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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
 12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

Scope:

Vendor/Contractor **shall** provide all, labor, material, equipment, supervision and other necessary incidentals to provide thorough inspection, testing, and maintenance, as well as repairs and replacement when necessary, on all fire safety equipment at all WV Division of Corrections facilities located on the attached bid forms. The inspections, tests, and maintenance **must** be done to meet all federal and state laws.

The vendor **will** provide replacement parts, programming services on proprietary systems, and or subcontract work upon request of the institution at a cost plus not to exceed **10%** markup. All parts receipts are to be submitted with the vendor invoice showing the original price, and the percentage markup.

Objectives:

To insure all Life Safety Systems located at all West Virginia Division of Correctional facilities located throughout the state, which are listed on the bid forms are functioning in accordance with NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) codes and standards as well as all West Virginia State Codes.

To insure all Life Safety Equipment is performing as designed to protect the well being of the occupants of all Division of Corrections buildings.

Contractor Minimum Qualifications and Requirements:

1. Lead Technician **must** be NICET Level Two or higher (National Institute for Certification In Engineering Technology)
2. All others **must** have a minimum of Low voltage license or higher
3. Must have West Virginia contractors' license
4. Technicians **must** be factory trained.
5. Bidding vendors **shall** possess at least (5) five years of documented experience performing Inspection and Testing of Life Safety Systems and provide proof of such by supplying a list of at least five references of similar size systems, upon request.
6. A subcontracted third party may be used to perform any or all inspection and testing activities. However, the bidding vendor listed will assume any and all liabilities for acts and omissions of its employees and agents (subcontractors.)
7. The vendor **will** be responsible for selecting supervising, and compensating all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of the contract. Neither the vendor nor any employees or subcontractors of the vendor **shall** be deemed to be employees of the State for any purposes whatsoever.

8. The wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension or other deferred obligations, and licensing fees, etc., and the filing of all necessary documents, forms and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing are the vendor's responsibility.

13. Vendor is responsible for all special equipments needed.
14. Kitchen suppression must be scheduled in advance in agreement and cooperation of the facility management.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
