## GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
  2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
  3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
  4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
  5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
  6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
  7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
  8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
  9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
  10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
  11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

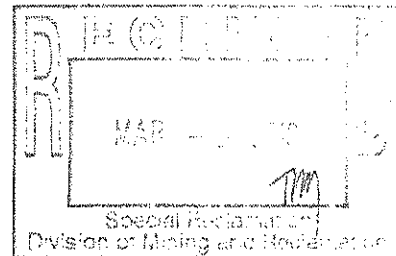

Attached are the original pre-bid conference sign-in sheet(s) for the above referenced project and questions and answers asked during the conference.

The following are corrections to the "Scope of Work" and bid schedule.

- Item 12 – First sentence now reads "Alkalinity cell one (1) will be constructed by excavating down to original ground, to the length, width, and six foot (6') depth listed in the attached specifications and plans."  
Change to read – "Alkalinity cell one (1) will be constructed by excavating down to the length, width, and six foot (6') depth listed in the attached specifications and plans."
- Item 12 – Last sentence now reads "Cost of riprap, limestone, drive-thru and grout will be inclusive to the cost of Cleaning Pond 4 (see attached specifications and/or plans)."  
Change to read "Cost of riprap, limestone, drive-thru and grout will be inclusive to the cost of Alkalinity Cell No 1 (see attached specifications and/or plans)."
- Item 13 – First sentence now reads "Construct approximately two hundred seventy-five linear feet (275 LF) of limestone riprap Channel Three (3) to receive water from the fill underdrain and the grouted riprap groin Channel Number one (#1) and reworked groin ditch."  
Change to read – "Construct approximately two hundred seventy-five linear feet (275 LF) of limestone riprap Channel Three (3) to receive water from the grouted riprap groin Channel Number one (#1) and reworked groin ditch."

- Item 35 – Second sentence now reads “Road bed through box cut will be raised with spoil material to a height that will cover exposed coal seam in box cut.”  
Change to read – “Road bed through box cut will be raised with spoil material to a height that will cover exposed coal seam in box cut while carrying this fill beyond the box cut to minimize grade into and out of box cut to the existing roads.”
- Item 46 – Third sentence now reads “Spillway will be constructed using either standard sandstone or limestone riprap.”  
Change to read “Spillway will be constructed in the existing location using either standard sandstone or limestone riprap.”
- Item 47 – Second sentence now reads “Pond will be cleaned to a length, width, and depth listed in the attached plans and specifications.”  
Change to read “Pond will be cleaned to a length, width, and depth listed in the attached plans and specifications with all debris from baffle curtains, pipes and floating pump disposed of properly under Item 9.0 Structure and/or Debris Removal.”

#### Changes to Bid Schedule

- Item 5.1 Agricultural Lime now reads a quantity of “150 acres” and has a unit price of “per acre”  
change to read – quantity of 600 tons and a unit price of “per ton”.
- Item 18.0 Well head /Borehole seal now reads a quantity of “1 each” and has a unit price of “per each”.  
Change to read a quantity of “2 each” and leave the unit price “per each”.

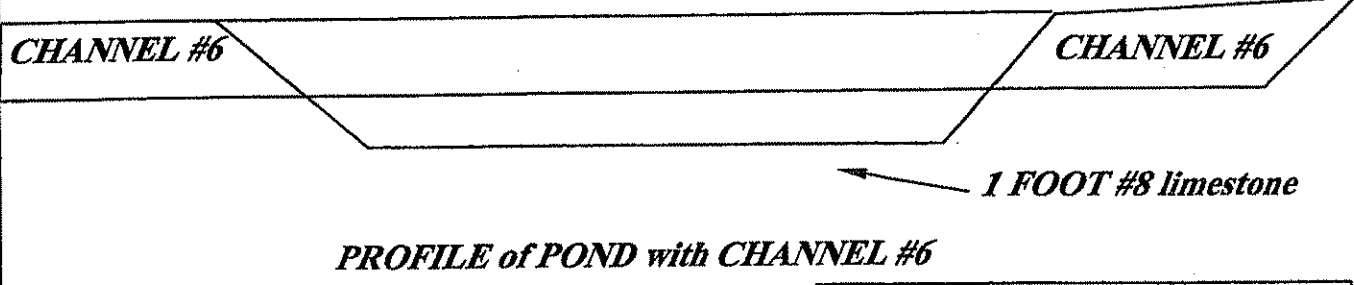
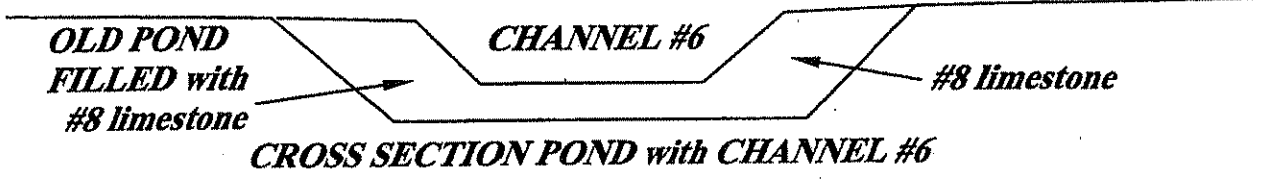
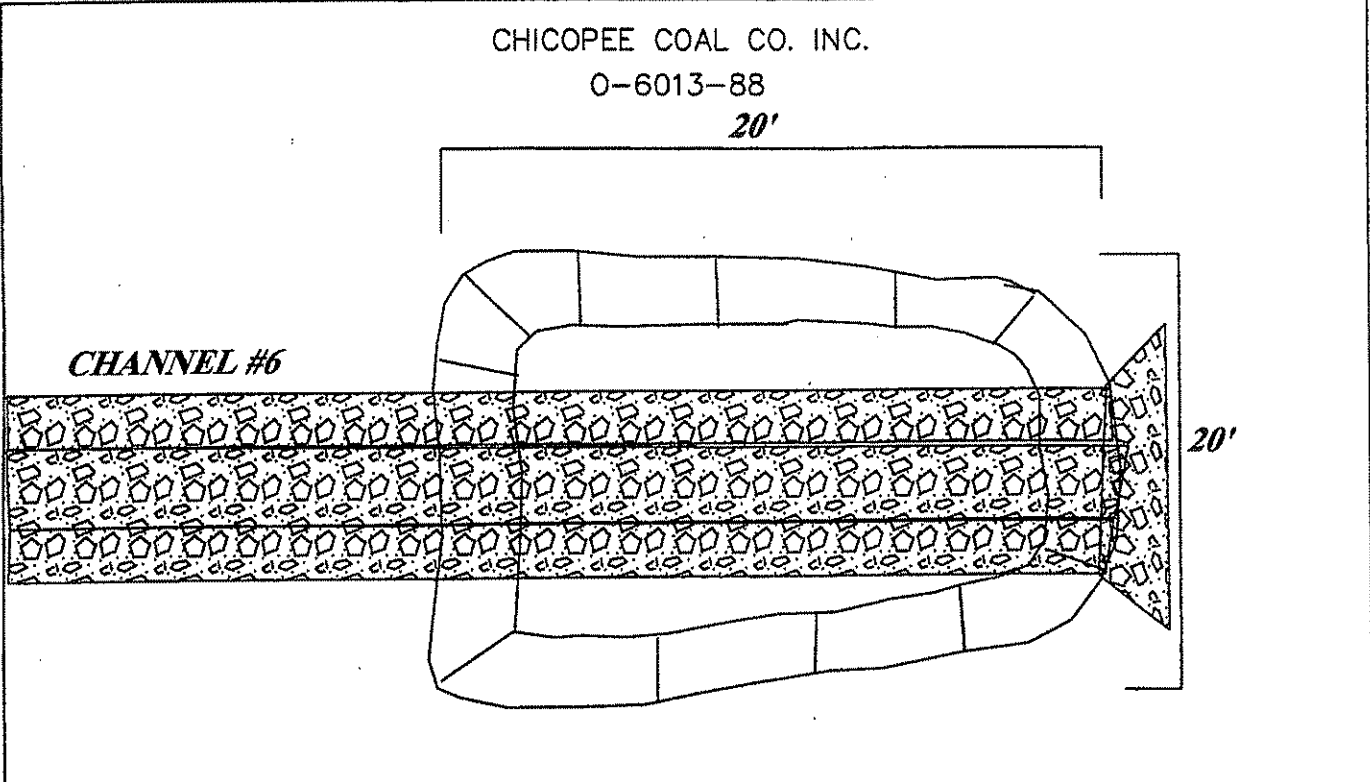

#### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS AT PRE-BID

1. Where do we place black material from pond elimination?  
 The black material from the pond elimination can either be encapsulated in highwall backstack at the prep plant or it can be placed on exposed refuse pile prior to covering pile with topsoil material.
2. How much #8 limestone gravel will be required to eliminate pond at the toe of the existing refuse disposal pile?  
 Pond at the toe of the existing reclaimed refuse pile contains an appreciable amount of silt and sediment. We will provide a typical drawing giving the dimensions of the pond. See attached drawing.
3. Does unreclaimed refuse pile get crowned prior to covering with topsoil?  
 Yes, the refuse pile will be graded to have a “crown” across the top of the pile and it will be sloped from the face to the rear. There is a typical drawing n your bid package that addresses this.
4. Do the “black areas” on face of the unreclaimed refuse pile get topsoil covering & revegetated?  
 Yes, any “black” areas on the unreclaimed refuse pile will be revegetated. These areas are small and were formed from 4 wheeler traffic.
5. Where is borrow area located for the material to cover the unreclaimed refuse pile?  
 The borrow area is located on right side (looking upstream) of the unreclaimed refuse pile..
6. Will we be required to relocate the gas lines on the borrow area or can we work around the lines?  
 You will have to contact the gas company for that information. If gas line relocation is deemed necessary, DEP will reimburse this expense at cost.
7. Are gates open at all times for access to site?  
 Yes, gates are never closed.

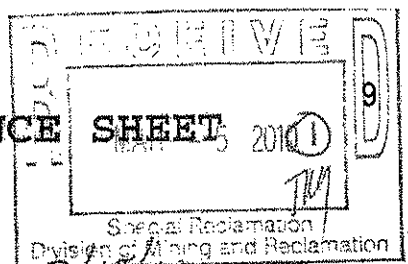

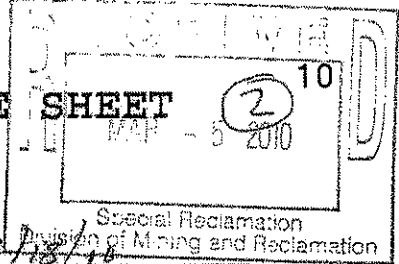
