GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. - 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

Alternates offered by the bidder as **EQUAL** to the specifications must be clearly defined. A bidder offering an alternate should attach complete specifications and literature to the bid. The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.
- 3. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- 4. All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. - 5. Communication during the solicitation, bid, evaluation or award periods, except through the Purchasing Division, is strictly prohibited (W.Va. C.S.R. §148-1-6.6).

Addendum #1 - Questions During Pre-Bid Conference For DEP 15167 T&J Coal, Inc. Permit # P-177-85

The following questions were identified at the Pre Bid Conference (PBC). The answers provided herein take precedence over verbal answers at the PBC should there be any conflicts between the two.

THE BID SCHEDULE HAS BEEN REVISED: Item #4.2 revised to 5200 LF of Construct New Haulroad; and Item #7.2 revised to 200 LF of 36 Inch Culvert.

- 1.) Q. Can we mob in on this access to the site (coming in to the site through farm field)?

 A. No, the location of the new access road directly off of the county road shall be the only approved access to the treatment site for the contractor.
- Q. This new road that you are going to install out through the woods, is there already a road roughed in or piece of road there?A. Yes, we will walk on some of it and show it to you later.
- 3.) Q. Are you going to take the ditching from the road culverts clear into the hollow? A. Yes, to prevent erosion, and to slow down water flow.
- 4.) Q. If we have to cut this road down, do we need to ditch both sides of road?

 A. Yes at certain locations, the road cross section indicates that a grass lined ditch is included on all of the road, and in some cases where it is steep, riprap ditching will be used and paid for in a separate bid item.
- 5.) Q. Are we going to put matting in the grass lined roadside ditch, or do we seed and mulch it?

 A. Seed and mulch the roadside ditch, unless we add riprap at certain locations.
- Q. Any trees to be taken down, do we need to leave for the landowner?
 A. Yes, any trees 8 inches in diameter and larger shall be topped, stumps removed, and neatly stacked in convenient locations along the road for the landowner.
- Q. Can we move the ponds further away from the seep area (standing at the seep area)?
 A. Yes, utilize the wider area available to orient the two treatment ponds and maximize the most drop in elevation from the seeps to the first pond. By utilizing the wider area away from the seep for the pond construction will also maximize a longer distance of grouted channel from the seep to the first pond.
- Q. Can the road be on the outside berm of the treatment ponds, or is it (road) going to be over the hill?A. We will evaluate the best road alignment after the contractor has graded the area for the pond sites, but our initial proposed alignment of the road is to place it on the upper side of the pond

berms (between the hillside and the ponds).

- 9.) Q. Does the road keep going (standing at the seeps, and looking past them)?

 A. No, a branch of the road extends to the point where the seep is located to get to the future caustic tank and building. This road extension will also have to include an area to turn the chemical delivery truck (tandem or tri-axle 3000 gallon tank truck) around. Any turning areas will be paid as new road construction.
- Q. What percent grade or slope are you wanting on the road going up the hill (standing at the seep area)?A. Make the road as gradual as possible, and we would like the road to be less than 15% slope.
- 11.) Q. If we have to do any grading on the hillside above the road, will it have to be a minimum of 2 horizontal to 1 vertical slope?

 A. Do not grade the hill any steeper than 1.5 horizontal to 1 vertical, and try to maintain 2 horizontal to 1 vertical slope, where possible. To avoid excessive grading on the uphill side of the road, you may have to start the road up the hill further back. You can branch a separate road off toward the treatment building, and include a turning area. The contractor shall propose the road alignment and have it approved to the DEP, prior to construction.
- 12.) Q. How far down here does the permit limit go (standing at the seep area)?

 A. The permit area extends along the two main open benches, however; to construct the two treatment ponds, the contractor may have to grade material past the large tree line for the lower pond embankment construction. Plan for that as part of the pond construction bid items, and the clear and grub bid item. Do not disturb areas below the existing bench that we walked around (where the ponds are to be located).
- 13.) Q. So, is the seep going to run into the grouted V-ditch? A. Yes, the seep will be piped into the V-ditch.
- 14.) Q. Is there a fence around this building (caustic tank building)?

 A. No, only fence around the two treatment ponds, and the two sludge cells.
- 15.) Q. Are both sludge cells the same size, and is that size top of water or top of berm?

 A. Yes, they are both the same in size... 40 feet top inside width, and 150 feet top inside length, and a total depth of 10 feet.
- 16.) Q. What are you tying the sludge cells together with?

 A. The sludge cells shall be tied together with a 20 feet joint of 15 inch diameter culvert pipe.
- 17.) Q. Will there be three or four concrete spreaders at the ponds?

 A. There will be four spreaders installed, one at each pond inlet and each pond outlet.
- 18.) Q. How wide are those spreaders?
 A. Please refer to detailed drawing included in requisition, 10 feet wide, and center 4 feet will have a 3 inch drop out where the water will flow out. They are 3 feet deep and 1 feet thick. All dimensions are included in the drawing.

19.) Q. Are the baffling curtains going in the settling ponds?

A. Yes, one baffle shall be installed in treatment pond #1, and two baffles shall be installed in

- A. Yes, one baffle shall be installed in treatment pond #1, and two baffles shall be installed in treatment pond #2.
- 20.) Q. Are we going to put rock headwalls on the 36 inch culvert installations?

 A. Yes, the contractor shall install rock riprap at each end of each culvert installed. Any rock riprap installed on headwalls and endwalls of culverts is incidental to each culvert installation
