**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS
REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA Business Associate Addendum:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Covered Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
15. **West Virginia Alcohol & Drug-Free Workplace Act:** If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. The contractor and its subcontractors shall provide a sworn statement in writing, under the penalties of perjury, that they maintain a valid drug-free work place policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

Addendum #1
Laurel Run Doser Project

The following information is supplementary to the design plans for the project.

- 1) Electric service has been provided to the pole on-site via overhead lines in the previous project. The contractor shall be required to provide the services necessary for installing electric service from the pole underground to the control panel of the doser which will include the wiring, conduit, and electrical connection. The service shall be buried from the pole to the building and shall be installed through the outside wall of the building at a location convenient for connecting to the control panel. Conduit from the pole to the doser pad is not provided by the previous project.
- 2) The Contractor shall be required to provide the services necessary to make the electric connection to the pump in the vault from the control panel. A 2" conduit has been provided by the previous project from the doser pad underground to the vault over the borehole for this purpose.
- 3) The Contractor shall provide the services required for construction of the structural supports needed to hold the silo in place and support the load of the filled silo. The structural support shall consist of four silo posts welded to the sides of the silo and to a 1-inch thick steel bearing plate as shown on the attached drawings. A 12.5 foot x 1.0 foot bearing plate shall be provided by the Contractor and welded to the existing steel pads in the foundation and secured to the foundation by anchor bolts as shown on the Details.

The structural steel shall consist of 8-Inch steel columns weighing a minimum of 31 lbs/ft. All welds shall be performed by a certified welder. The Contractor is responsible for ensuring the structural integrity of the silo support system.

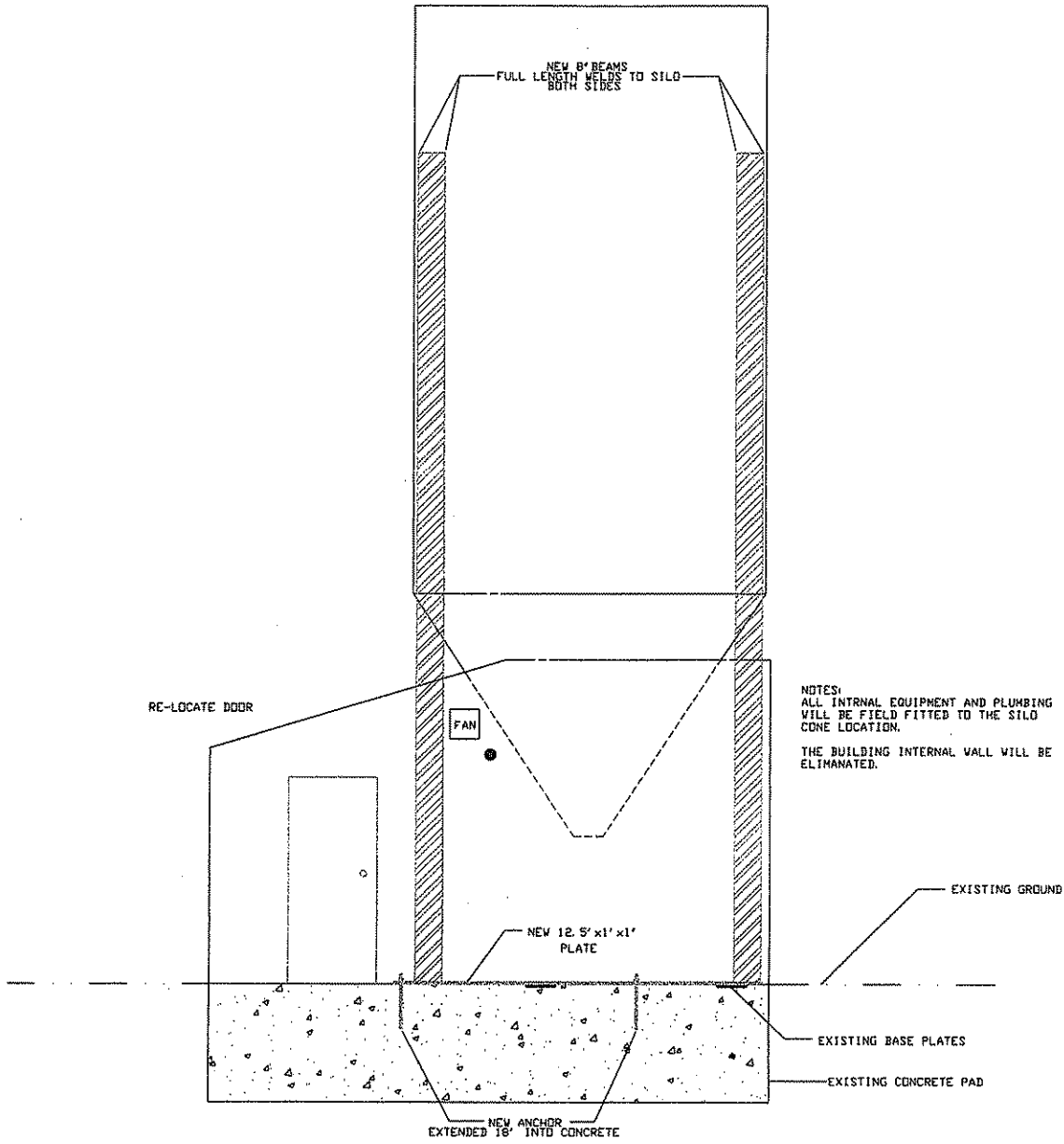
The silo support system shall be constructed in accordance with and to the dimensions shown on the attached diagram. The construction of the steel columns as indicated in the attached drawings necessitates some modification to the design of the attached building. These modifications are shown on the drawings and shall be incorporated into the fabrication of the building.

The cost for materials and labor required for construction of the structural steel support system shall be included in the lump sum price bid for Item 3.0 Doser.

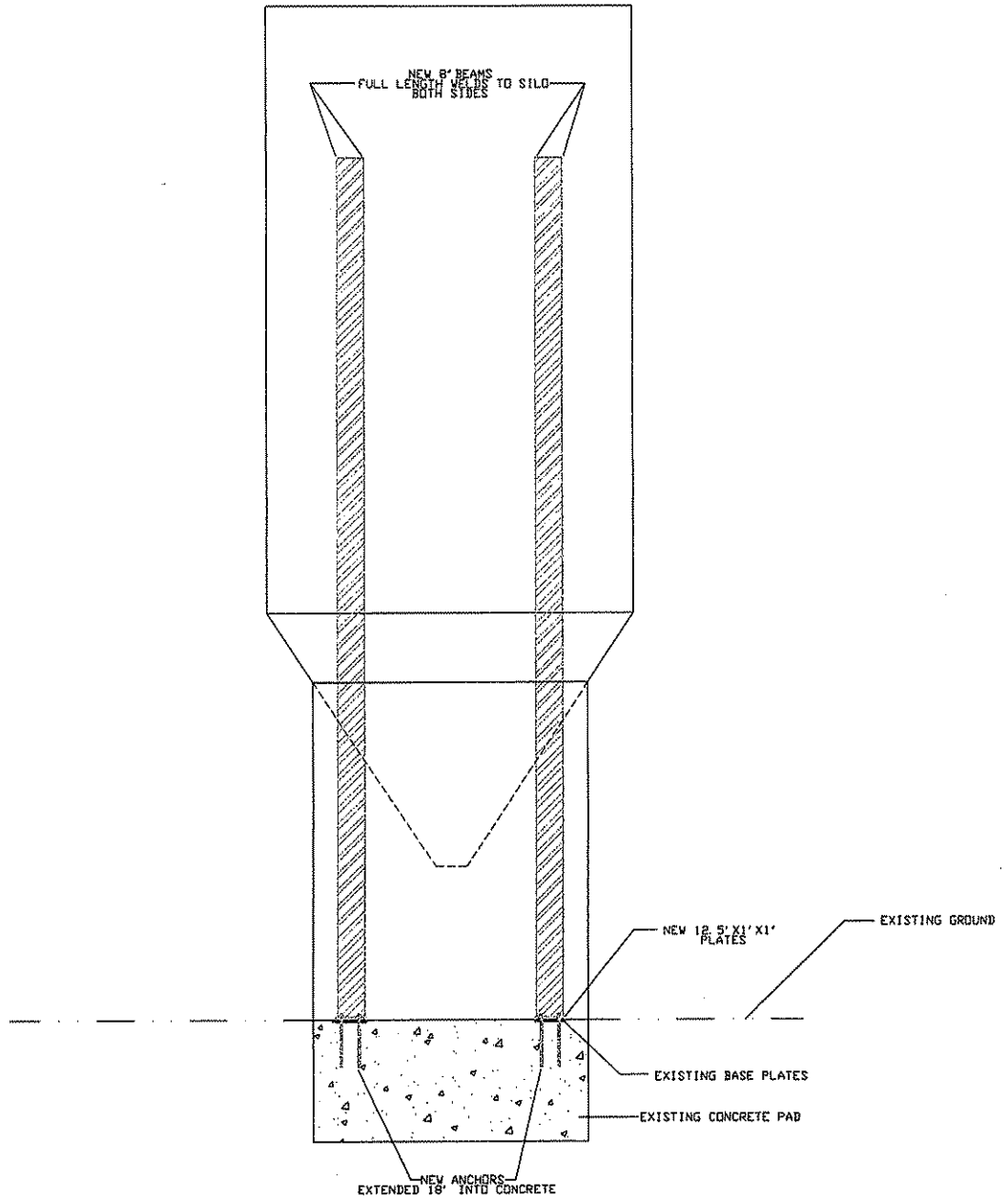

CROSS-SECTION B-B'

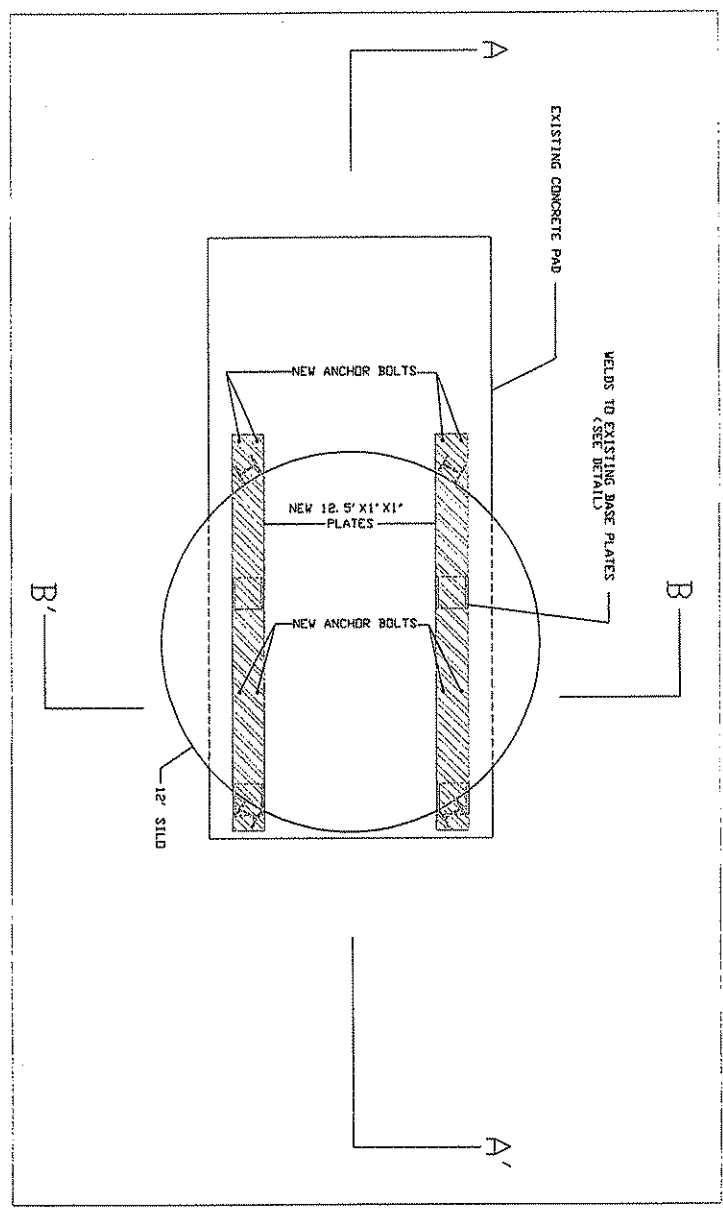

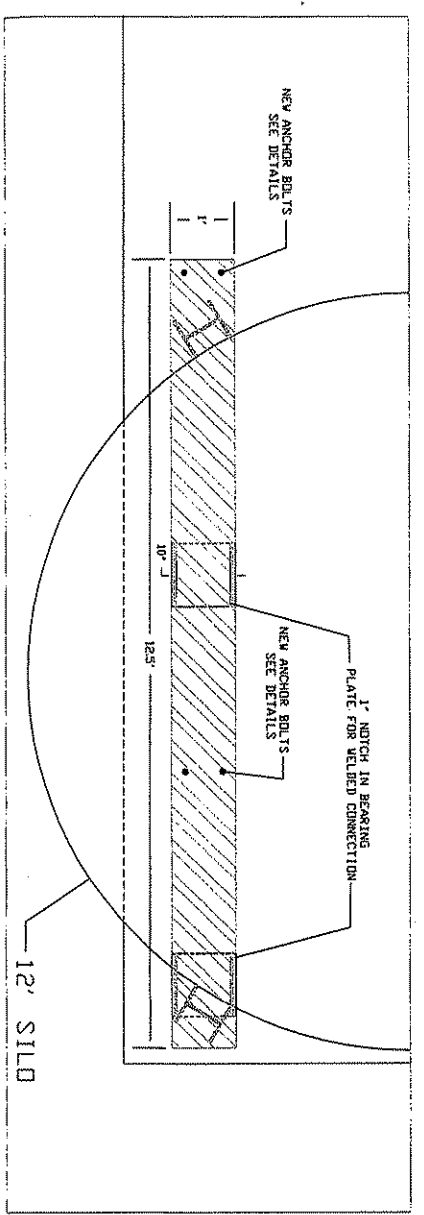

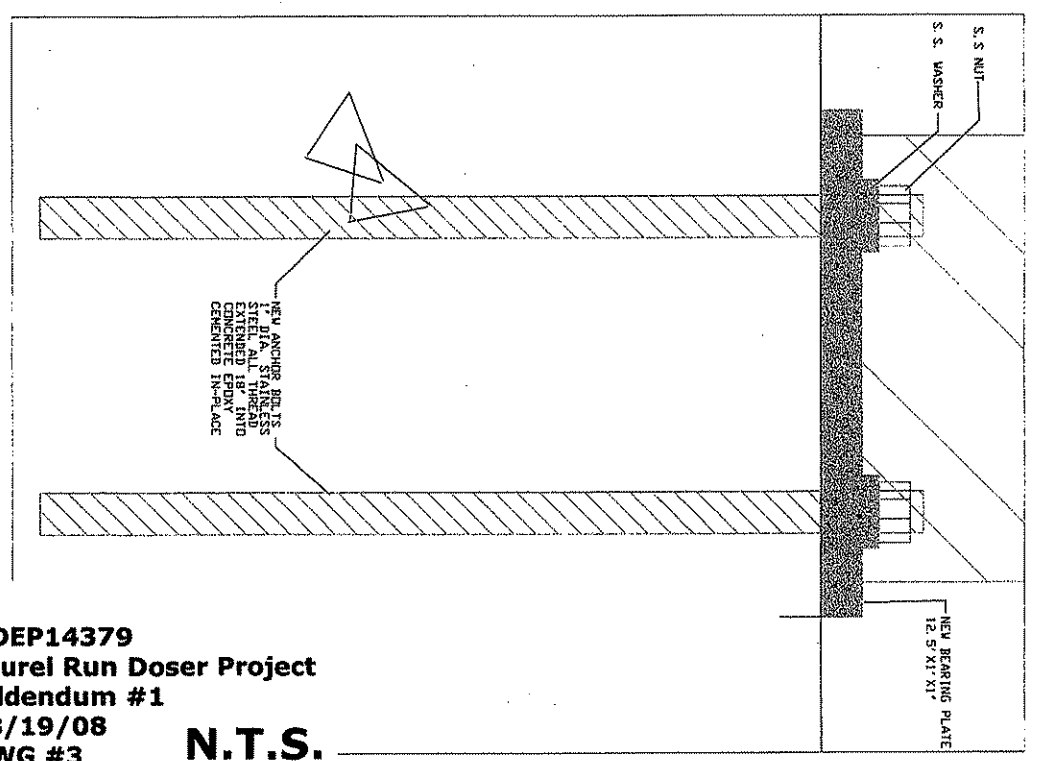
PLAN VIEW
