and will be used by the owner to allocate funding sources appropriately. Beckner stated that Appalachian Signal recently installed fire alarms for other facilities and could give their contact information to General Contractors.
- .07 **ADDENDUM BULLETINS:** Colebank stated that an addendum will be forthcoming, which will include minutes of this Pre-Bid Meeting and any other clarifications, which may be needed. It is important for the bidders to remember to acknowledge receipt of all addendum bulletins on the Form of Proposal.
- .08 **SUBMISSION OF QUESTIONS / SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS DURING BIDDING :** All questions must be submitted in writing on the Pre-Bid Question form provided in the specification manual, including MEP questions. All substitution requests must be submitted on the Substitution Request form provided in the specification manual, including MEP requests for substitution. The cut-off for the submission of questions and substitutions is April 27, 2009 at 2 PM. Questions, answers and substitution requests that are submitted will be included in the addendum bulletins.   - A. The sand pit has had lead abatement completed. The Owner is not aware of any Hazardous Materials. The Contractor shall notify the Owner/ Architect upon observance of any suspected Hazardous Materials. The owner will remove / dispose of materials in an environmentally acceptable manner
2. Has a budget or estimate been released?
  - A. No.


#### 5.0 PRE-BID QUESTIONS & SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS:

- .01 Are the powered drop screen, projector and associated equipment being provided by the owner? If not, where are the specifications listed for this equipment and cabling?
- A. Powered screen and electrical controls, projector mount, and A/V cabling are to be provided by the Contractor. Projector and any media players (DVD player, Computer, VCR) will be provided by the Owner. Cabling requirements are included in the Electrical sheets. The projection screen is specified in Section 115213.
