Specific Eligibility Criteria:

Provide an Electronic Vehicle Inspection Report with a simple tag and inspect system that ensures pre- and post-trip inspection compliance, eliminates paperwork and expedites vehicle repair. Each vehicle will have its own programmed hand-held device with electronic sensors located at different points on vehicle to ensure that each driver performs inspections to each location.

The easy-to-use EVIR guided driver inspections, must record the data automatically and must transmit data instantly. Each system must be able to send reports to various locations for reporting purposes.

The system is to be set up that will not allow the driver to by-pass any points of the program during the inspection to ensure checks and balances on each inspection.

Specific Qualification Criteria:

Must be able to comply and have approval from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration according to 49 CFE, Parts 396.11 and 396.13. This system will take place of pre and post trip inspection books that are maintained in the vehicle and in the office that is required by law.
