**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS  
REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA Business Associate Addendum:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. ## **Addendum #1 DEP14358**

- Item 1:** References to the former Cabinet Secretary's name "Stephanie Timmermeyer" is to be changed to "Randy Huffman". This occurs in the specifications under the Article IV- General Requirements sheets 9A, 9B, 9C, 9D. This also occurs on the title sheet of the construction plans.
- Item 2:** **Delete Specification 7.2.1.4:** Rock riprap (Non-grouted) shall be required in the construction and installation of Ditch Number One (Reach One, Reach Two, and Reach Three) and Ditch Number Two (Reach One).
- Add Specification 7.2.1.4:** Rock riprap (Non-grouted) shall be required in the construction and installation of Ditch Number One (Reach Two, and Reach Three) and Ditch Number Two (Reach One).
- Item 3:** **Delete Specification 7.2.2.2:** Grouted Rock Riprap will be required in the construction and installation of Ditch Number One (Reach Four, Reach Five, Reach Six, and Reach Seven).
- Add Specification 7.2.2.2:** Grouted Rock Riprap will be required in the construction and installation of Ditch Number One (Reach One, Reach Four, Reach Five, Reach Six, and Reach Seven).
- Item 4:** **Plans:** Sheet three, Sheet 4, Sheet 11-Detail 1, and Sheet 12-Detail6 should have the grouted rock riprap symbol on Reach One of Ditch one (Ditch One Profile Stations 0+13.75 to 0+23.75)

### **PRE-BID QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

- Item 5:** **Q:** Will the speech being read at the Pre-Bid become part of the Addendum?
- A:** No, this will not be necessary because everything being talked about comes directly from the Specifications.
- Item 6:** **Q:** You just mentioned 10,000 cubic yards of excavation, but it does not appear on the Bid Schedule?
- A:** The approximate 10,000 cubic yards mentioned would be moved to construct a 20-30 foot wide construction and debris removal access road, with sideslopes of 1H:1V to existing grades, around the edge of Vertical Mine Shaft Number One. This figure is not on the Bid Schedule because moving this material is considered incidental to construction of Vertical Mine Shaft Number One concrete cap. In addition, the Contractor may not wish to construct an access road of this magnitude, at this location, or at this elevation. Debris removal and concrete cap construction is a part of the Contractor's duties for which you will be hired for this project. As such, we don't and won't supervise or in any way control your operational methods other than to specify required final designs. So, how much material is removed is your decision and the purpose for

mentioning this was to make you aware of the possible tasks required to complete the cap construction.

- Item 7:**      **Q:**      Where is the extra 1,400 cubic yards, which is not mentioned on the Bid Schedule?
- A:**      Approximately 1,300 cubic yards of material will be moved to regrade the site to the lines and grades shown on the Plans. Should you decide to develop an off-site borrow are to provide 12" of soil cover atop exposed coal refuse areas you will need approximately 1,400 cubic yards of soil borrow. The 1,300 cubic yards of regarding and the 1,400 cubic yards of off-site soil borrow, should you decide to for an off-site borrow area, should be included in the lump sum price bid for Unclassified Excavation.
- Item 8:**      **Q:**      Are B&O Taxes required for this project?
- A:**      No.
- Item 9:**      **Q:**      Are shop drawing for the pre-stressed concrete beams required for this project?
- A:**      Yes.
- Item 10:**     **Q:**      (Collins Bldg.) Several different scenarios have been mentioned for the backfill of suspected Vertical Mine Shaft Number Two, are all of these scenarios to be paid under one bid item?
- A:**      Yes, should a shaft be discovered beneath the concrete slab at suspected Vertical Mine Shaft Number Two locations, the only pay item available for compensation is Item 9.3 Vertical Mine Shaft Number Two Cap.
- Item 11:**     **Q:**      (Collins Bldg.) You mentioned work hours for this project are 7:00 am to 7:00 pm with no work on Sundays. Does this apply to pump-around operations also?
- A:**      No.
- Item 12:**     **Q:**      (Carpenter Reclamation) You stated the existing 48" aerial pipe will be replaced with a single 40-foot joint of 42" pipe. I have never heard of a joint of pipe that long.
- A:**      I think there is a contact for accompany that can supply that joint of pipe in the specifications. If there is not please call Randy Calkins at (304) 472-7140, extension 104, and I will supply that contact.
