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# GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. WEST VIRGINIA ALCOHOL & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT: If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. The contractor and its subcontractors shall provide a sworn statement in writing, under the penalties of perjury, that they maintain a valid drug-free work place policy in compliance with the West Virginia and Drug-Free Workplace Act. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

- 1. Use the quotation forms provided by the Purchasing Division.
- 2. SPECIFICATIONS: Items offered must be in compliance with the specifications. Any deviation from the specifications must be clearly indicated by the bidder. Alternates offered by the bidder as EQUAL to the specifications must be clearly defined. A bidder offering an alternate should attach complete specifications and literature to the bid. The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.
- 3. Complete all sections of the quotation form.
- 4. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy.
- 5. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- **6. BID SUBMISSION:** All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. # PRE-BID MEETING MINUTES MARCH 10, 2009

### Don Smith and Brad Leslie of the WVDNR provided the following information:

- 1. Because this is a mandatory pre-bid, everyone in attendance should sign in before leaving
- 2. Don Smith introduced the design team and park staff.
- 3. Contractors shall acquire the Request for Quotation (DNR209127) from Frank Whittaker at the WV State Purchasing Office (PH #304-558-2316)
- 4. The last day for questions and substitutions will be March 31, 2009.
- 5. All questions and substitutions shall be addressed to Frank Whittaker at the WV State Purchasing Office (Email: <a href="mailto:frank.m.whittaker@wv.gov">frank Whittaker@wv.gov</a>).
- 6. The Bid Opening Date will be extended to Thursday April 23, 2009 at 1:30 pm. This date and time will be confirmed by the WV State Purchasing Office.
- 7. A 5% Bid Bond will be required of all bidders.
- 8. A 100% Performance Bond will be required of the Successful bidder.
- 9. The time to complete the project will begin on a date set by the Notice to Proceed and will continue for 365 calendar days to the Substantial Completion Date. Liquidated Damages of \$250 per calendar day will be assessed to the General Contractor for every calendar day over 365 days that the project is not Substantially Complete.
- 10. A two year maintenance bond covering the roofing system is required
- 11. Bidders should acknowledge receipt of all addenda on the bid form
- 12. AIA Document G702/703 shall be used as the contractor's method of Application for Payment. The Contractors Application for Payment shall be submitted to Chapman Technical Group for certification.
- 13. All requests for substitutions must be submitted by the General Contractor/Prime Bidder. If a substitution is approved all bidders will be notified by addendum. Bidders are encouraged to carefully read the Request for Substitution Requirements.
- 14. The prevailing wage rates apply to this project. Wage rates can be obtained from the WV Secretary of State's Office.
- 15. The successful bidder will be responsible for keeping the site clean and free of trash, and construction debris.

### The Following Questions were asked during the discussion:

- 1. Q. Will this project be awarded based on Base Bid and the Alternates? Base bid only?
  - A. The contract award shall be based on the lowest base bid or the lowest combination of the base bid and alternate bid items, as selected by the Owner. The alternate bid items will be selected in the order indicated in the Form of Proposal.
- 2. Q. How are appliances handled related to alternates? Will the appliances be based on 10 cabins or 13 cabins?
  - A. The alternate related to the appliances shall be based on 13 cabins.
- 3. Q. In what order will the alternates be chosen?
  - A. The alternates will be taken in the order they are listed in the bidding documents.

4. Q. What permits will the contractor be responsible for?

A. The NPDS permit has been applied for by the owner as well as permits for the wastewater treatment plant. The contractor will be responsible for obtaining permits from the Division of Highways, as well as the required bond More information will be provided in the addendum.

5. Q. How do wage rates apply to this product?

A. The contractor and all subcontractors are subject to the Prevailing Wage Laws of the State of West Virginia and must pay the current prevailing wage rates established for Tucker County for all on-site construction

# Joe Bird of Chapman Technical Group provided a basic technical description of project:

1. The General Contractor will be responsible for coordination with modular home builder to determine what portion of the cabin construction is to be factory built and what portion is to be site built. Regardless of which parts are site built and which are factory built the final product shall be based on the construction documents provided.

2. Substitutions related to the Waste Water Treatment Plant will be considered. However all substitutions shall be submitted through the WV State Purchasing Office as previously

noted

3. All road crossings will be bore and jack rather than open cut

4. Power will come to the site from a direction other than that shown on drawings. An

addendum sketch will be provided showing the new direction

5. Minutes from today's meeting and all questions from today's meeting will be discussed by the design team, included in an addendum, and returned to Frank Whittaker for distribution.

## The Following questions were asked During the Discussion:

1. Q. What is the proposed start date for construction?

A. The proposed start date for construction is late May or early June, but is dependent on the receipt of a Purchase Order from the Division of Purchasing. The receipt of the Purchase Order depends on, in part, the responsiveness of the successful bidder in providing the required documentation.

2. Q. Will each cabin have a separate electric meter?

A. Each cabin will have a separate electric meter and the contractor will be responsible for providing electrical conduit to each cabin.

3. Q. What is the proposed budget for this project?

A. The WV State Purchasing Office will not allow the project budget to be provided at this time

4. Q. Is there a "rock clause" for this project?

A. There is no provision for a "rock clause" in this project. A copy of the geotechnical report has been provided for informational purposes, but is not part of the contract documents.

- 1 The bid opening date shall be changed to April 23, 2009 The last day for questions or requests for substitutions shall be changed to March 31, 2009.
- 2. The bidder agrees that his bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the actual date of opening thereof.
- 3 The contract award shall be based on the lowest base bid or the lowest combination of the base bid and alternate bid items, as selected by the Owner. The alternate bid items will be selected in the order indicated in the Form of Proposal.
- 4 West Virginia Department of Transportation Permit: The Owner has filed an application for a permit to perform the necessary Work within the West Virginia Department of Transportation Rights-of-Ways All work in the Department of Transportation Right-of-Way shall comply with the Accommodations of Utilities on Highway Right of Way and Adjustment and Relocation of Utility Facilities on Highway Projects, June 2007, in addition to the current edition of "West Virginia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges" plus current Supplemental Specifications, as well as

The Owner has made application for the permit from the WVDOH and the Contractor will be responsible for obtaining such permit which will require the payment of inspection fees, which is estimated to cost \$2,326.46, and obtain and bear the cost of a \$100,000 Highway Bond, satisfactory to the WVDOH, in the name of the WV DNR Parks and Recreation Section.

WVDOH inspection cost is based upon the following footages of water and sanitary sewer pipe and the unit costs shown:

Water Line: 3,522 LF X 0.43/LF = 1,514.46Sewer Line: 1,015 LF X 0.80/LF = 812.00Total Estimated Inspection Fee = \$2,326.46

- 5 The waterline road crossings indicated on Drawings C7 and C8 shall be changed from open cut to bore and jack
- 6 Electrical service will be provided overhead by the power company to a location west of Cabin 13, instead of the location indicated on Drawing C2. This change shall be as indicated on the attached sketches, SK-1 and SK-2
- 7. All underground cable television conduits shall be deleted.

- 8 Underground electrical conduits shall be installed in accordance with Section 02210, Trench Excavation and Backfill Where underground electrical conduits conflict with drainage piping elevations, the conduits shall be buried deeper than the minimum required burial depth
- 9. Reference Drawing C16 and C20, the Emergency Generator receptacle cable shall have three #6 and #10 EG. Transfer switches shall be two pole, solid neutral.
- 10 Reference Drawing P1, the size of the propane line shall be 3/4"
- 11 Reference Drawing E1, wiring for the telephone jacks shall be furnished by the Contractor from the termination box on the exterior of the cabin. Wiring for the television cable shall be furnished by the Contractor and shall extend from the television jacks through a ¾" conduit into the attic space. Cable from the attic to the future satellite dish will be supplied by others.
- 12 Reference Drawing E1, change the ampacity of the panel in each cabin to 200 amps. The service entrance cable shall be #3/0 copper.
- 13 The fireplace chimney shall be a concentric flue for exhaust gas and combustion air, standard for the fireplace provided for the construction indicated on the Drawings
- 14 Soil and rock waste materials may be disposed of on Park property at a location within 5,000 feet of the project site, as directed by the Park Superintendent. The waste site is approximately 450 feet long and 150 wide and shall be encircled by a silt fence and shall have a stabilized construction entrance installed in accordance with the details indicated on Drawing C1B. Side slopes shall be a maximum of 3:1. The erosion and sediment control notes indicated on Drawing C1A shall apply to the waste site.
- 15 Brush may be burned on Park property, as directed by the Park Superintendent.
- 16 Trees larger than 4 inches in diameter shall be cut to eight-foot lengths and stockpiled on a site on Park property within two miles of the project site, as directed by the Park Superintendent.
- 17. Tree stumps shall be removed from Park property and legally disposed of
- 18 Reference Drawing C6, Line No. 2, Sanitary Sewer Profile, change length from 72LF to 54LF.




- 19 Reference Drawing C14, Sand Filter Details, add the following notes: "The filter media shall be silica sand, Black Beauty, or other media approved by the Engineer Filter media shall have a uniformity coefficient of #2 5 with an effective particle size of 0 5 to 1 5 mm.
- 20 Bidders should indicate receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the Request for Quotation


