GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.
- 3. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- 4. All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. - 5. Communication during the solicitation, bid, evaluation or award periods, except through the Purchasing Division, is strictly prohibited (W.Va. C.S.R. §148-1-6.6).

Addendum #1 - Questions During Pre-Bid Conference For DEP 14906 Buffalo Coal Company, Inc. Permit # S-2018-88

The following questions were identified at the Pre Bid Conference (PBC). The answers provided herein take precedence over verbal answers at the PBC should there be any conflicts between the two.

- 1.) Q. Do you have to go back as far as you need to to get material on top (for backfilling the pit)?

 A. Yes, use what you need, and what you don't need you must regrade and seed over.
- Q. Will the pond be eliminated in this job, or later?A. Yes, pond #6 will be eliminated after a minimum of 70% of the vegetation has been established.
- Q. Is this going to be filled from down here (standing out in front of the pit area) to the top of that highwall, or is the area above the highwall going to be pushed down?

 A. No, do not disturb area above the highwall. You will match the existing backfilled slope to the south of the pit.
- 4.) Q. The disturbed area (above the highwall) is up there where that brush starts then, is that correct?

 A. Yes.
- Q. (Standing on the flat area out in front of the pit) does this area need to be sloped to?

 A. No, you are beyond the sloped area of the backfill here. The slope on the south side of the pit is 4H:1V, and the slope toward the north side of the pit is 2.5H:1V.
- 6.) Q. There is no compaction specification with any of that (backfilling the pit)?

 A. No, much of the pit area may have a lot of shot rock to use as backfill. Just track in material as it is placed in the backfill.
- 7.) Q. What about the topsoil, is it just the best we can find here?

 A. Yes, as you are working through the spoil stockpile, hold back any good material to place on top. Use the rock first to place in the pit area. Also, any boulders left along the access road may be used to reclaim pond #5, or may be placed into the pit.
- 8.) Q. The only access to this site, is it through the guard shack (at Mettiki Coal's Load-Out Facility)?

 A. Yes, plan on accessing the site through the Mettiki Coal active permitted site. There is
 - A. Yes, plan on accessing the site through the Mettiki Coal active permitted site. There is another road that has recently been established through the site for the TRAILS high voltage electric line project, which is a private access road. The DEP does not authorize use of this road.
- 9.) Q. What we don't use (spoil stockpile material), do we dress in place? A. Yes, and revegetate it.

- 10.) Q. How deep is the pond (pond #6)?

 A. Not sure, but we believe it is not more than 6 feet deep.
- 11.) Q. To eliminate pond #6, do we just fill it up, or do we pull the outer sides in?

 A. No, we want you to bring the outer embankments back in and regrade it. The pond has to be pumped out first.
- 12.) Q. Do you want the area below the spoil stockpile to be regraded along with the spoil area?

 A. Yes, regrade areas that have been previously disturbed by dozers. You may have to work around rock outcrops, and do not disturb areas that have only been cleared of trees, but have not been disturbed with dozers.
- 13.) Q. Is this area included with your seeding now (the disturbed area below the existing spoil stockpiles)?
 - A. Yes, 10 acres covers the pit area, the spoil stockpile areas, and ponds. The 17 acres of vegetative enhancement should cover the south of the pit area.
 - CLARIFICATION: If the 10 acres of Revegetation does not cover the regrade areas below the spoil stockpile, we will use some of the Vegetative Enhancement 17 acres of seeding to cover this first. Then we will use the rest on the south side of the pit area.
- 14.) Q. Are there any problems with coming back to the site to survey it?

 A. You can come back to the site as long as you check in and out at the Mettiki site guard house.
