recycled milk cartons (Color Green); fixed fulcrums constructed from malleable cast iron (Powder Coated Green) and safety handles.

American Playground All Metal Modular Play Structure, # APS60035, or equal To include the following play stations: 2 aluminum spiral slides L336R & L651; deep rung arched ladder; arched bridge; stainless steel straight slide; stainless steel wave slide; arched ladder; spiral climber; ADA transfer station; access ladder; horizontal ring ladder; Tic Tac Toe panel, steering wheel panel, figure 8 climber; sliding pole; arched roof; decks constructed from a minimum 12 gauge hot rolled steel with plastisol coatings; posts a minimum 5" aluminum tube 1/8" wall (Powder Coated), components are made of a minimum 1.9 X 11 gauge galvanized pipe , 1.315" x 11 gauge galvanized pipe, 1.065" x 12 gauge galvanized pipe (All Components Powder Coated); arched roof: the roof supports must be fabricated from a minimum 5" outside diameter tubing, 1/8" wall thickness , extruded from 6000 Series aluminum alloy with a minimum Tensile Strength of 38,000 psi and minimum Yield Strength of 35,000 psi. Warranties:

- All equipment must be guaranteed to be free of defects in workmanship and material for a minimum of one year from date of acceptance. However, if manufacturer warranty periods are longer than the required minimum one year warranty, those warranties must apply.

Structural steel members and play surfaces must be treated for rust prevention and painted With a suitable powder coat finish. All molded plastics and vinyl coatings must have UV protection

Vendor must provide complete installation instructions, parts specifications, touch-up paint sufficient for initial installation, and warranties.

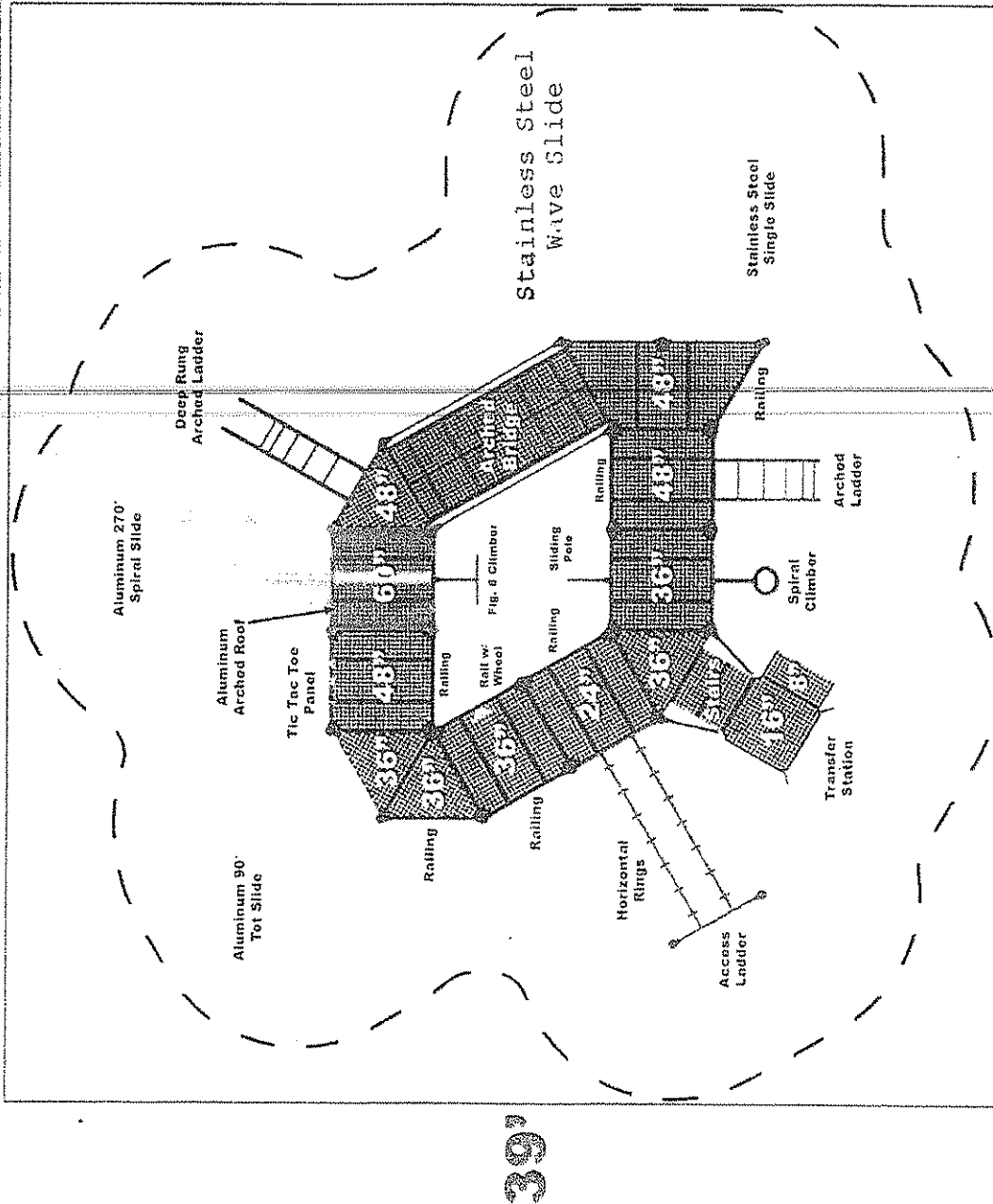
