Detailed Description of Project:

Open-End contract to purchase products for typing of Streptococcus pneumoniae isolates from human specimens to determine the effectiveness of the current Pneumococcal vaccine and provide products for the serotyping of salmonella isolates from human specimens.

Specific Eligibility Criteria:

The Pneumococcal products are the only products available on the market to serotype specimens in approximately 2 minutes. These products are solely manufactured by Statens Serum Institut in Denmark for which Miravista Diagnostics is the sole distributor in the United States. While the Salmonella antisera products are not the only products available for testing of Salmonella, they have been found to give the most accurate results.

Specific Qualification Criteria:

Miravista Diagnostics is the sole distributor in the United States of Statens Serum Institut, the manufacturer of the only Pneumotest latex agglutination kit available to produce results in 2 minutes.
