## GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

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## IDENTIFICATION

The bidder shall identify the asphalt storage tank by manufacturer, model, series, and year of manufacture in the proposal so as to enable identification by the West Virginia Division of Highways in manufacturer's sales literature on the proposed asphalt storage tank. The bidder shall submit complete descriptive literature fully describing the proposed unit, to establish that the bidder is bidding on the most current model, including latest engineering improvements which have been or will be advertised and sold on the open market. The description of the asphalt storage tank shall assure the Division of Highways that specifications will be met without improvising, modifying, or augmenting a standard vertical asphalt tank beyond those variations contained in the manufacturer's regularly advertised specifications. The unit specified herein and offered in this quotation shall be manufactured after January 1, 2007, and clearly identified and marked with the date of manufacture.

## DELIVERY

Delivery of the asphalt storage tank shall be made to the specified job site within forty-five (45) days of the date of the purchase agreement by the successful bidder.

## PRE-SERVICE

The asphalt storage tank shall be completely serviced, all equipment installed and all adjustments made which are required to prepare the unit ready for immediate and continuous operation upon delivery.

## WARRANTY

The manufacturer's standard (1 year minimum) warranty and service policy shall be furnished with the vertical asphalt storage tank.

## OPERATING AND SERVICE MANUALS AND PARTS LISTS

Two (2) copies of parts lists, service or maintenance manuals, and operator's manuals shall be furnished with the vertical asphalt storage tank on delivery. Detailed drawings of the concrete pad dimensions recommended for the tank installation shall be furnished within (7) calendar days of the date of the purchase agreement.

## 7 GENERAL

The vertical asphalt storage tank shall be designed for the storage of emulsified asphalt. The tank shall be electrically heated with gravity flow and have a minimum capacity of 7,000 U.S. gallons.

### SPECIFICATIONS

- A. The tank shall be 8'0" in diameter and approximately 19'0" high and constructed of 1/4" carbon steel.
- B. The tank shall be insulated with min. 3" fiberglass and covered with aluminum jacketing for all weather protection, including bottom and top.
- C. The tank shall be erected on and attached to a steel stand to place the broom of the tank 7'0" above ground.
- D. The tank shall be equipped with a ladder and safety rail to provide access to door on top of tank. The ladder shall be enclosed to meet OSHA specifications.
- E. The tank shall be equipped with a minimum of nine (9) 800 watt electric heat strips (7,200 watt total), 220 volts, attached to the outside bottom of the tank. Thermostat control (240 volt, 3 phase) shall be included. The tank shall have the ability to maintain a temperature of 160 degrees F. when the outside temperature is a negative 10 degrees F.
- F. The tank shall be equipped with (1) 3" steer lever control ball valve for loading and (1) 3" check valve on inlet and drain line. All are to be thermo taped and insulated.
- G. A loading hose 3" in diameter and 12' long of flexible steel with quick coupler at tank end shall be provided.
- H. A built-in float gauge for measuring liquid level reading both in English and Metric shall be provided.
- I. The vertical tank shall be capable of storing polymer modified asphalt and shall be equipped with a two bladed agitator driven by a 1 HP 220 volt, 3 phase electric motor with automatic timer capable of agitating from 5 to 30 minutes in one minute increments at set times on any given day of the week.



- J. The tank shall include (1) temperature gauge with a 4" dial, 50 degrees F to 200 degrees F minimum.
- K. The tank shall include lifting eyes for unloading and lifting the tank.
- L. The tank and structures shall meet all applicable Federal and State of West Virginia codes. Manufacturer of the tank must have an ASME tank approval number to assure that Federal regulations and codes can be met. The number shall be included with the bid.
- M. The WVDOH shall provide a crane and operator to unload and lift the tank, concrete pad with steel support plates, wiring from tank control boxes to power supply, and tank erection and installation.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

**PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

**DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
