GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. - 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

DNR211029 Hunters Helping the Hungry

Project Description – the following briefly describes the Hunters Helping the Hungry (HHH) Project:

West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR), Wildlife Resources Section's Hunters Helping the Hungry (HHH) Program was started in 1992 as a way for hunters to donate their legally harvested deer to the less fortunate of the State. Since 1992, hunters have donated more than 19,200 harvested deer to create more than 978,000 meals. Once the deer is donated, the certified processors dress, grind, package and freeze to await pick-up by the vendor. The vendor will temporarily store frozen venison and later transport the venison to a statewide distribution network of soup kitchens, food pantries, shelters, senior centers, missions, churches, and community centers. This distribution is carried on through the fall and winter months of the year.

Vendor Qualifications – In order to facilitate the HHH Program, the vendor must have the following qualifications and capacities:

- Licensed to handle venison by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture
- Have a current network, or capable of developing a network by October 16, 2010, of a minimum of 500 non-profit feeding programs
- Verify all non-profit feeding programs are certified in safe food handling
- Must provide evidence you are a member in good standing with Feeding America before award
- Have freezer space of no less than 39,000 cubic feet in one location
- Must provide for sufficient quantity of refrigerated vehicles for timely statewide venison pick-up and delivery
- Able to reimburse processors \$1.45/pound

Scope of Work – Vendor (with the assistance of a sub-contractor, if required) will complete the following tasks:

- Inspect all participating feeding programs every two years during distribution to ensure facility is being operated according to safe food handling procedures
- Maintain inventory records for a period of 3 years after the expiration of the contract
- Pick-up processed venison from participating processors as identified on the HHH website (www.wydnr.gov/Hunting/HHH.shtm)
- Store venison in an on-site freezer(s) until it can be safely delivered to distribution facilities. All venison must be delivered prior to March 15.
- Deliver venison to all 55 West Virginia counties as determined by need of distribution facilities (unless no requests are received by a particular county)
- Mail Share the Harvest letters to approximately 3,000 statewide churches no later than Oct 15.
 Vendor does mail merge from a provided database, on provided letterhead and is responsible for postage until reimbursed.
- Must participate in a minimum of two HHH Program fundraising events/year as requested by the DNR, which may be up to 2 full days/event.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (**West Virginia Code** §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
