- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

Green Building Curriculum Development, Social Networking and Professional Development

The West Virginia Department of Education, Division of Technical and Adult Education Services, Office of Career and Technical Instruction supervises the delivery of secondary career and technical education programming in middle schools, high schools and technical centers throughout West Virginia. This office is developing curriculum content and related professional development that will introduce green concepts to selected Career and Technical concentrations.

The WVDE will purchase curriculum materials, social networking services and professional development services that meet the following mandated specifications:

Part 1: Green Building Curriculum – The vendor will work with the WVDE to develop curriculum materials appropriate for the General Building Construction concentration and related concentrations related to green building and design. Topics shall include green building defined, LEED certification, green building materials, installation of green building materials, green building design, use of alternative energy sources for building design and construction. Problem-based learning will be incorporated. Suggestions for additional Content Standards and Objective will be made to the WVDE.

Part 2: Social Media - The vendor will create and operate a robust social media site connecting students and teachers to each other and to industry professionals. The social media site will encourage teacher collaboration and professional development, student interaction and foster connections with professionals in the green building movement.

Part 3: Professional Development – The vendor will work with the WVDE to conduct face-to-face or electronic professional development activities for up to 60 teachers in the General Building Construction concentration and other related concentrations that will assist the teachers in the utilization of the materials developed under parts 1 and 2 of this RFQ. The Vendor will also conduct face-to-face or electronic professional development activities, with cooperation from the WVDE, for up to 65 teachers in the Auto Technology concentration and other related concentrations. The vendor will organize green industry professionals to assist with technical aspects for teachers through face-to-face interaction at scheduled professional development meetings and social media connections.

Deliverables - Vendor will deliver:

- 1. Curriculum materials in electronic and paper formats ready for teacher use. The materials must use a problem based learning format. WVDE will copy and distribute.
- A social networking site for instructors and students in General Building Construction programs and other construction related programs that facilities collaboration between teachers, professional development for teachers, social networking for students in the above described programs and connections between green building industry professionals, teachers and students.

3. Face-to-face and electronic professional development opportunities for instructors that will help them integrate the curriculum materials and social networking into their instruction.

Terms and Conditions of the Contract

It is anticipated that this contract will be issued as an open-ended contract. Billing may occur only after deliverables are completed.

Curriculum materials and professional development must be completed by August 1, 2010. The social networking site must be operated throughout the 2010/2011 school year.

The purchase order for this contract will be issued to the low bidder who meets the qualifications. The successful bidder will be notified by purchase order from the West Virginia Purchasing Division.

Vendor Qualifications

Qualified bidders must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Organizations bidding on this project must have developed curriculum material development that features 21st Century teaching and learning, especially problem-based learning.
- 2. Organizations bidding on this project must have delivered large and small group and electronic teacher professional development that features 21st Century teaching and learning in a career and technical context and of the scope described in this RFQ.
- 3. Organizations bidding on this project must have experience in the development of West Virginia Content Standards and Objectives.
- 4. Organizations bidding on this project must have developed and operated a monitored social networking site with the following characteristics:
 - a. Approval function with membership verification
 - b. Real-time interaction
 - c. Allow posting of content such as texts, video or pictures
 - d. Chat function
 - e. Creation of special interest groups
 - f. Guidance for teachers on how to integrate the social networking site into their instruction
- 5. Organizations bidding on this project must be a Professional Development Affiliate for the Partnership for 21st Century Skills.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.
