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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.

General Information

The West Virginia State Police is seeking bids to establish a contract for digital (alpha and numeric) paging service throughout West Virginia, inclusive of all 55 counties. The ideal vendor would be able to provide 100% saturation coverage (alpha or numeric messaging) for the entire state on a year round basis. Failing this, prospective vendors should clearly state, in unequivocal terms, exactly what their respective coverage areas are,

- 1. The West Virginia State currently owns approximately 150 Motorola Brand pagers which operate on 152.4800 MHz frequency. Prospective vendors must be able to provide service utilizing this equipment on the same frequency, with no reprogramming of the units required. If another frequency or different equipment is required, it should be clearly stated in your proposal that pagers will be provided at no additional charge.
- 2. Prospective vendors are encouraged to include lesser coverage options and/or spot coverage options in addition to their wide area coverage, as some agency personnel will not need statewide coverage.

The charges and prices requested are the only fees which will be payable under this contract. Vendors shall not include any "one time set-up fees" or extra charges for alpha service. Any charges of this nature shall be included in the prices quoted.

Bid evaluation will be based on the best value to the State and the State reserves the right to make multiple or split awards based on the best value. An award will be made for each and every item (#1 through #10) assuming

acceptable bids are received. Since a separate award may be made for each and every coverage, estimated usage will <u>not</u> be a factor in bid evaluation. Vendors are encouraged to submit quotes for any regional coverage they offer. Bids will not be rejected for failure to provide all coverage's sought.

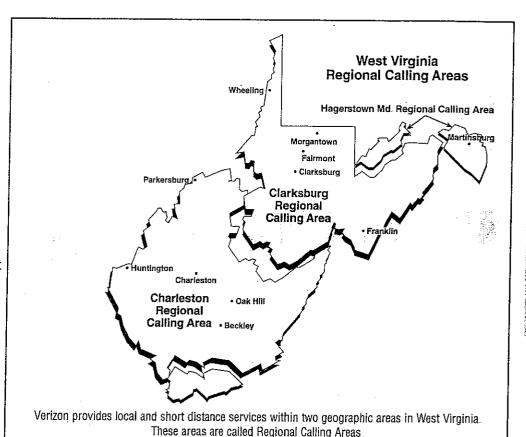

Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

I certify that this bid is made without prior understanding, agreement, or connection with any corporation, firm, limited liability company, partnership or person or entity submitting a bid for the same materials, supplies, equipment or services and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. I further certify that I am authorized to sign the certification on behalf of the bidder or this bid.

LICENSING:

Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
